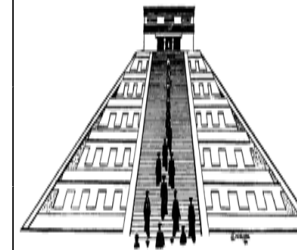

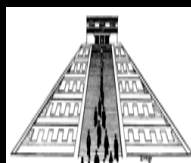

What is the Raza Grad Celebration Ceremony?

The Raza Celebration Ceremony was created to honor students apart from the University Commencement. It is a wonderful ceremony that provides students with a more intimate and personal way to celebrate their graduation. During this ceremony, students are called up by name and are given a certificate of recognition. In addition to being called up by name, the student is given time to thank anyone she/he feels contributed to her/his success. There is also a luncheon the student shares with family members prior to the actual ceremony.

Where will this year's ceremony take place?

This year's ceremony will take place at Quiet Cannon in Montebello. The maximum capacity for this location is 1000 people. This means that only a limited amount of students can be accommodated, so register early!

When will the ceremony take place?

The Raza Grad Celebration Ceremony will take place on Saturday, June 13, 2009. Check-in will begin at 11:30 am. Lunch will be served at 12 Noon and the ceremony will run from 1pm to 3:30 pm.

How much does it cost to participate?

The fee for participating in the Raza Grad Celebration Ceremony varies according to the number of tickets requested. Students are given the option of either 5 tickets for \$150 or 10 for \$280. Tickets are only sold in lots of 5, with the option of 5 or 10 tickets only. This means that if you need 4 tickets, you will purchase 5 tickets. If you need 8 tickets you will need to purchase 10 tickets. Always include yourself when considering the number of tickets you will purchase. No students will be able to purchase more than 10 tickets for the Raza Grad Celebration Ceremony.

When do I need to pay the fees to participate?

Tables are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. It is to your advantage to return this form with payment to the CSULA Federal Credit Union. An installment plan is available, 50% of total fee will save your space! For example, if you purchase 10 tickets for \$260; \$140 will save your spot. The second installment is due no later than Friday, May 8th, 2009.

What does the fee cover?

A portion of the money you pay to participate in the Raza Grad Celebration Ceremony is used to pay for your meal. You also receive a complimentary sash and an annual. The annual includes your picture and a brief dedication. Make sure to read and fill out the registration form completely to ensure that you are included in the annual. Photos are also included in the registration fee and will be taken *by appointment** in Cross Cultural Centers, located in the University-Student Union on the following dates:

April 17, 21, 23, 24, 28, 30, May 1 (9am – 4 pm)
April 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 20, 27 (9am – 1 pm)
Make up-date May 4 (9am – 1 pm)

* NOTE: In order for each graduate's picture to be included in the annual, she/he needs to schedule an appointment with the Grafix Department, located in the University-Student Union on the 2nd floor, room or call (323) 343-2464, for her/his photo session. No exception will be accepted.

How do I register for participation?

You can register by filling out a registration form available Cross Cultural Centers, located in the University-Student Union on the 2nd floor, room 206. Application will be available Monday, March 2nd, 2009.

Where do I turn in the completed registration form?

The completed registration form and payment needs to be returned to the CSULA Federal Credit Union, located on 2445 Mariondale Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90032 by Friday, May 1st, 2009. Due to the space constraints, late applications will not be accepted. After we receive your completed registration form, we will mail you a confirmation letter with information about the mandatory meeting, tickets and other necessary information.
