Objectives


- Migrate two Power Apps, PD Go and PD HelpDesk, to use Azure cloud database instead of SharePoint 365.

Enrollment App


- Redesign UI for the new LACPD forms

- Migrate data from Office 365 to Azure SQL Database
- Implement necessary stored procedures and workflows
- Make necessary code changes to work with a relational database
