Summary of Plan

MSW students' competency achievements were evaluated using two instruments. Instrument 1 consisted of signature assignments completed in the MSW core courses in the Fall 2025 semesters and Spring 2026 semesters. Instrument 2 comprised competency ratings provided by practicum instructors at the end of the Spring 2026 semesters.

*MSW students enrolled in the One-Year Advanced Standing Program (ASP) are exempt from all foundation-year coursework.

Advanced Generalist Practice (including MSW 2 and 3 Year Advanced Program and ASP)

MSW students' competency achievements during the Advanced Generalist Practice years were evaluated using two instruments. Instrument 1 consisted of signature assignments completed in the MSW core courses in the Fall 2025 semesters and Spring 2026 semesters. Instrument 2 comprised competency ratings provided by practicum instructors at the end of the Spring 2026 semesters.

As shown in Table 1, it was expected that 85% of the MSW students in their advanced year in the Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 semesters would meet the benchmark established for the expected level of achievement on each instrument.
