FPC is proposing a new policy that requires that all students enrolled in a course under the instruction of specific faculty member(s) be listed on that faculty person's GET record for that term; and that faculty are compensated according to the Contract for teaching or supervising any student(s) registered for a course under that faculty person's name at Cal State LA. GET is the work record of each faculty person; it is a legal document and must include the names of all students enrolled in courses at Cal State LA with that faculty person as the instructor of record. In addition, it is a violation of the *Fair Labor Standards Act* for any faculty person to voluntarily, without compensation, teach or supervise any student enrolled in a course at Cal State LA with that faculty person as the instructor of record.

FPC discussed the new policy at its meetings on February 1, February 8, and February 15, 2021. FPC voted unanimously to approve the new policy on February 15, 2021.
