- 2 California State University, Los Angeles offers the Bachelor of Arts, the Bachelor of Science,
- 3 Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Vocational Education Degrees. All four degrees have the same
- 4 basic structure: General Education, major concentration and free electives:
- 5 **The Bachelor of Arts** is designed to provide a balanced liberal arts education and general
- 6 knowledge in a recognized discipline, interdisciplinary field, or areas of professional study.
- 7 The Bachelor of Science is designed to provide a balanced liberal arts education and a scientific,
- 8 <u>technical or professional entry level of competence.</u>
- 9 The Bachelor of Music provides a balanced liberal arts education with additional preparation in
- musical performance with emphasis on high performance standards.
- 11 The Bachelor of Vocational Education, created through State legislation, is specifically designed
- for vocational/occupational teachers who are required to have both work and teaching experience.
