



Family Nurse Practitioner Residency Program

The Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) Community Care Residency Program is a full-time 12-month post-graduate residency program designed in partnership with the Chin Family Institute for Nursing (CFIN) at California State University, Los Angeles (Cal State LA). This program supports the needs of CCALAC member health centers and their patients, while simultaneously providing intensive training and on-the-job experience to new and recently graduated FNPs who are committed to developing their careers as primary care providers.

Through this program, FNP Residents will work at one CCALAC member health center and help increase access to quality primary care for underresourced populations. FNP Residents will receive didactic lectures incorporated into clinical practice, support and guidance from a Preceptor(s) and Clinical Faculty, which will prepare them for full and autonomous expert care for populations with complex healthcare needs across all life cycles. FNP Residents will also improve their clinical skills, confidence, productivity and job satisfaction, as well as contribute to employer satisfaction and workforce retention. This program is a full-time, paid position, with paid time off and benefits.

Program Requirements

- Available to work full-time (Monday Friday)
- Commit to 12-month residency (January 2026 January 2027)
- Available for Zoom and in-person lectures at Cal State LA
- Proof of malpractice insurance
- A graduate of an accredited FNP program (no more than 2 years since graduating, 2023 graduates or later)
- Credentialed (FNP-C) or licensed/credential-eligible as a FNP in California, or have applied for national FNP certification, or successfully passed the certification exam

- Unofficial school transcripts
