#### Installment Payment Plan (IPP) - 2 Payments

Defer the cost of your Tuition Fee for an enrollment fee of \$22.00. The first installment is due prior to registration, and the second installment is due 30 days from the issue agreement date.

Available through January 20, 2015 before 5:00 p.m.

#### Management Payment Plan (MPP) - 3 Payments

#### Winter 2015 Quarter’s Tuition and Fees

Divide the cost of your tuition and fees into three installments for an enrollment fee of \$35.00 for one term and \$55.00 for multiple terms. The first payment for winter 2015 term is due November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2014. *If your enrollment appointment is earlier than November 3<sup>rd</sup>, then the first payment is required to register for classes.* The last day to use this plan for winter 2015 is December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2014, however both the November and December payments must be made to enroll at that time.
