SUBJECT:	Proposed Modification for Chapter I of the Faculty Handbook:
	Academic Organization of the University

This section of the Faculty Handbook has not been updated in the time since the College of Ethnic Studies was formed, nor does it reflect the name change for the College of Education. There have also been several department changes since this section was last updated. The modification of the section reflects the current academic structure at Cal State LA.

- Lines 5-6: Alphabetizes the departments to align with the format used for the remaining colleges.
- Line 5: Notes the separation of the department of Music from the department of Theatre and Dance.
- Lines 6-7: Adds the Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies to the College of Arts and Letters.
- Lines 8-9: Updates the department name for the Department of Finance, Law, and Real Estate in the College of Business and Economics.
- Line 10: Removes "Charter" from the name of the College of Education, reflecting its current status as no longer a charter college.
- Lines 15-17: Added the College of Ethnic Studies to the academic organization, and included the corrected name of CLS, as well as AAAS and PAS as the departments currently within this college.
- Lines 17-23: Updates the naming and organization in the Rongxiang Xu College of Health and Human Services.
- Lines 22-24: Removed the departments from the College of Natural and Social Sciences that have since been incorporated into the College of Ethnic Studies.

1 Academic Organization of the University

- For the administration of its instructional programs, the University is organized into six colleges. The colleges

 Science; Electrical and Computer Engineering; Mechanical Engineering; and Technology.
