Subject: EPC Memo 23-15: Proposed Deletion of "Introduction to Higher Education

Course" Policy - Chapter IV of the Faculty Handbook

In their new General Education standards, set to replace our current GE Breadth requirements, the CSU has removed Block E—Lifelong Learning and Self-Development—from the GE requirements. Under the existing GE Breadth, students satisfy the Block E requirement through an Introduction to Higher Education (IHE) course. EPC and GES propose deleting the policy mandating the "Introduction to Higher Education Course" to comply with these new CSU standards.
