SECURITIES TRACK

(Trader/Analyst/Fund Manager/Treasury)

FIN 437, 450, plus: FIN 447/440/431

CORPORATE FINANCE TRACK

(Corp Finance/I-Banking/Consulting)

FIN 434, 437, plus: FIN 431/440/450

FINANCIAL ADVISORY

(Financial Advisory/Private Banking)

FIN 437 plus: FIN 450/447/335

Specialty tracks:

COMMERCIAL BANKING

FIN 437, 450, plus: FIN 431/434/439

MORTGAGE BANKING

FIN 439, 493, plus: FIN 335 or FIN 450

PRIVATE BANKING

FIN 437 plus: FIN 437/439/450/335

For example, if you want to be an Analyst, you should take Fin 437, 450, and either 447, 440 or 431 as your electives (if you are interested in Corporate Treasury or International Fund Management, you probably want to take FIN 431). It is also recommended that Fin 437 be taken as quickly as possible, for students wishing to be involved in managing the student fund or getting involved in the FMA CFA challenge.

Career Notes to Finance Students:

In general, Fin 437 is the single most important elective to take. It is required for most financial careers, with the exception of commercial lending and mortgage banking. Fin 335 is only of value to those interested in financial advisory, private lending, or mortgage banking for home owners. Taking it because it is easy wastes a valuable elective if you are not pursuing one of those career paths and many employers discount that course. Choose your courses to match your career goals.

Note: Students must complete 2 diversity(d) courses in General Education from Blocks C, D, E, or Upper Division Themes. (The schedule assumes the student is GE certified for all blocks and HAS NOT TAKEN ENGL 102 equivalent or equivalent courses for major requirements.)
