Audit Highlights

The California State Auditor (CSA), a California state agency that audits governmental agencies' administration and management of public funds and programs, recently performed audits of the California State University (CSU) system. In 2017, the CSA audited the Clery Act Requirements and Crime Reporting and the Health and Safety of Employees and Students who use Hazardous Materials.
