"WHAT?" VS "WHY?"

Understanding Strengths, Interests, Values, Motivations, & Goals

- Major and career choice is often strongly influenced by external factors.
- Students often select a major or career before being fully informed of the expectations, challenges, and realities of the field.
- Understanding students' strengths, interests, values, and goals can help us as advisors and counselors to guide them in major choice.

Pre Nursing and Exploring Health Professions

Important Guidelines

- 1. As a reminder, only students admitted into Pre Nursing are eligible to apply to Cal State LA's Nursing program.
- 2. Students admitted to Cal State LA's Exploring Health Professions option are not able to apply for Nursing.
- 3. Students admitted in other majors are not able to switch to Pre Nursing or apply for Nursing.

Exploring Health Professions and Nursing

Nursing as Career vs Nursing as Major

- Alternate Paths: Major + Post Bacc
 - Nutritional Science
 - Kinesiology
 - Biology
 - Applied Science
- Alternate Fields: Nursing Adjacent Majors and Careers
 - Public Health
 - Health Care Administration

Case Study: Social Work

Understanding Student Career Goals

- For most students, the MSW is the ultimate goal for career success
- MSW does NOT require an undergraduate degree in Social Work
- Alternate paths:
 - Child Development
 - Rehabilitation Services
 - A Social Science Major: Sociology, Anthropology, Political Science
 - Any Ethnic Studies Major: Chicana/o Latina/o Studies, Pan African Studies, Asian American Studies
 -and more!

Fall 2024 Admission Guidance

- Apply online via the Cal State Apply application: Oct 1- Nov 30, 2023
- Students will need to report all colleges attended and enter all college coursework have transcripts handy and plan for adequate time
- Most admission decisions are made using self-reported information answer all questions accurately and completely.
- Cal State Apply Transfer Update Plan to update fall 2023 grades and spring 2024 classes in January 2024.
- To facilitate transfer success, all Cal State LA majors have Major-Specific
 Criteria for admission that focus on lower-division preparation in the major.




Transfer Admission Requirements

- Complete 60 transferable semester units, including 30 units of CSU General Education (GE).
- Complete the Golden 4 GE courses with grades of 'C-' or better:
 - A1 Oral Communication
 - A2 Written Communication
 - A3 Critical Thinking
 - B4 Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning
- Achieve a minimum overall transferable GPA of 2.00;
- Be in good standing at last institution attended;
- If needed, satisfy the English Language Proficiency requirement (TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, or DuoLingo English); and
- For select majors, meet the Major-Specific Criteria (MSC) for the desired major.



Major Specific Criteria for Admission



All Cal State LA majors have Major-Specific Criteria (MSC) which focus on student preparation that predicts success in the major and promotes timely degree completion.



MSC Courses and minimum GPAs

To facilitate major preparation, applicants are strongly encouraged to earn an Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T/AS-T) from a California Community College

Business Administration BS

Programs with supplemental processes

- Music BM complete audition requirement by February 5, 2024
- Nursing BSN submit NursingCAS application by January 5, 2024 at 8:59 pm

Business Administration: All Options

Transfer students completing an approved Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) in a major deemed similar:

- Required ADT major: Business Administration or Business Administration 2.0
- Required minimum cumulative GPA: 2.0

Transfer students not completing the ADT:

- Required minimum cumulative GPA: 2.0
- Required General Education courses (grade of "C-" or better required):
 - Written Communication
 - Oral Communication
 - Critical Thinking
 - Quantitative Reasoning (Math)
- Recommended major preparation courses (grade of "C" or better required):
 - ACCT 2100 Principles of Financial Accounting
 - ACCT 2110 Principles of Managerial Accounting
 - ECON 2010 Principles of Economics I: Microeconomics
 - ECON 2020 Principles of Economics II: Macroeconomics



Fall 2024 Majors with MSC for Admission

The following programs may use major-specific criteria for admission selection:

- Civil Engineering BS
- Computer Science BS
- Fire Protection Administration Technology BS
- Mechanical Engineering BS
- Music BM
- Nursing BS
- Psychology BA
- Social Work BA
- Television, Film and Media Studies BA
- Urban Learning-ITEP BA

Applicants to the above programs have the option to select an alternate major in the Cal State Apply application. If not offered admission to their first choice major, CSU eligible students may be considered for admission to their alternate major.



Local Admission Area Preference

Transfer applicants who are transferring directly from one of the schools listed below are considered 'local' if:

- The majority of their transferable units were completed at a local preference college;
- Or, their last school of attendance (with earned transferable units) is a local preference college;
- Or, they will/have earned an Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T/AS-T) in a major deemed 'similar' to the Cal State LA major from a local preference college.

Local Preference Community Colleges:

Glendale Community College, LACCD, Pasadena City College, Rio Hondo College, and Santa Monica College

We give local preference to all military veterans, regardless of colleges attended.



TRANSFER ADMISSION ROUNDS



LOCAL MSC GUARANTEE

Except for Nursing and Music BM, local CSU eligible applicants are guaranteed admission if they meet the required minimum MSC GPA and prerequisite courses.

NON-LOCAL MSC RANKING

Except for Nursing and Music BM,
CSU eligible non-local applicants
who meet the required minimum
MSC GPA and prerequisite courses
will be admitted on a space-available
basis based GPA ranking and
completed recommended courses.

SPACE AVAILABLE BY MAJOR

If space is available after Rounds 1 and 2, then CSU eligible students without the minimum requirements (MSC or ADT) will be considered based on a ranking of the criteria completed with local applicants receiving a 0.25 GPA bump.

Golden Eagle Fest On-Site Admissions

- To participate, students must:
 - Submit the Fall 2024 <u>Cal State Apply application</u> by Thursday, Nov 9; and
 - Sign up for Golden Eagle Fest On-Site Admission by Monday, Nov 13, 2023.
- Who is eligible for On-site Admissions on Nov 18?
 - Applicants must have completed all coursework in the United States. No international coursework.
 - Transfers who will meet minimum Cal State LA transfer admission requirements by the end of Spring 2024.

Cal State Apply Tips

- Allow Pop-Ups from Cal State Apply
- Use an email that they will have continuous access to – do not use current school email address
- Write down CAS ID and their login information
- Enter full, legal name in the application
- If they have one, don't leave SSN blank
- Have unofficial transcripts for reference
- If taken, report test scores (AP, IB, CLEP)
- If applying to EOP, have at least 2 people and their email addresses ready
- For Major Specific Criteria –accurately "match" courses in the Program Materials section.
- Use the Cal State Apply Applicant Help Center, including CHAT!



Transfer Success Pathway (TSP)

- Inaugural Cohort fall 2023 freshman:
 - Spring 2023 high school graduates
 - TSP Sign-Up period: Aug 1-Sep 30, 2023
- Start at local CA Community College and sign up for a TSP agreement for guaranteed future transfer to Cal State LA.
- Use online CSU Transfer Planner tool to plan their courses and track their progress.
- Cal State LA will be hosting special presentations and events for TSP participants.




