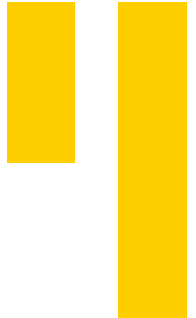

Fall 2024 Admission Guidance

- Apply online via the Cal State Apply application: **Oct 1- Nov 30, 2023**
- The California State University (CSU) no longer requires the ACT/SAT examinations for admission eligibility consideration. However, scores may be used for CSU English/Math placement.
- All Freshmen Admitted as Pre-Majors
- Students will need to report all A-G coursework – have transcripts handy and plan for adequate time
- Most admission decisions are made using self-reported information - answer all questions accurately and completely.



Freshman Admission Requirements

- Complete the “A-G” college prep courses with a grade of “C-” or better.
- Achieve a qualifying minimum overall post-9th grade “A-G” GPA:
 - California residents and graduates of CA high schools: **2.50 GPA**
 - Non-California residents: **3.00 GPA**
- Meet the Cal State LA ranking GPA cut-off;
- Graduate from high school, or earn a GED; and
- Applicants who do not meet the above GPAs may still be considered for admission through a **Multi-Factor Review Process (MFRP)**:
 - Satisfy the English Language Proficiency requirement (TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, or DuoLingo English) if at least 3 years of your high school coursework was not taken at a school where English is the only language of instruction.



Freshman A-G Subject Requirements

- A History & Social Science**
2 years (1 year of U.S. History and 1 year of social science)
- B English**
4 years required (ELD/ESL may be used for 9th grade English)
- C Math**
3 years required (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II; or Integrated Math I-III)
- D Laboratory Science**
2 years with a lab class (1 year Biological and 1 year Physical Sciences)
- E Language Other than English**
2 years of the same language
- F Visual and Performing Arts**
1 year (same discipline)
- G College Preparatory Electives**
1 year (from Area G or any additional A-F course)



Freshman GPA Calculation

GPA CALCULATION

- The high school GPA is based upon grades earned in all approved college preparatory courses taken in the 10th, 11th and 12th grade
- CSU will award honors points in the GPA calculation for up to 8 semesters of UC approved honors/AP/IB courses taken in 10th-12th grades (up to two courses taken in the 10th grade). No honors points are awarded for grades of Pass/Credit, D and F.

CREDIT/PASS GRADES

- Cal State LA will accept course Grades of "credit/pass" in 'A-G' courses completed in 2020 (Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall) and 2021 (Winter, Spring and Summer).
- All prior coursework must be graded and a grade of C- or better must be earned for the course to satisfy "A-G" requirements. Grades of credit/pass or no credit/non-passing will not be included in the calculation of high school GPA.



Multiple Factor Review Process (MFRP)

Except for Pre-Nursing, applicants who do not meet the ranking GPAs may still be considered for admission through a Multi-Factor Review Process (MFRP) if they meet all other requirements, and have the following minimum 'A-G' GPAs:

- CA residents or graduates of CA high schools: **2.00 GPA**
- Non-California residents that are graduates of non-CA high schools: **2.47 GPA**

Supplemental factors will be used to calculate a **Multi-Factor Admission Score (MFAS)** for each applicant. The MFAS may then be used for admission ranking.



Multi-Factor Review Process Components

For Fall 2024 admission, Cal State LA will be using the following supplemental factors to determine an applicant's **Multi-Factor Admission Score (MFAS)**:

- **Academic Factors (59%)**
 - 'A-G' course GPA
 - 'A-G' coursework above the required 15 years
- **Local Admissions Area (10%)**
- **Institutional Commitment (5%)**
 - Partnership Schools (Go East LA, Go Central, Pasadena Promise, etc.)
- **Applicant Attributes (26%)**
 - First generation
 - Low income
 - Foster Youth/Ward of the Court
 - Veteran/Military Status
 - Educational Programs Participation
 - Work Status (hours)
 - Extracurricular Activities (hours)

Applicants who go through the MFRP will be ranked by their **Multi-Factor Admission Score (MFAS)** and may be offered admission based on remaining space availability in the major or college.



Pre-Nursing Admission

- To be considered for admission to Pre-Nursing, freshman applicants must meet all the following minimum requirements:
 - Meet Cal State LA freshman admission requirements;
 - Have a minimum 'A-G' GPA of 3.50; and
 - Have earned 'B-' or better grades in the first attempt of these following year-long high school courses:
 - Intermediate Algebra, Algebra II, or Integrated Math III;
 - Biology with lab; and
 - Chemistry with lab.
- Students admitted to Cal State LA as Undecided, or to a major other than Pre-Nursing, will not be able to change their major to Pre-Nursing or Nursing.

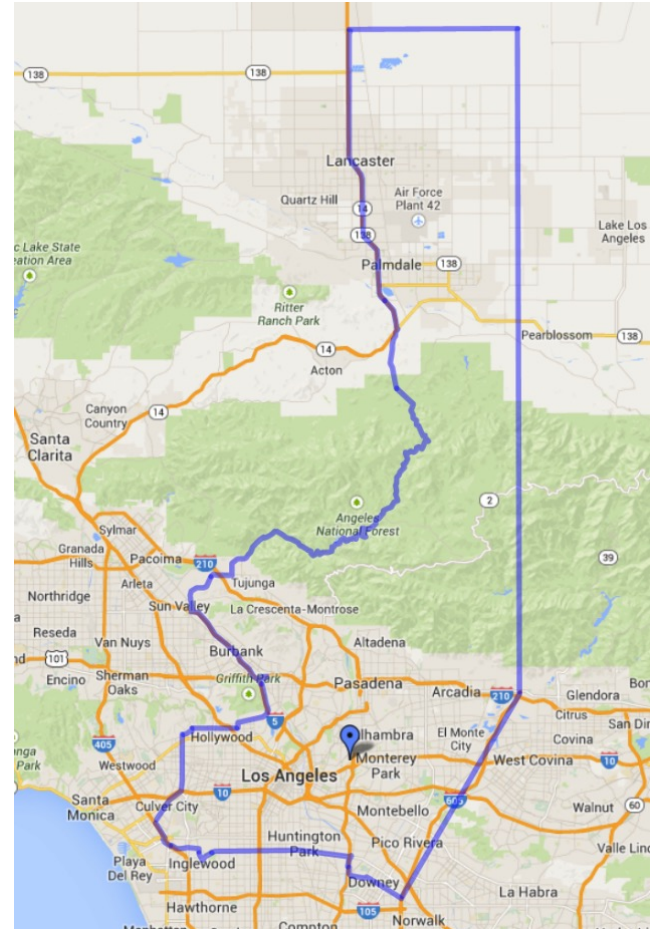




Local Area Preference

Freshman applicants who will graduate from a high school within Cal State LA's local admission area will receive local preference.

Except for Pre-Nursing, 'local' applicants will be guaranteed admission if they meet the minimum CSU Freshman Admission requirements and have an overall 'A-G' GPA of 2.70.

FRESHMAN ADMISSION ROUNDS



ROUND 1 LOCAL GUARANTEE (GPA Only)

Except for Pre-Nursing, CSU eligible local applicants who achieve an overall 'A-G' GPA of 2.70 or higher.

ROUND 2 GPA ONLY

Except for Pre-Nursing, CSU eligible local and non-local applicants who meet the Cal State LA GPA cut-off based on available space.

Fall 2023 GPA Cut Offs

Local: 2.6 | Non-Local: 2.85 | Out-of-State: 3.0

ROUND 3 MULTI-FACTOR REVIEW PROCESS

Except for Pre-Nursing, applicants who have at least a 2.00 GPA (2.47 non-CA Residents) and meet all other CSU admission requirements will be considered via the **Multi-Factor Review Process**.



Transfer Success Pathway (TSP)

- Inaugural Cohort – fall 2023 freshman:
 - Spring 2023 high school graduates
 - **237** students signed TSP agreements with Cal State LA
- Start at local CA Community College and sign up for a TSP agreement for guaranteed future transfer to Cal State LA.
- Use online CSU Transfer Planner tool to plan their courses and track their progress.
- Cal State LA will be hosting special presentations and events for TSP participants.

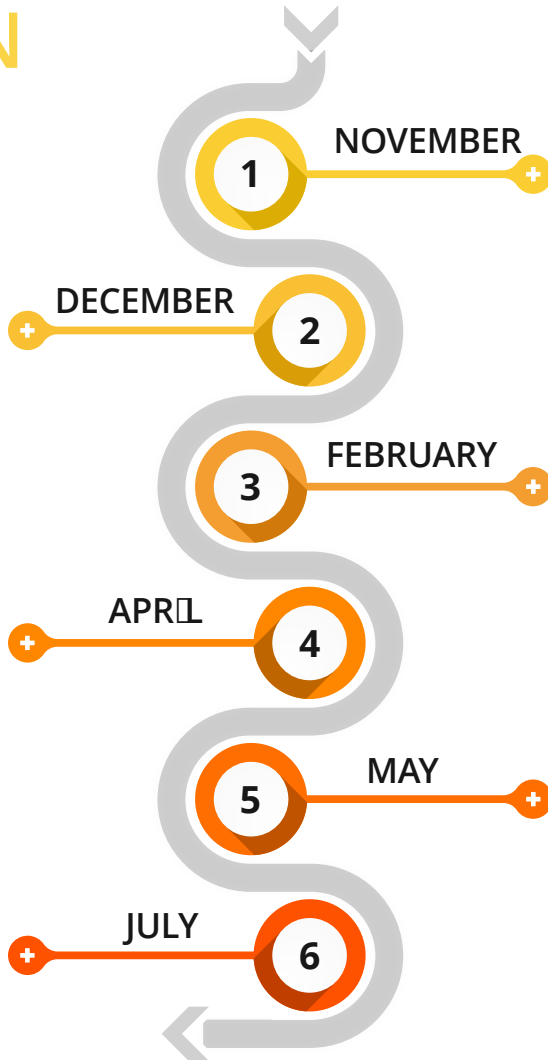

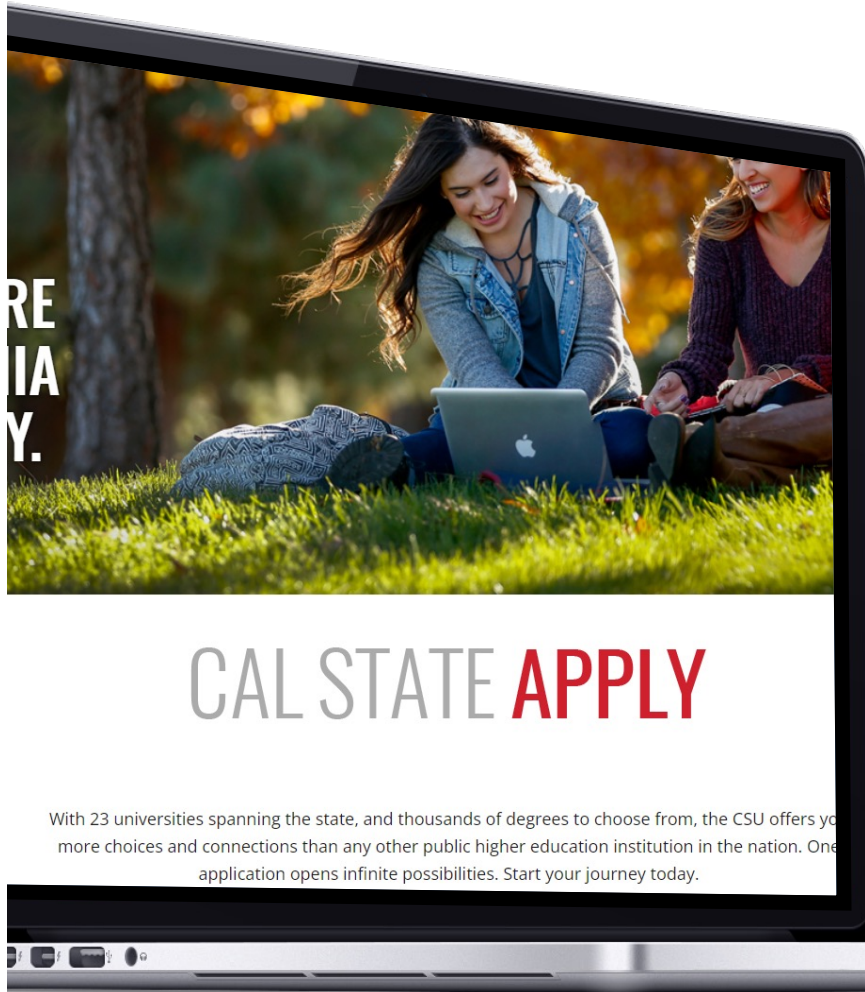


Golden Eagle Fest On-Site Admissions

- To participate, students must:
 - Submit the Fall 2024 [Cal State Apply application](#) by Thursday, Nov 9; and
 - Sign up for [Golden Eagle Fest On-Site Admission](#) by Monday, Nov 13.
- Who is eligible for On-site Admissions on Nov 18?
 - Applicants must have completed all coursework in the United States. No international coursework.
 - First-time Freshman Applicant requirements
 - Meet minimum Cal State LA freshman admission requirements by the end of Spring 2024; and
 - Have a minimum qualifying 2.85 'A-G' GPA at time of application.
- Which majors are not available for On-site Admission?
 - Pre-Nursing

Cal State Apply Tips

- Allow Pop-Ups from Cal State Apply
- Use an email that they will have continuous access to – do not use school email address
- Write down CAS ID and their login information
- Enter full, legal name in the application
- If they have one, don't leave SSN blank
- **Have unofficial transcripts for reference**
- If taken, report test scores (SAT, ACT, AP, IB)
- If applying to EOP, have at least 2 people and their email addresses ready
- Use the Cal State Apply Applicant Help Center, including CHAT!





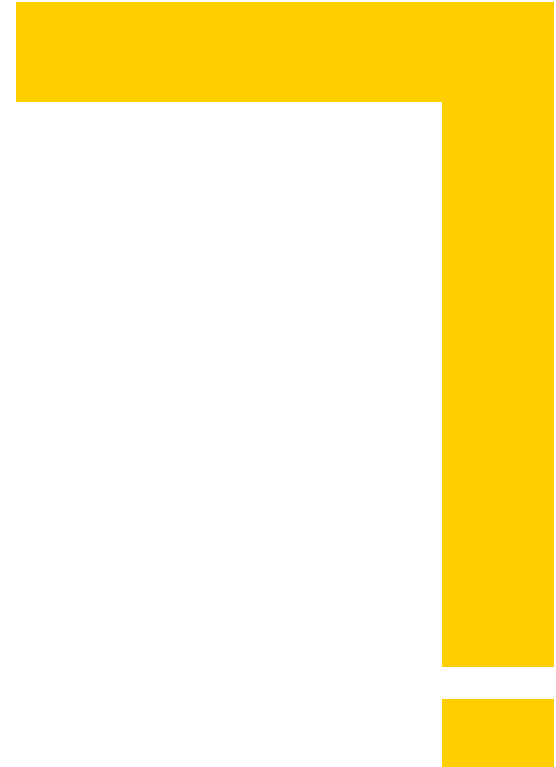
Common Senior Year Pit Falls

- Not passing English or Math courses with grades of 'C-' or better.
- Not completing courses as planned, including repeated courses.
- Letting their overall A-G GPA fall lower than their end of junior year GPA (used for admission offer).
- Not finishing all high school graduation requirements by the end of Spring 2024.
- Forgetting to submit official final high school transcripts with posted graduation date by July 15.
- Not applying to Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) – eligible students should apply and complete the application by Jan 15.
