2.0 INTRODUCTION

This report presents the findings of the Microbiological Air Sampling performed for the Biological Sciences Building – Basement – 3rd Floor located at 5151 State University Dr., in Los Angeles, California.

2.1 Authorization

Authorization to perform the Microbiological Ambient Air Sampling was given by the California State University, Los Angeles (CSULA) representative Ms. Barbara L. Queen.

2.2 Purpose

The purpose of the Microbiological Ambient Air Sampling was to identify any suspect Microbiological / Fungal Spores throughout the affected areas of the Basement through the 3rd Floor.

2.3 Scope of Services

GETC's services for this Microbiological Ambient Air Sampling were comprised of the following task:

1. Air Sampling

Details on the methods used for the tasks listed in the scope of work are given in the Section 3.0 Methodology.

3.0 METHODOLOGY

This section includes the description of the methodologies used to perform the Microbiological Ambient Air Sampling. These methodologies include Air Sampling and Analysis.

3.1 Microbiological Ambient Air Sampling

 Collect and submit for analysis Air samples for Microbiological/Fungal Spores within the Biological Sciences Building – Basement – 3rd Floor.

3.2 Sampling Procedures and Analysis

Sampling Procedure

The inspector collected Fifteen (15) Air samples for Microbiological spores. Sampling was limited to the Biological Sciences Building – Basement – 3rd Floor located at 5151 State University Dr., in Los Angeles, California.

EPA guidelines were used to determine the sampling protocol. Sampling locations were chosen to be representative of the unit.

The samples were numbered and shipped to a laboratory accredited under the American Industrial Hygiene Association (AIHA) and Environmental Microbiology Proficiency Analytical Sampling Program (EMPAT).

Chain-of-Custody Procedures

Chain-of-Custody documents possession of the samples from the time they are collected until they have been analyzed and are stored. Custody documentation must be followed whenever materials are received, collected, transferred, stored, analyzed, or destroyed.

The original Chain-of-Custody is to accompany the materials at all times. Custody documentation will begin at the time a sample is collected. Each transferor should retain a copy of the Chain-of-Custody record.

Laboratory Quality Control Program

Pasteur Laboratory maintains an in-house quality control program. This program involves reanalysis of a minimum of ten percent of all samples, precision and accuracy controls, use of standard bulk reference materials, maintenance of national and state accreditation, participation in external and internal proficiency Sampling programs, and confirmation of analyst experience and qualifications in compliance with specific internal training and competency requirements. Additionally, all quality assurance/quality control and operational procedures are documented in manual form and retained on site as reference materials for all analytical staff.

3.3 Report Format

This report has been organized in a manner that represents the data in several forms to best suit the needs of the building owner. The "Executive Summary" provides a description of the facility and analytical results for each suspect material. The "Findings" describe the materials found and provides recommendations. The "Materials Spreadsheets", Appendix A, contains detailed information on the locations of the areas sampled. The "Analytical Report", Appendix B, is a listing of samples taken and their mold content.

4.0 FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

4.1 General Summary

On November 7, 2025, Global Environmental Training and Consulting, Inc. performed Microbiological Air Sampling at the Biological Sciences Building – Basement – 3rd Floor located at 5151 State University Dr., in Los Angeles, California. Air sampling results concluded that the current levels of spore counts found in all indoor samples are below the outdoors (background) Sample #A-30.

Complete sampling and analysis of suspect mold spores are given in Appendix B.

4.2 Recommendations

Global Environmental Training & Consulting, Inc. (GETC) has reviewed the results of the air samples and has no other recommendations at this time.

5.0 WARRANTY

The field and laboratory results reported herein are considered sufficient in detail and scope to determine the presence of microbiological airborne spores in the Biological Sciences Building – Basement - 3rd Floor. Global Environmental Training & Consulting, Inc. warrants that the findings contained herein have been prepared in general accordance with accepted professional practices at the time of its preparation as applied by similar professionals in the community. Changes in the state of the art or in applicable regulations cannot be anticipated and have not been addressed in this report.

The survey and analytical methods have been used to provide the client with information regarding the presence of airborne fungal spores existing in the Biological Sciences Building – Basement - 3rd Floor at the time of inspection. Test results are valid only for the areas tested. There is a distinct possibility that conditions may exist which could not be identified within the scope of the study or which were not apparent during the site visit.
