Frequently Asked Questions

C-3DPAC (CSU 3D-Printed Fixed-Wing Aircraft Competition at Cal State LA)

- Q1. Does a pilot need a Pilot license such as Part 107? The Indemnification asks if the pilot has an FAA pilot license. They have 'TRUST' certifications. Will it be enough?
- A1. For C-3DPAC, the FAA Trust Certification is sufficient.
- Q2. Are Part-time Community College Students eligible for the competition?
- A2. Yes. The rules will be updated to allow for part-time as well as full-time students.
- Q3. May a high-school team compete in C-3DPAC?
- A3. Yes, but there are some additional administrative requirements. Please contact us as you register, for more information.
- Q4. What is the date of the event?
- A4. The event is Saturday, February MAY 18, 2024. There was a typographical error in one place in Rev 1 of the rules referencing the date from last year's event. This has been corrected in Rev 2.
