In order to address intermittent performance issues, our teams have temporarily reverted the STA 25.13 release to production sites.

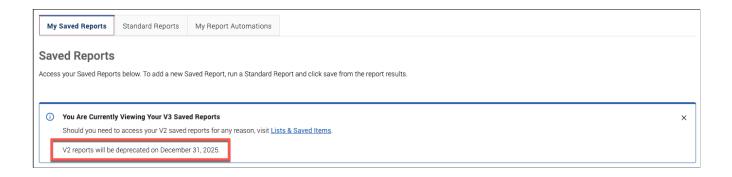
Announcements

Legacy V2 Report Sunset Date Visible in Navigate360 Staff

Navigate360 for Student Success introduced V3 reports in September 2023 with an intention to sunset the legacy V2 reports once users had enough time to get acquainted with the new format.

On December 31, 2025, legacy V2 reports will be sunset, which means end users must recreate any saved or scheduled V2 reports into V3 format before December 31st, 2025. As part of this change, information about the deprecation date is now reflected in your institution's Navigate360 for Student Success site, as shown in the screenshot below.

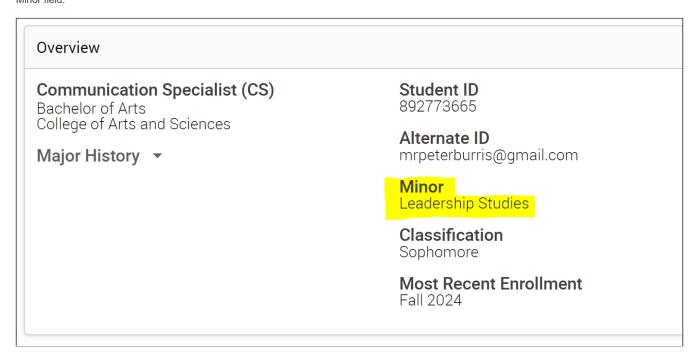
New Features & Enhancements

Accessibility

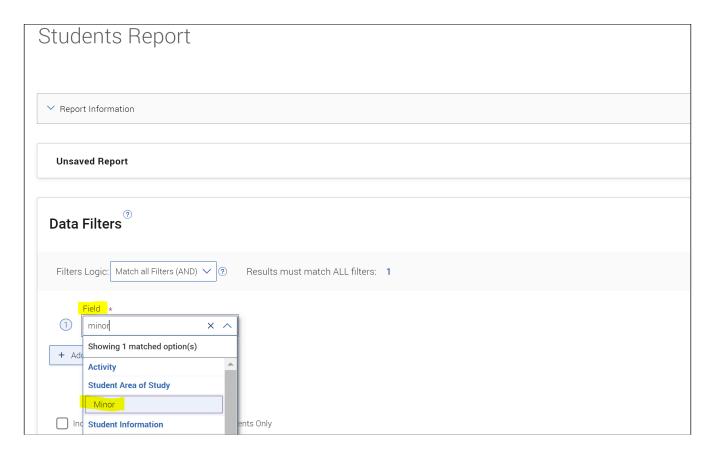
As part of our continued accessibility work, Navigate360 has made accessibility improvements and fixes across the Navigate360 for Student Success platform. Included in these improvements are updates to the tabs that appear across multiple pages including Staff Home, Student Home, Staff Profile, Student Profile, View Care Units, Create Care Unit, and Travel Letters. Users will notice a horizontal scroll bar when zoomed in or when many tabs appear at once. These accessible tabs assist with screen reader and other assistive technology performance.

Standalone Minor Field on Student Profile

This release allows partners to display student minor as a standalone field on the <u>Student Profile Overview page</u> alongside other key student data such as major, Student ID, and Classification. Multiple minors can display for a student simultaneously. Note that there is a 255-character limit for the Minor field.



Once enabled, *Minor* will be a filter in several V3 reports, including Students, Students Enrollments, Alerts, Attendance, Assignments, Notes, and Cases, as in the example below.



If your institution is interested in displaying standalone Minors, submit a ticket to the Partner Support team (<u>Navigate360TechSupport@eab.com</u>) to open a request to enable the new standalone minor field. From there, our teams will collaborate with you to move any minor data currently displayed in your site (e.g. categories) to the new field, as well as identify whether any new files will need to be generated to support this request.

Note. The standalone minor field is available to partners with the Core package or higher due to data availability.

Fixes

Various Fixes

- · Removed a limitation that was causing the Staff Dashboard to restrict the My Students chart to 25 students.
- Sorting by the Full Name column now works on all Campaign metrics pages. When sorting by Full Name, campaign recipients are sorted
 alphabetically by last name.
- · Fixed performance issues causing the Students Enrolled In Term tab to time out when viewing Enrollment Campaigns.
- · Improved performance for administering Appointment Questions templates having large number of location/service combinations.
- The Created On column in V3 reports was sorting as a string, instead of as a date. This has been fixed and it should now sort the way a date would.
- · Fixed an issue where student appointments marked as Not Attended To from a drop-in queue were displaying as ongoing.

Anne Van Der Karr: Thanks for asking this question. The stand-alone minor field will not be available as a filter in Advanced Search. Instead it will be available as a field in V3 reports. My recommendation to leverage minor as a filter for creating Messaging Campaigns would be to create an automated action based on a saved V3 report, leveraging the minors filter.
