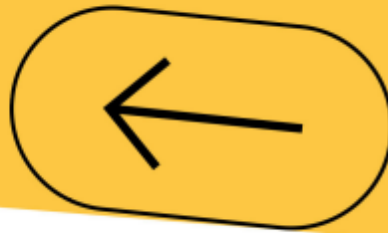

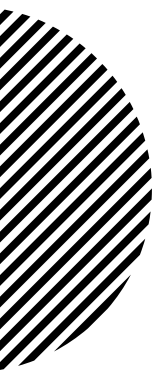
BIG THINGS HAPPENING IN 2022
