



New Graduate Student Checklist

This checklist will prepare and help you transition smoothly into our academic community.

- Activate your [MyCalStateLA](#) ID to access your email, Wi-Fi, parking information and more. Access GET by clicking on the GET icon in the [MyCalStateLA portal](#). It is essential to receive important updates and instructions from the university. If you have questions, reach out to IT HelpDesk for assistance [Student IT Resource Guide \(PDF\)](#).
- Submit your official transcripts if your To-Do list is pending. To be considered final, the transcript must include the final term's grades and Sposted degree with conferral date.

- Get to know your [Program Advisor](#) and check prerequisite requirements.
- International students** should check [International Program Office](#) (IPO) website for I-20, advising, CPT, OPT and other important information. IPO will be communicating with you through your Cal State LA email address, so make sure to activate your [MyCalStateLA portal](#). and regularly check your university email. This is crucial to receive important updates and instructions.
