The College of Professional and Global Education



The College of Professional and Global Education (PaGE) is one of eight colleges at Cal State LA and provides flexible, relevant, and practical educational pathways, preparing organizations to serve, and succeed in their local and global communities.

- PaGE offers extended education degree, certificate, and professional training programs at Cal State LA Downtown (DTLA), at the university's main campus, and in the San Gabriel Valley
- The college also oversees international programs for Cal State LA including exchange and study abroad for domestic students

Pharmacy Technician Program

- This program is taught by experts in the pharmaceutical field
- This program is a comprehensive 50-hour course that prepares students to enter the pharmacy field and take the PTCB exam
- Course content includes medical terminology specific to pharmacy, reading and interpreting prescriptions, and defining drugs by generic and brand names
- Students will learn dosage calculations, IV flow rates, drug compounding, dose conversions, dispensing of prescriptions, inventory control, and billing and reimbursement
- Students are expected to have completed high-school level math and science courses before enrolling in this program. A high school diploma or GED is required to sit for the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board's (PTCB) exam

- Program is offered every Fall, Spring, and Summer
- Program completers will receive a Certificate of Completion
