Funding for Early Childhood Special Education and Visual Impairment Credential Programs

California State University, Los Angeles

The program will integrate evidence-based, interdisciplinary training with a strong emphasis on family-centered practices that foster early literacy and math development.

To be eligible:

- Students must be enrolled in the ECSE or VI credential option
- Funded scholars will have a 2-year payback requirement for each year of funding received, working as an ECSE teacher or TVI
- Scholarship may impact Finanical Aid calculation
- Scholars must be US citizen
- Recipients are required to fulfill additional grant obligations
