

Complete Cal State LA's **Online Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Nutritional** Science to Qualify for a **Dietetic Internship and Become a RDN**

If you've been held back by missing courses required for a dietetic internship, we have exciting news for you! The California State University, Los Angeles (Cal State LA) College of Professional and Global Education now offers an online Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Nutritional Science Program, designed specifically to help individuals like you qualify for dietetic internships and take that crucial next in step vour professional journey.

Why Become a RDN?

To achieve RDN status, a candidate must complete a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution, an accredited supervised practice program (such as a dietetic internship), and a graduate degree (e.g., a master's degree) in any field. www.calwic.org PAGE 47 The Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Nutritional Science Program is a comprehensive, 35-unit program that provides the essential courses needed to qualify for supervised practice. This program is 100% online and designed with flexibility in mind, making it easier for full-time employees to balance their current job and education.

- Three Semesters Long: Complete the program in just three semesters.
- Flexible Schedule: Some courses are asynchronous, allowing you to complete coursework on your schedule, whether it's evenings or weekends. Other courses will meet in the evenings, possibly around 5:00 pm, although specific times are yet to be determined.
- Transfer Credit: Cal State LA offers free transcript assessments to determine if prior coursework can be transferred, with up to eight units eligible for transfer credit.
- GPA Admission Requirement: Minimum GPA of 2.5 in the last 60 semester or 90 quarter units
- Affordable and Accessible: The cost is \$400 per credit, totaling approximately \$14,000 for the full program. Financial aid and scholarships are available to help you invest in your future without financial stress.



Who Should Enroll?

This program is perfect for WIC employees who have already completed a bachelor's degree in a health-related field but need specific nutrition courses to qualify for a dietetic internship.
