

We are happy to be adding the new position of part-time Associate Teacher to the infant/toddler classroom support system. These associate teachers are hired through our corporate agency and are not required to leave the program once they graduate from Cal State LA. This allows us to keep these teachers for a longer stretch of time to add more consistency to the program. These Associate Teachers will also be required to hold a Teacher’s Permit so they will be able to step into to a lead role should the main teacher need to be out of the room.

Staff Development and Program Quality Assessment

- The Center has been providing on-going **RIE training** for our Infant/Toddler teachers. Teachers have been working with a RIE coach every other week to reflect on and implement the RIE approach. For more info on the RIE Approach: <https://rie.org/>
- The **Preschool Teachers** have been training and working on preparing the classrooms and staff for an observation using The **Classroom Assessment Scoring System® (CLASS)**. For more info on CLASS go to: <https://teachstone.com/class/>
- Subsidized families will be emailed to take part in a **survey** during mid-May from the California Department of Education. The survey will provide us data we can use to reflect and improve upon the program for families on a grant program.
