### Additional Graduation Requirements

- Completion of all Lower Division GE units
- Effective Fall 2021, students are required to take the GE Area F: Ethnic Studies course as part of the General Education Program. Meet with your academic advisor for more information.
- 9 units of upper-division GE divided into 3 areas: Block B - Natural Sciences (3 units), Block C - Arts & Humanities (3 units), and Block D - Social Sciences (3 units)
- U.S. History (American Institutions Requirement (AM1))
- U.S. Constitution/State & Local Govt. (American Institutions Requirement (AM2))
- Civic Learning/Community Engagement Requirement (6 semester units). One (cl) course must be completed at the upper division general education level.
- Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete one race/ethnicity (re) course and one diversity (d) course or another race/ethnicity (re) course.
- Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) courses, with at least one in their major.
