

ABOUT THE HONORS COLLEGE APPLICATION PROCESS

We encourage you to apply to the Cal State LA Honors College. Benefits of joining the Cal State LA Honors College include being part of a supportive Honors learning community, dedicated study and social spaces, small interactive classes, Honors College scholarship opportunities, priority registration, recognition at graduation, individualized advising with an emphasis on career development and graduate school, and access to the broad range of Cal State LA undergraduate research and other creative academic opportunities.

The Cal State LA Honors College is for motivated students who are interested in actively participating in our intellectual, social, and community engagement programs. Students can enter the Cal State LA Honors College as first-year, transfers or as continuing juniors. Selection will be based on a comprehensive review of application materials, including written essays, letters of recommendation, and GPA. New students must also be admitted to the University.

INCOMING FRESHMEN REQUIREMENTS

We recommend that first-time freshmen applicants have a cumulative, weighted high school GPA of 3.5 or higher.

INCOMING UPPER-DIVISION TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

We recommend that incoming Junior transfers have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher in their college coursework.

CONTINUING STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Continuing Cal State LA students may also apply to the Honors College provided they have attained a minimum GPA of 3.5 or higher in their college coursework.


*Important note for all groups: Meeting these minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the Honors College.

APPLYING TO THE HONORS COLLEGE INVOLVES A THREE-STEP PROCESS:


1. Apply to Cal State LA through Cal State Apply: www2.calstate.edu/apply. (You have completed this step and are now ready for step # 2).
