KING HALL PLAYGROUND SITE (AFTER)

- Sanitized play area
- Increased vegetation
- Small, mobile tiered planters for herbs (basil, mint, etc.)
 - Small fruits and vegetables (cherry tomatoes, strawberries, etc.)
- Flowers and bushes to attract biodiversity
 - plant sustainability, pollination (butterflies, humming birds)
 - Plants for California weather and attract pollinators (Lavender, Erigeron glaucus, Beardtongue)
- Healthy relationship with surrounding environment
- Routinely maintain shrubs, plants, produce, etc.
