Our Fall 2024 Pedagogical Journey...

We have made some changes to our office entry hallway. The documentation you see posted is a culmination of our work and study with the Boulder Journey School (BJS) in Boulder, Colorado. As you may know, the full-time staff visited BJS last April to participate in a study tour focusing on pedagogical documentation and contextual curriculum development. To build upon what we learned in Colorado, the teachers continued their work into fall 2024 by participating in bi-weekly Zoom meetings with a BJS faculty member and our Education Specialist, Jana Maudonnet. Meetings focused on in-depth study of children’s interests and classroom identity at a particular point in time. Teachers and children were able to tap into concepts and themes and the documentation represents their experiences through this process. Teachers and administration used meeting times to discuss and critique each others documentation as a way to reflect and build upon our philosophy and pedagogical development. \*We are excited to be sending another small group of teachers to BJS in April for those who were not able to attend the study tour last year.

Center Updates

- **New Sand:** Sand has been replaced in all sandboxes throughout the Center.
- **New Burglar Alarm:** A new burglar alarm has been installed that is connected to motion sensors throughout the main building. Should someone try to break into the Center, campus police will be notified immediately. Damaged cameras have also been replaced.
- **Panic Button Installed:** For added security, campus police has installed a panic button at the front desk that will notify campus police should the need arise.
- **CSU Children’s Center Director’s Conference:** Jim attended a Children’s Center Director’s conference at Fresno State University 2/5-2/7 to meet and discuss current topics and trends relevant to CSU children’s centers.
- **Staff Development:** The Center is providing **RIE training** for our new infant/toddler teachers who have recently joined our team. Teachers will be working with a RIE coach over the semester to reflect on and implement the RIE approach. For more info on the RIE Approach: <https://rie.org/>.
- **I.C.E. Protocol:** Teachers/Staff have been trained on what to do if I.C.E. were to show up at the Center.
