California State University, Los Angeles

California State University, Los Angeles (Cal State LA) has been awarded a \$380,000 grant from the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) to conduct research designed to improve cyber security. Cal State LA will collaborate with NATO experts and scientists from Italy, Israel and Pakistan on the project. Marina Mondin is the grant's principal investigator and an associate professor of electrical and computer engineering at Cal State LA. **Read more**

Central Michigan University

Ben Swarts, an assistant professor of chemistry and biochemistry at Central Michigan University (CMU), will receive \$660,000 over five years to do bacteria research. Swarts, completing his fourth year at CMU, recently received the National Science Foundation's highly competitive Faculty Early Career Development Program award, open only to pre-tenured professors. **Read more**

Saginaw Valley State University (Mich.)

Saginaw Valley State University (SVSU) has won federal funding to improve health care delivery for residents in rural areas. A grant of nearly \$1.4 million will support an innovative approach that will place graduate students in SVSU's nurse practitioner program into the field to provide patient care, and will prepare them for careers in rural settings. **Read more**

The Salisbury University (SU) Nursing Department has received nearly \$4 million from the Maryland Higher Education Commission to develop two new programs.
