Millersville University's (MU) It's on Us team was awarded a grant of \$30,000 by the state to continue these efforts. They plan on using this grant to continue to support the It's on Us program; develop a Title IX peer education program; host speaker events; offer training for staff, faculty and students at MU regarding sexual assault; participate in the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators' (NASPA) Culture of Respect Collaborative; and much more.
