Flute Audition Requirements

Applicants for admission to undergraduate and graduate degree programs as flute majors should bring copies of the music to be performed. All auditions will include opportunities for applicants to demonstrate their sight-reading ability.

Etudes and pieces selected for the audition need not be memorized.

Flute – Bachelor of Arts and BM in Performance or Music Education

Candidates are required to perform two contrasting movements from the standard solo flute repertoire, or one movement and a standard etude.

Entering students should also be ready to perform major scales one octave through four flats and four sharps

Repertoire should be selected from the traditional and contemporary solo flute literature demonstrating both technical and musical development.

Flute – MM Performance

Candidates should prepare three contrasting selections of their choice representative of the major solo flute repertoire. Pieces should be selected from the traditional and contemporary solo literature demonstrating both technical and musical development. (i.e. at least one piece should be a concerto or a sonata). Selected program must represent at least two different musical periods.
