Measuring Student Outcomes

Student Outcome Dimensions

- Educational
 - e.g., graduation rates
- Instructional
 - e.g., student learning outcomes
- Societal and Life
 - e.g., employment rates, life-long learning, contributions to society

Assessing Societal and Life outcomes

- Employment: Employment Development Department (EDD) statistics
- Graduate School: National Student Clearinghouse data
- Anecdotal data: Famous alumni!
- Alumni surveys

Cal State LA Alumni

- More than 200,000 graduates!
- Almost 50,000 bachelors recipients potentially accessible via email.

Previous Alumni Survey

- Bachelors recipients only
- Done in 1996 twenty years ago!
- Only 764 responses
- Only 8% of which were beyond two years from graduation

Current Alumni Survey

- Bachelors recipients only
- 15,646 graduates with valid email addresses were invited
- A variation of the 1/5/10 model:
