- 4. 4.1 It was m/s/f (Beer) to amend line 9 of document 05-1.1 by deleting the words <u>categories A and B and must have at least a satisfactory record in category C</u> and replacing it with CATEGORY A AND EITHER CATEGORY B OR CATEGORY C.
 - 4.2 It was m/s/p (Dewey) to amend lines 20 and 21 on page 7 of document 05-1 by deleting the word <u>Associate</u> and inserting the words PROVOST AND and inserting the words OR DESIGNEE after the word "Affairs."
 - 4.3 It was m/s/ (Baaske) to amend line 26 on page 7 of document 05-1 by deleting the phrase <u>however</u>, is one of degree, not kind, and it.
 - 4.4 Senator Sharp suggested that the Baaske motion be amended to include deleting the words <u>This difference</u> and inserting the words to THESE DIFFERENCES.
 - 4.5 The suggestion made by Senator Sharp was accepted as a friendly amendment.
 - 4.6 The Baaske motion was approved as amended.
 - 4.7 It was m/s/p (Cleman) to amend document 05-1 by replacing lines 4-19 on page 8 with the second amendment on document 05-1.1.
 - 4.8 Discussion ensued about the issue of hiring associate and full professors with tenure and the Chair announced that the Executive Committee would agendize the issue for referral to the Faculty Policy Committee.
 - 4.9 It was m/s/p (Krilowicz) to amend line 38 on page 2 of document 05-1 by deleting the phrase <u>be taken into account</u> and inserting the phrase GUIDE THE EVALUATION MADE.
 - 4.10 It was m/s/ (Zepeda) to amend line 31 on page 3 of document 05-1 by inserting the words OR DEPARTMENT CHAIR at the end of the sentence.
 - 4.11 Senator Baaske suggested that the Zepeda motion include adding the words AS SPECIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT RTP DOCUMENT.
 - 4.12 The suggestion made by Senator Baaske was not accepted as a friendly amendment.
 - 4.13 Senator DeChaine suggested that the Zepeda motion be amended by changing the words to be added to the end of the sentence to OR, IN THE ABSENCE OF ONE, THE DEPARTMENT CHAIR.
 - 4.14 The suggestion made by Senator DeChaine was accepted as a friendly amendment.
 - 4.15 Senator Dewey suggested as an editorial amendment that the DeChaine amendment be changed to read: OR, IN ITS ABSENCE, THE DEPARMENT CHAIR.
 - 4.16 It was agreed by consensus to accept the suggestion made by Senator Dewey as editorial.
 - 4.17 The Zepeda motion failed.
 - 4.18 Senator Gutierrez indicated that the word "performance" was not spelled correctly on the second amendment on documents 05-1.1.

4.19 It was m/s/ (LaPolt) to amend line 25 on page 2 of document 05-1 (distributed as an information item) by adding a new box and the word OUTSTANDING above the box for "satisfactory or better."

- 4.20 Debate ensued and the LaPolt motion was withdrawn.
- 4.21 It was m/s/p (Cleman) to amend lines 22 to 24 on page 2 of document 05-1 (distributed as an information item) by inserting the phrase AND IN TERMS OF THE TOTAL PERFORMANCE after the word "category"; inserting the words IN ADDITION before the sentence beginning with "The summary"; and deleting the remainder of the language on Lines 23 and 24 replacing it with SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: THE COMMITTEE FINDS THIS PERFORMANCE:
- 4.22 The recommendation was APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY as amended (05-1).
