It is my great pleasure to welcome you to the 2018 Civic University $^{\circ}$ 2.0 program. Civic U $^{\circ}$ is a non-credit certificate program developed by the Pat Brown Institute for Public Affairs at Cal State LA in association with the Office of Mayor Eric Garcetti, supported by Cal State LA's College of Professional and Global Education. We are delighted that the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment has once again invited us to offer this program to the Los Angeles Neighborhood Councils.
