Emeritus:

The honorary adjective granted to a retired professor by the University President based on the recommendations of the department/school, and college upon honorably retiring from their assigned duties.



The Purpose of the Association

Established on February 9, 1978, the Purpose of the California State University, Los Angeles Emeriti Association is to:

- 1. Secure, enhance, and maintain the status, rights, and privileges of the emeriti faculty of California State University, Los Angeles.
- 2. Encourage members to carry on scholarly endeavors contributing to the educational community of the University.
- 3. Serve the educational community at the University, college, school and department/division levels.
- 4. Contribute to the University's mission by such means as may be determined by The Association.
- 5. Provide for the general welfare of the members of the Association.

Regular membership is open to all faculty who are granted emeritus status by California State University, Los Angeles.

Emeriti and current CSULA faculty make presentations to seniors in metropolitan Los Angeles for enrichment and intellectual stimulation.

Forums to address timely issues/topics of special interest to the Emeriti and University communities are scheduled based on interest, importance, or timeliness.
