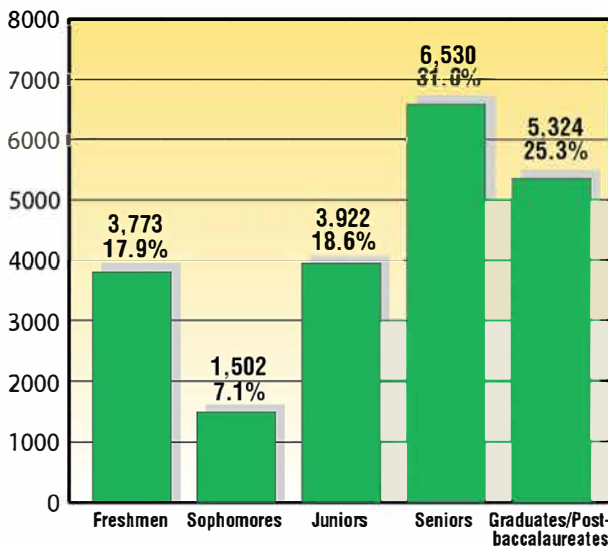

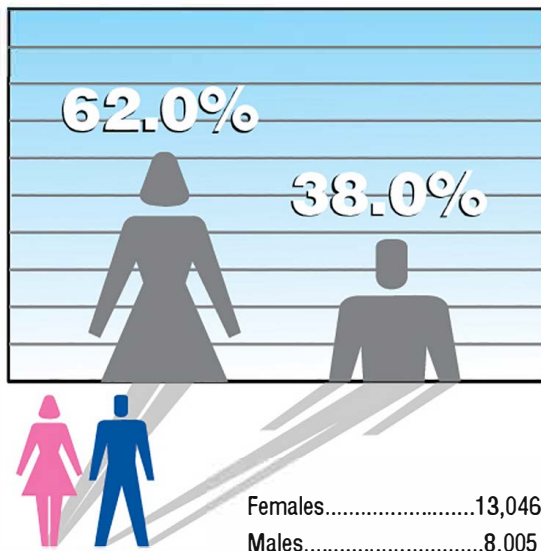
The Offices of Institutional Effectiveness and Public Affairs have developed Cal State L.A. Facts to provide the campus community with pertinent information about the University. Data are presented for Fall Quarter 2007 (unless noted otherwise), since the fall term is generally considered representative of the academic year.

- Cal State L.A. enrolled 21,051 students in Fall 2007. The full-time equivalent student (FTES) figure was 16,687. (FTES calculations for degree-seeking graduate students have been redefined for the CSU starting 2006-2007.)

Headcount by Gender

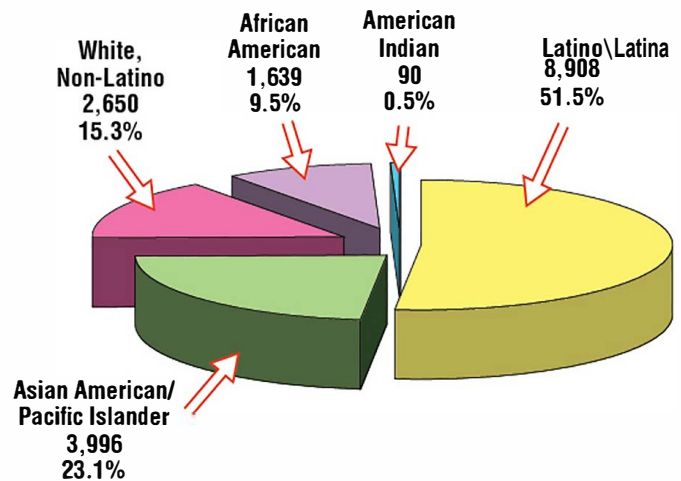

- The average study load is 12.4 units for undergraduates, 8.7 for graduates/postbaccalaureates, and 11.5 overall.

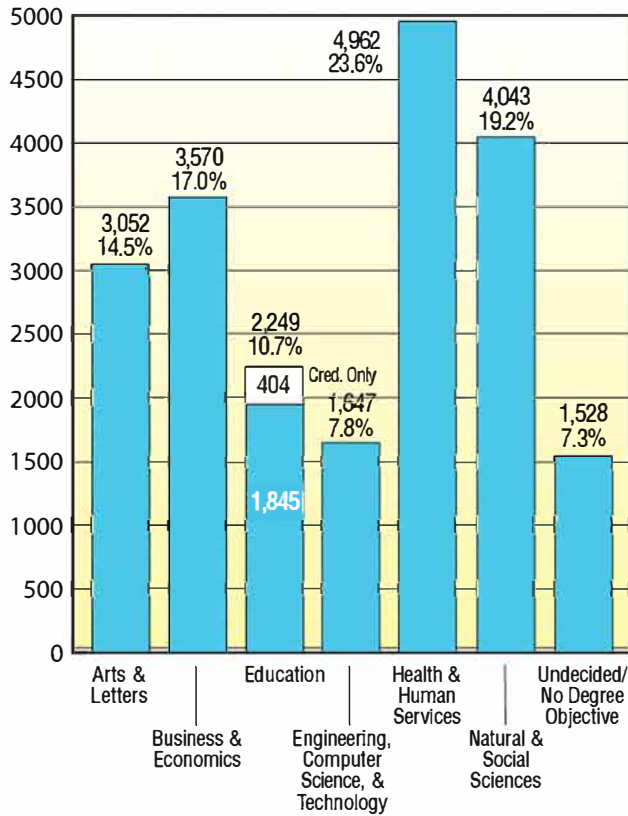
Headcount by Race/Ethnic Group*



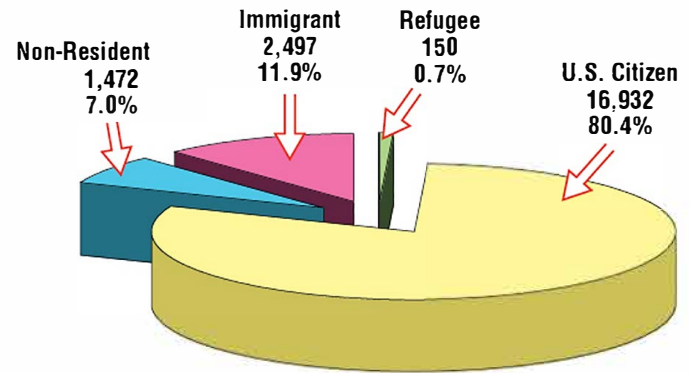

Headcount by Citizenship Status

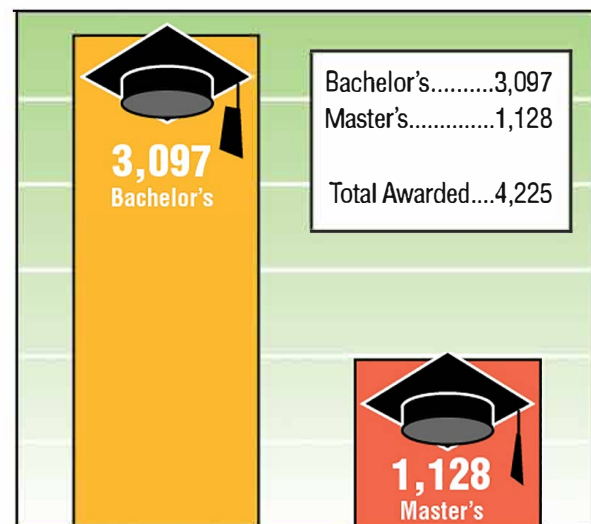
