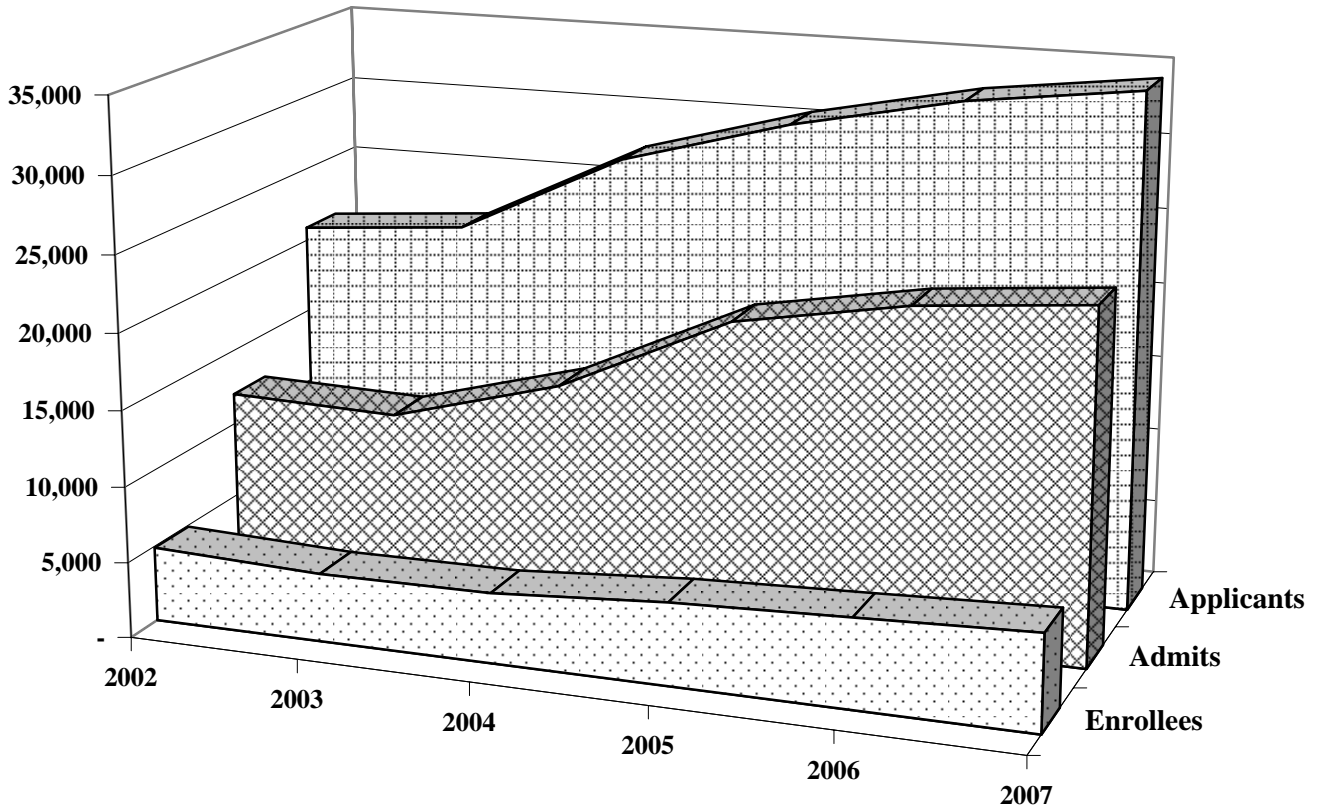

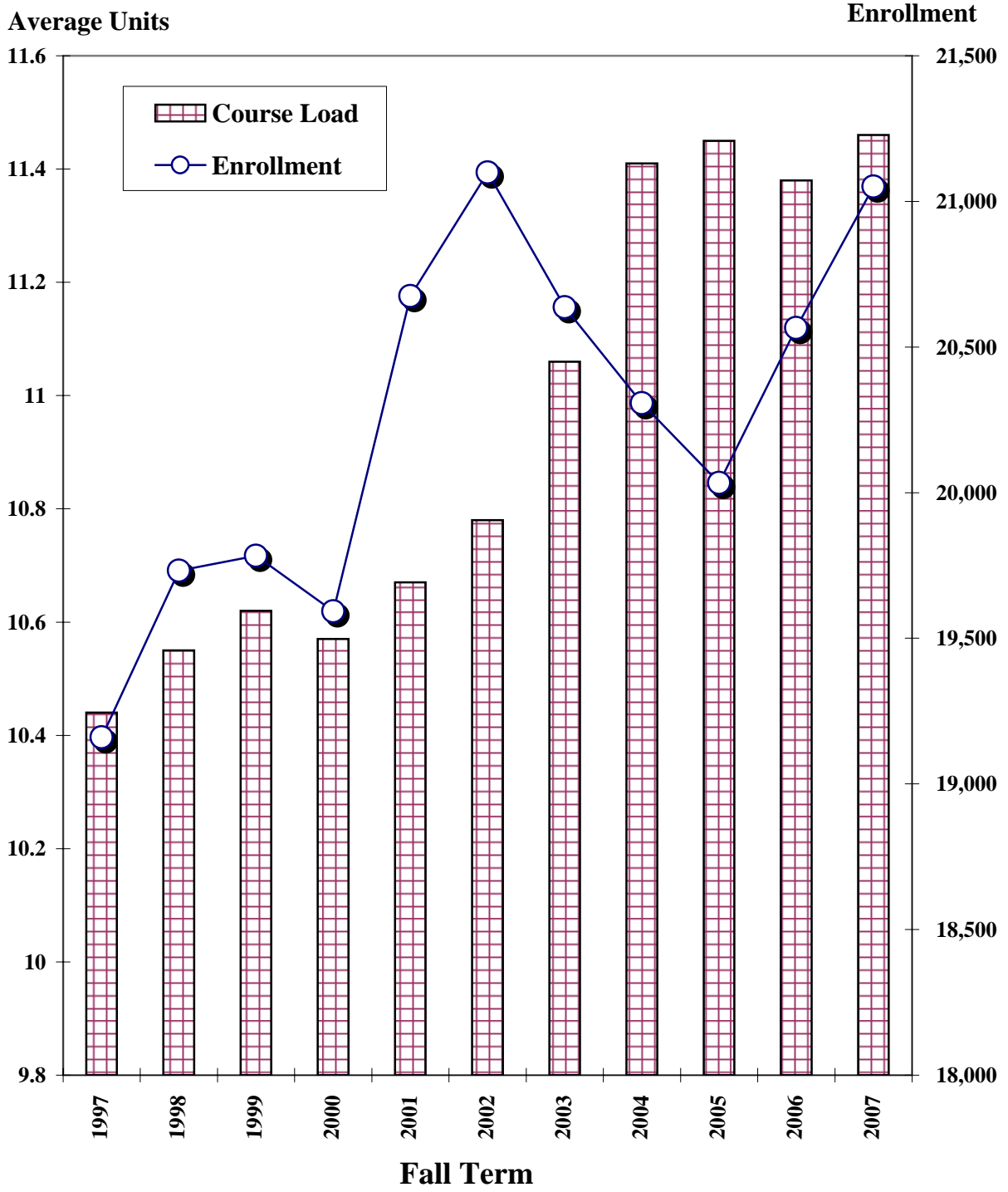

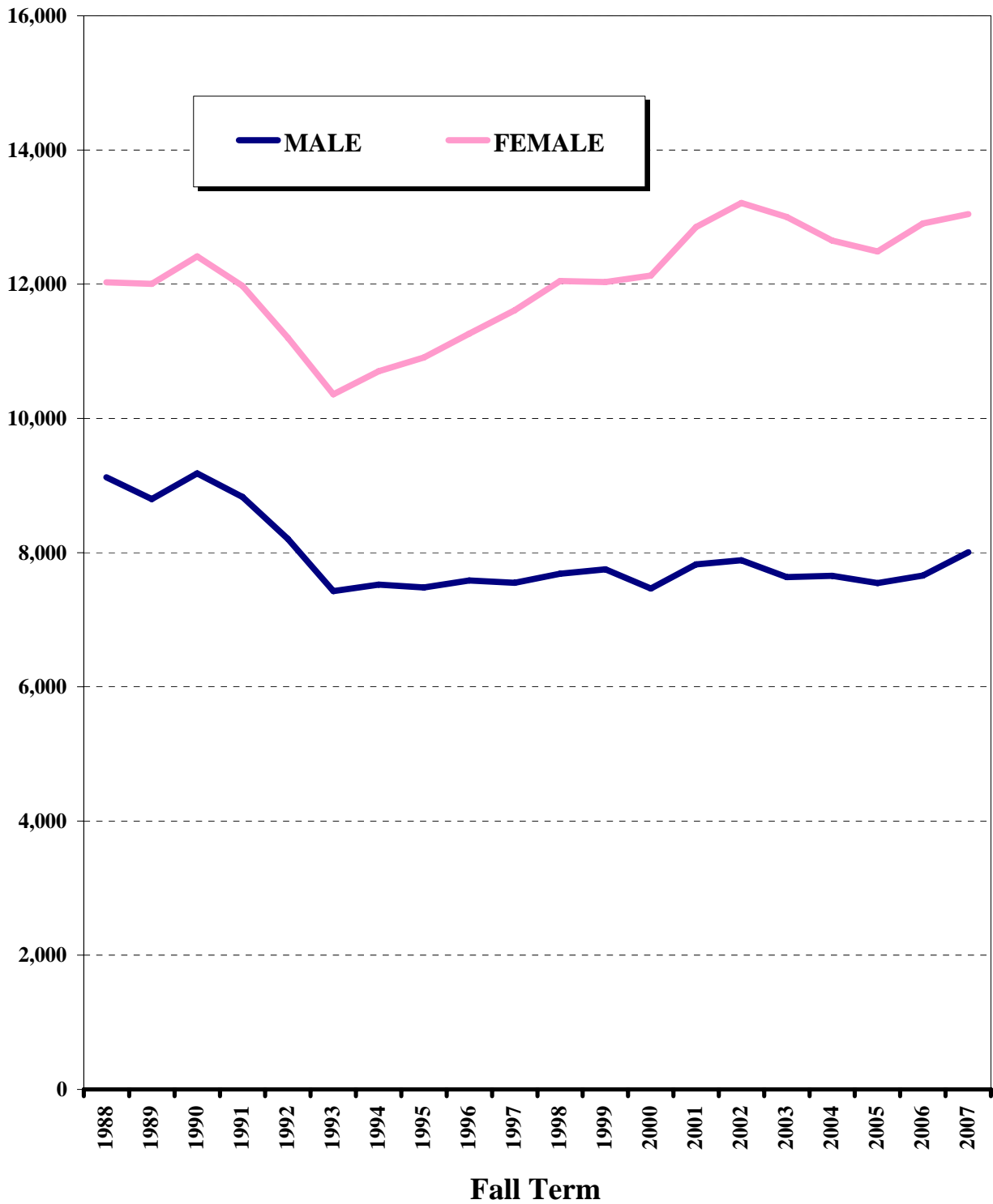

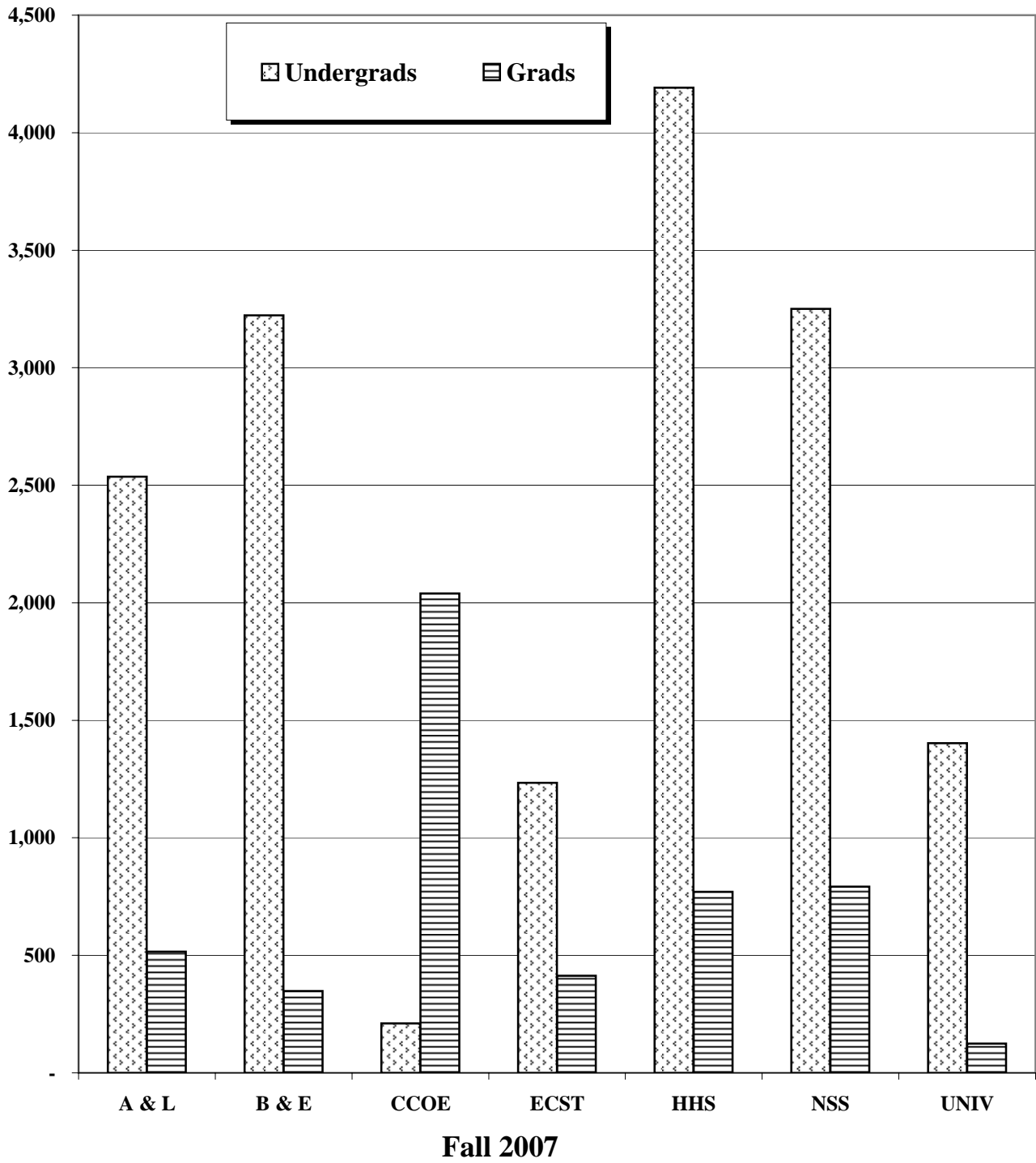

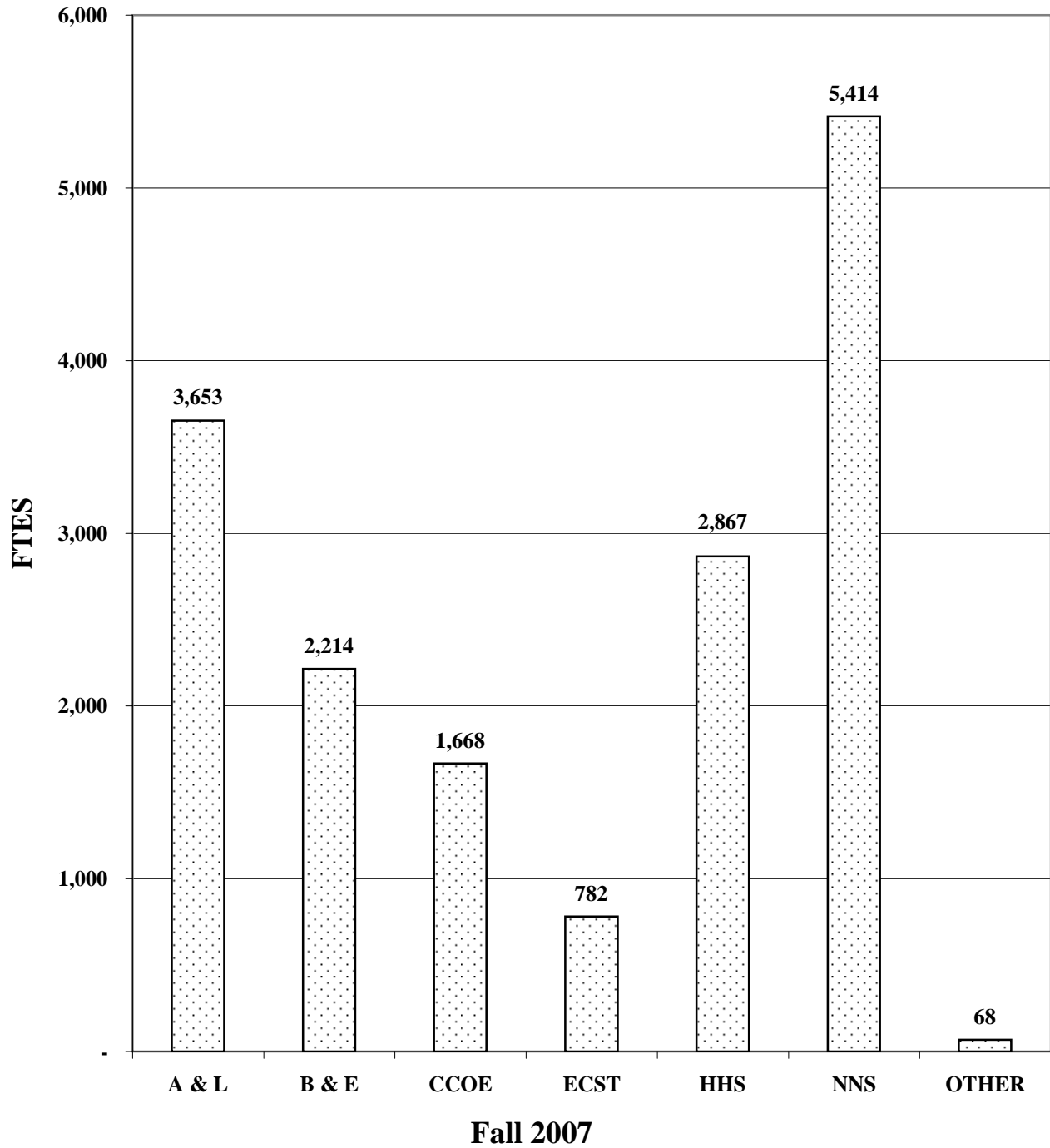

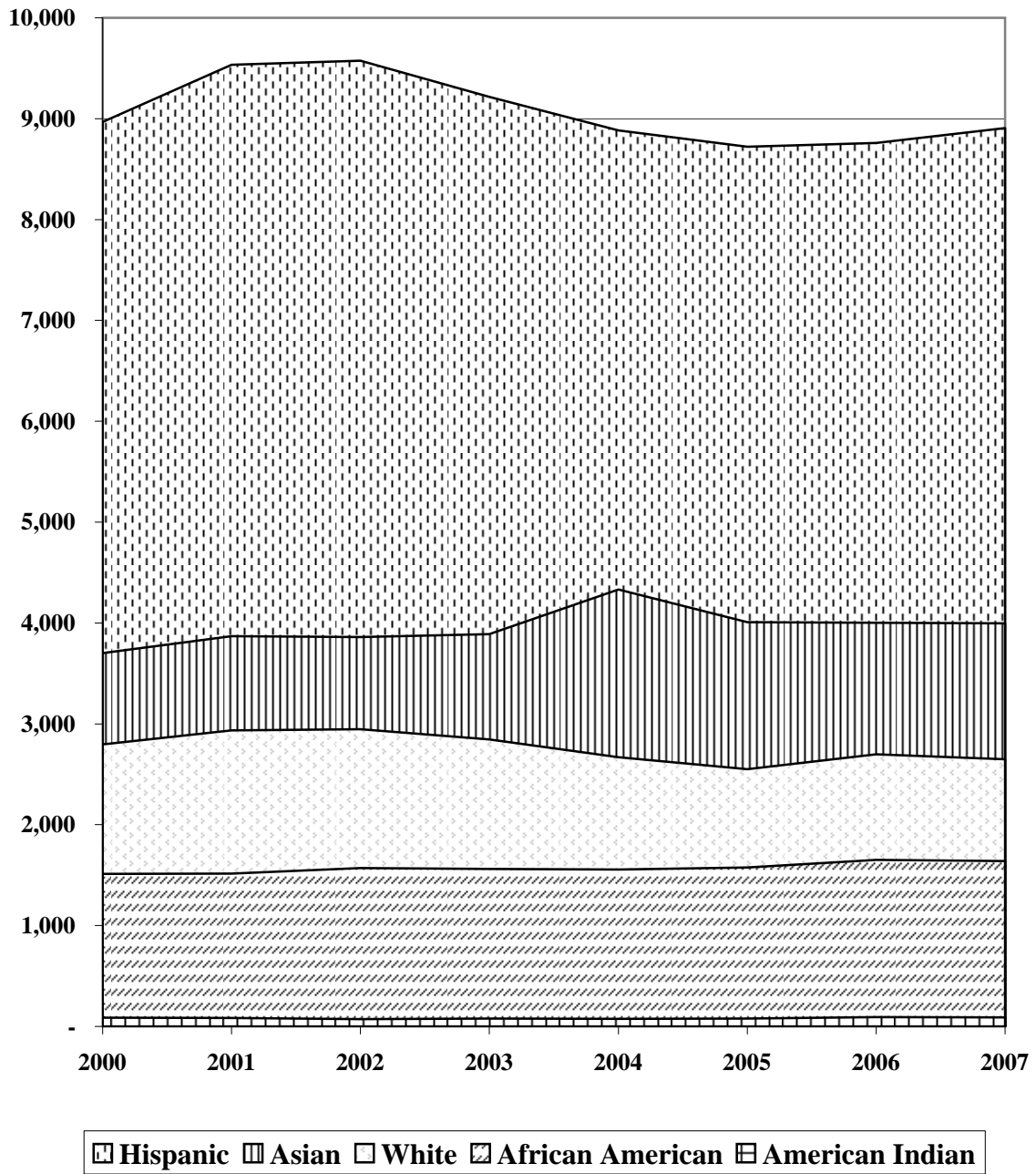

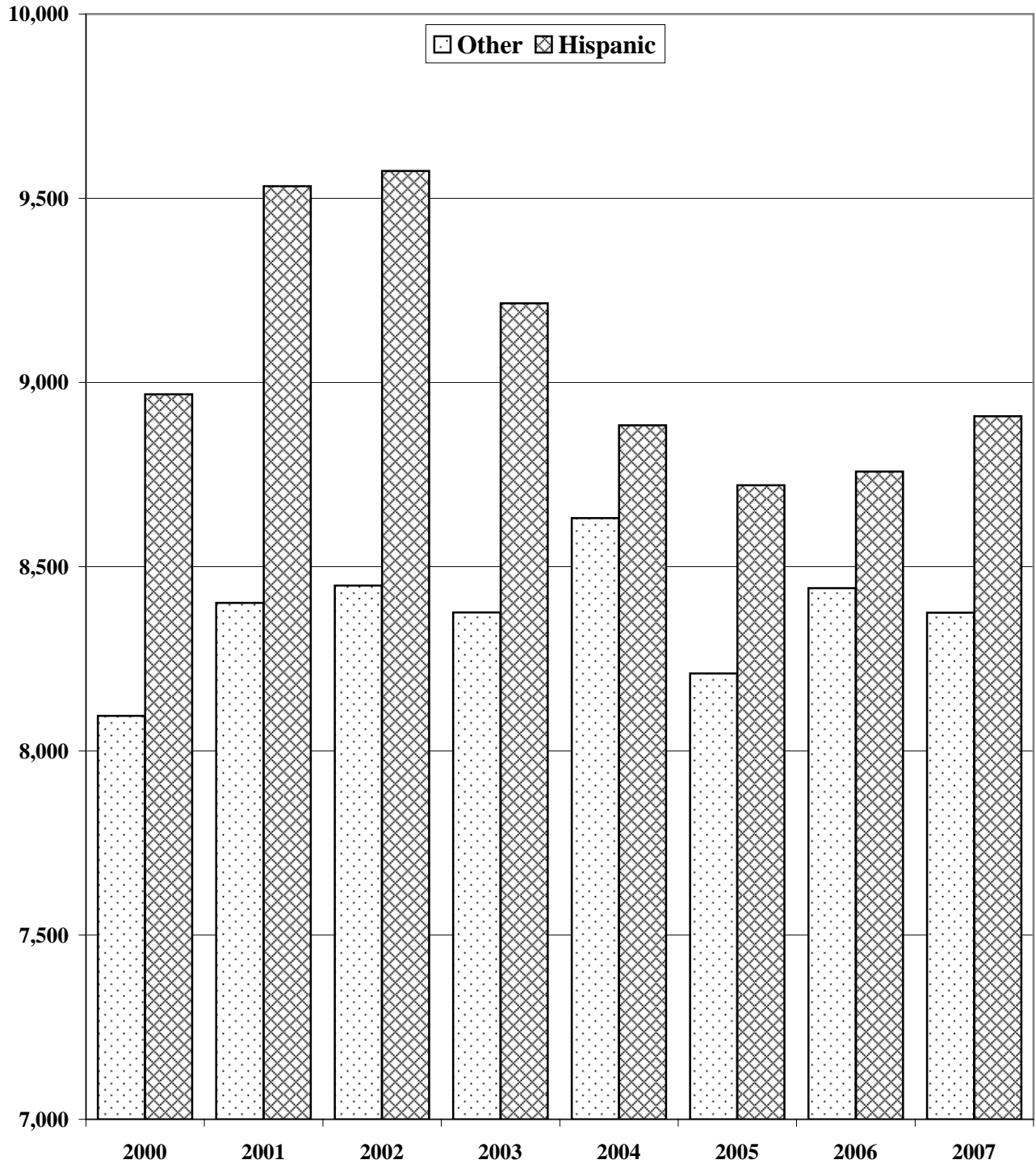

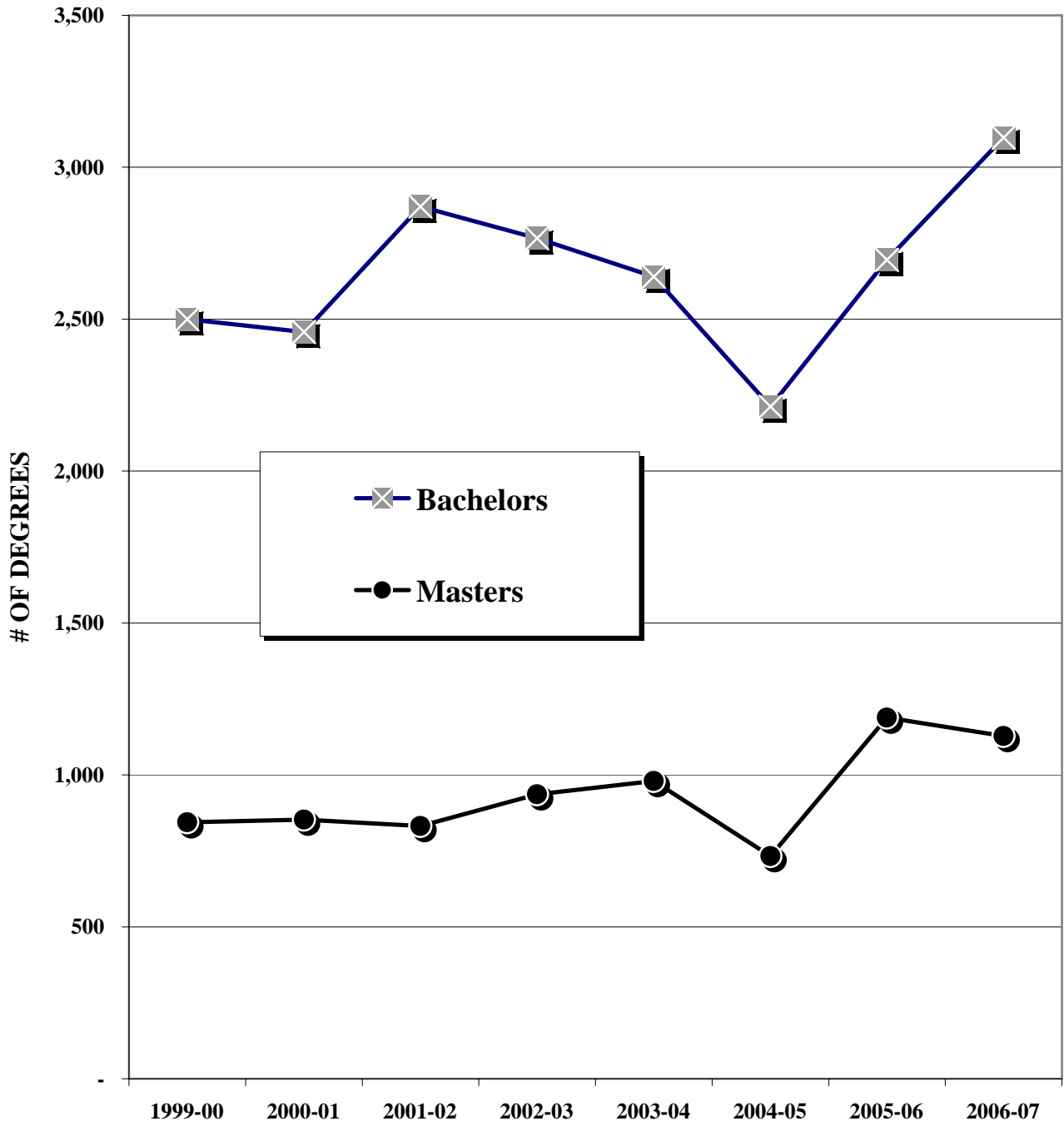

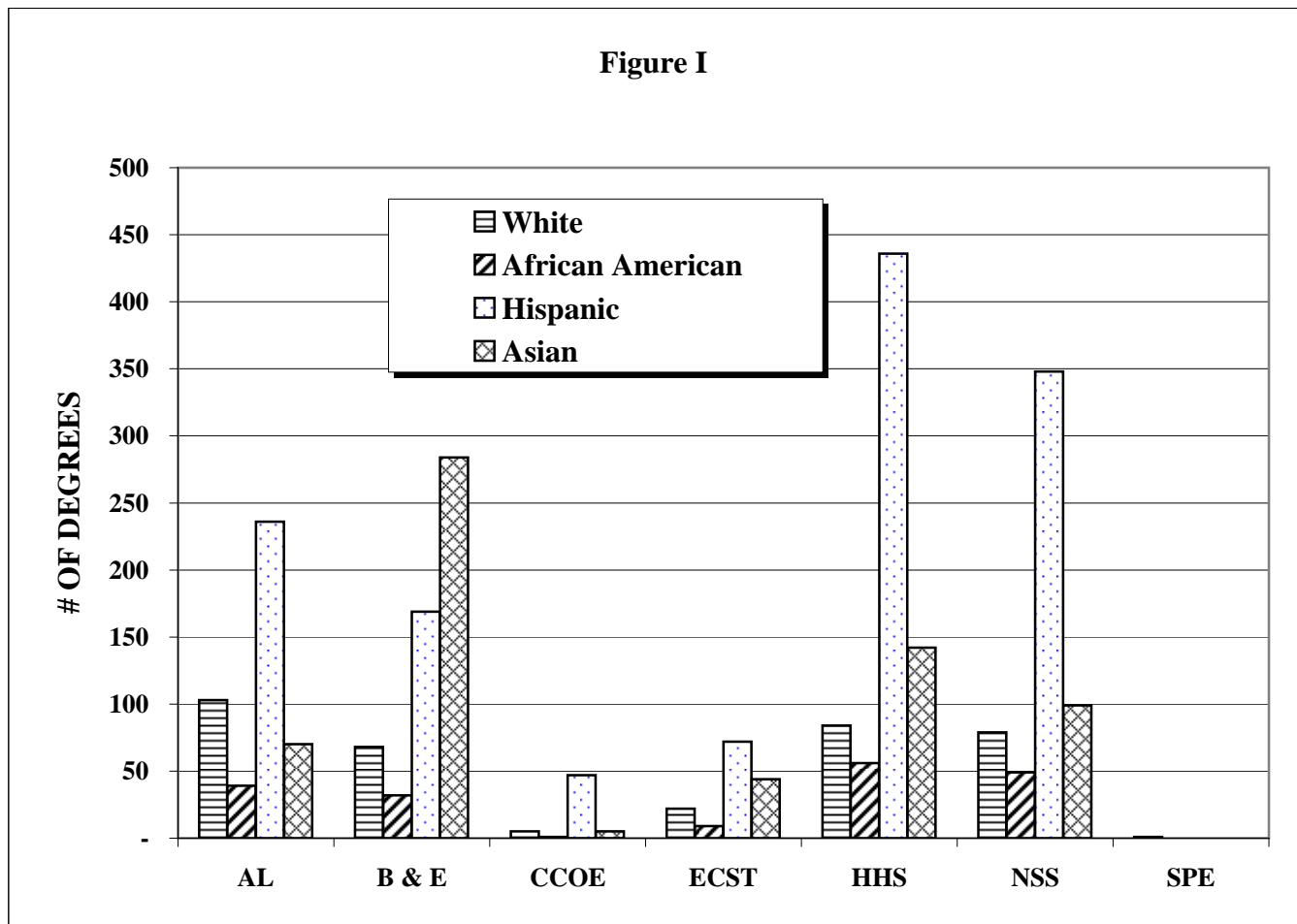

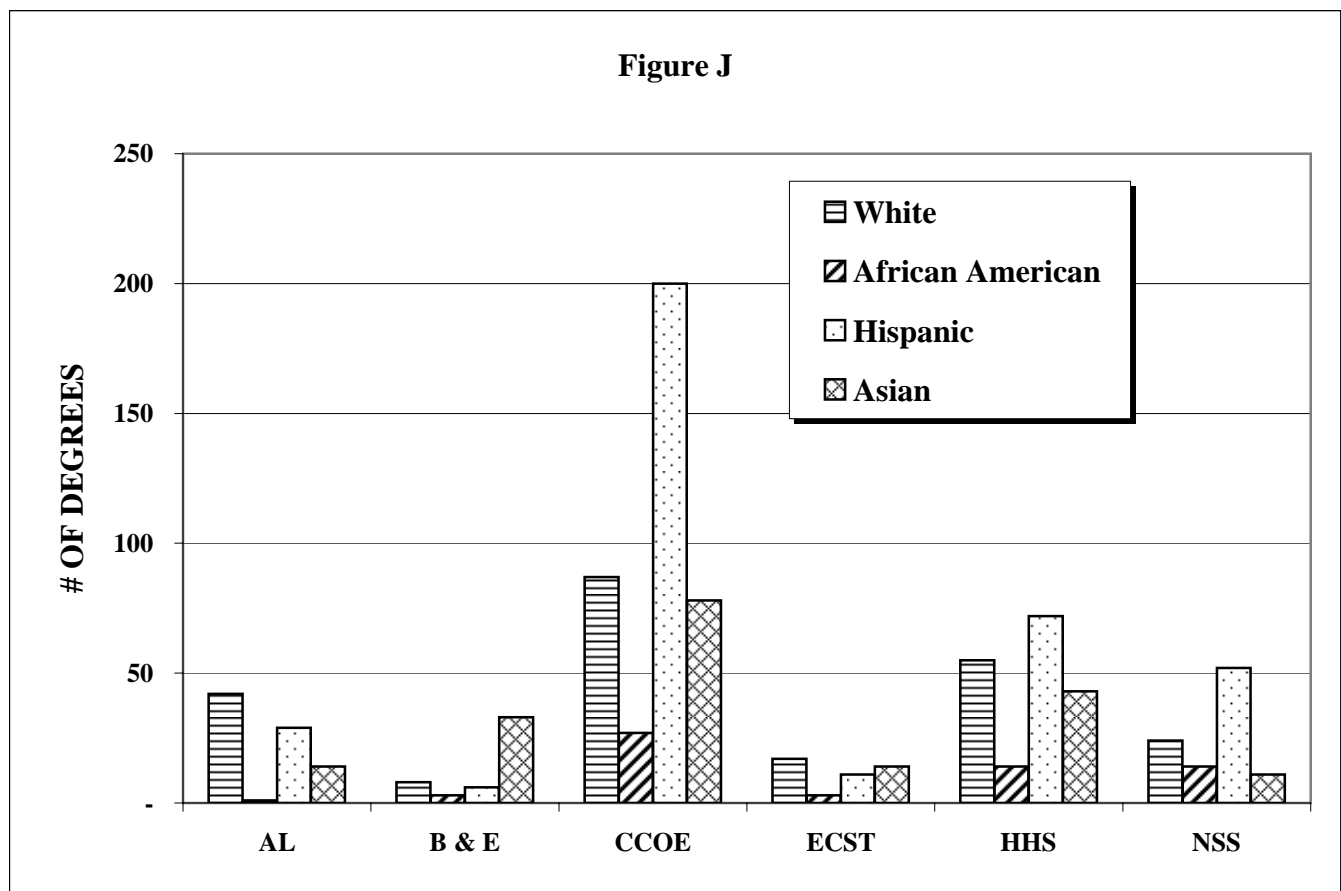

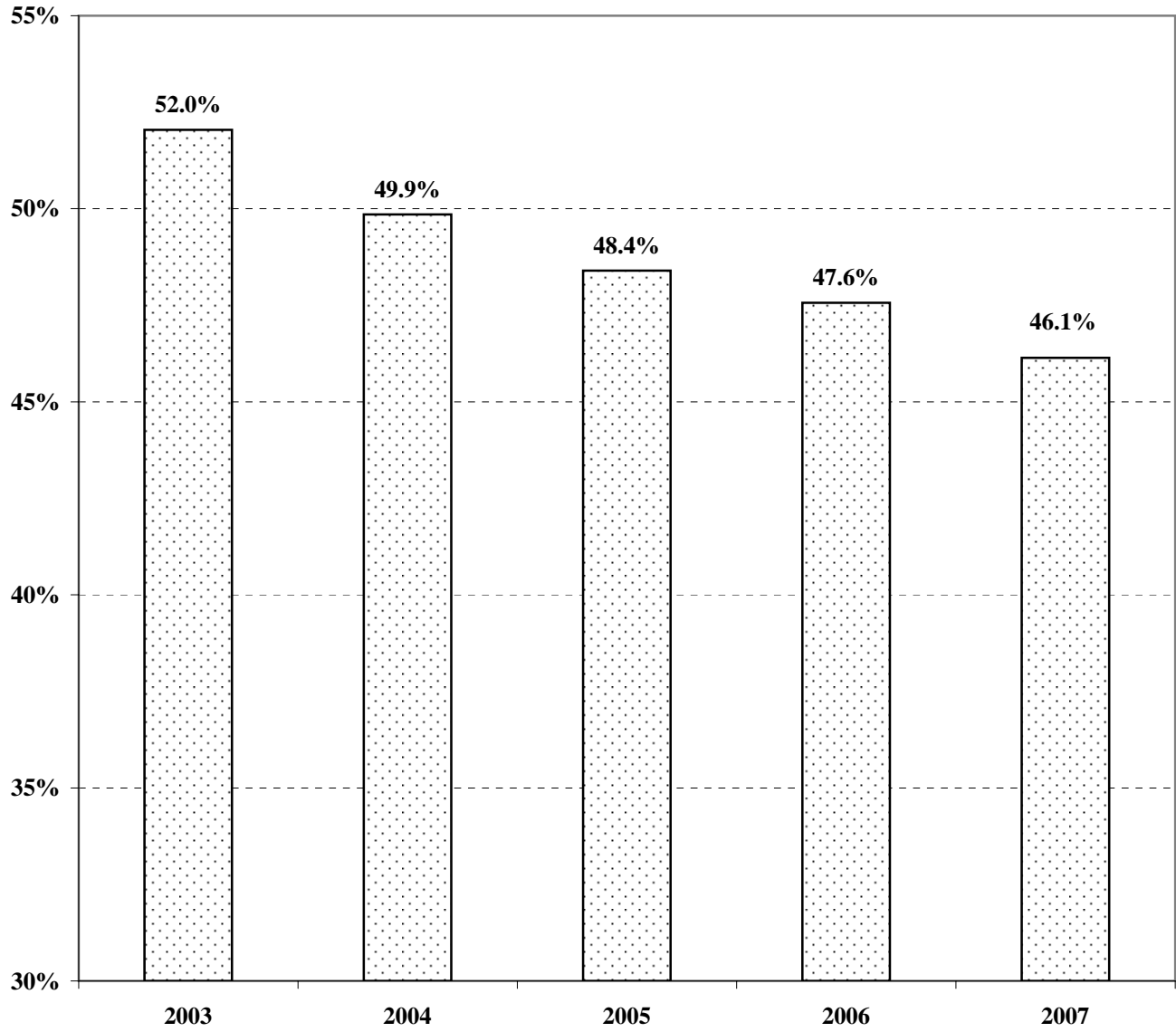

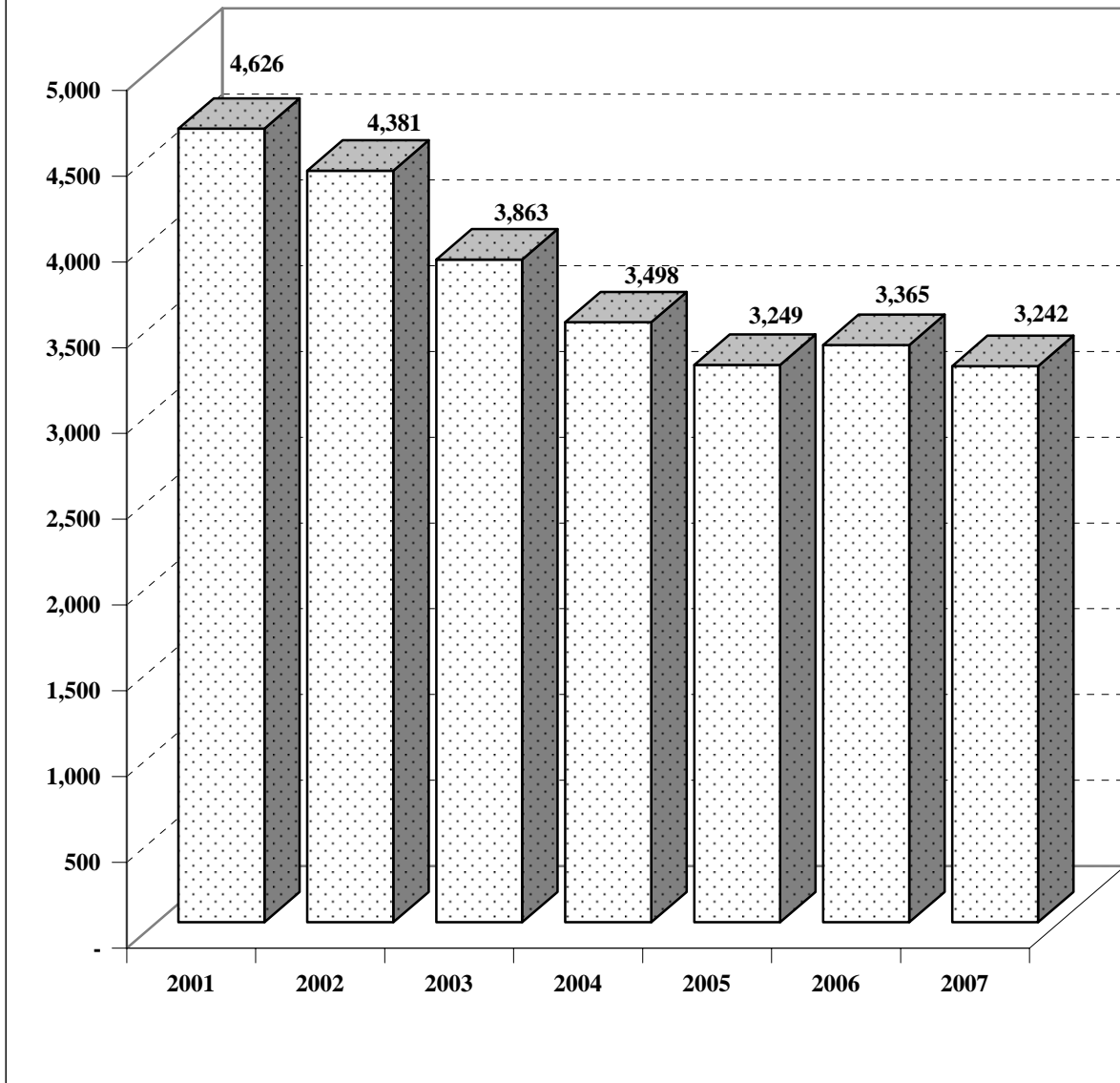

\*Part-Time defined as 6 or less units (based on fees paid)

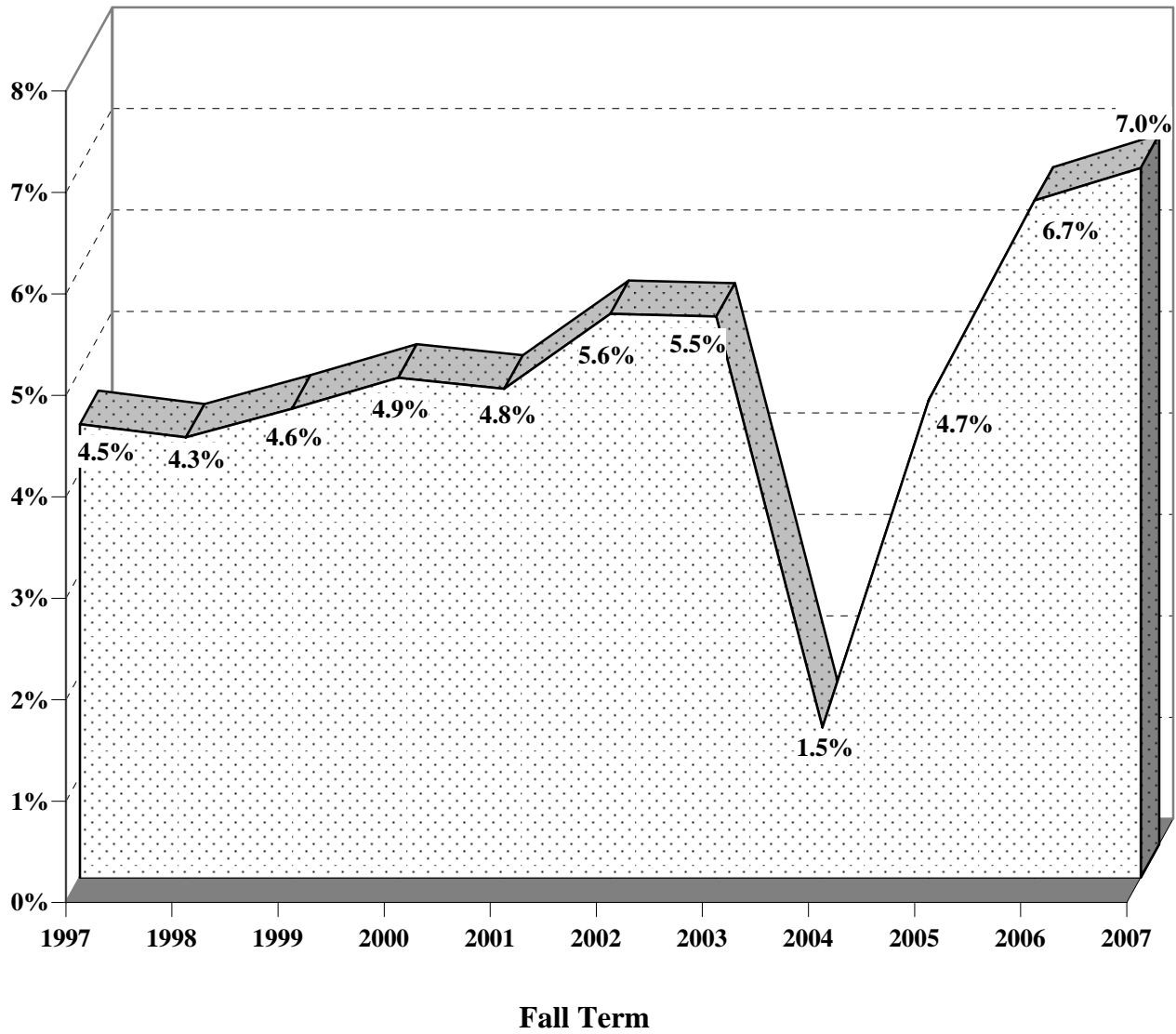

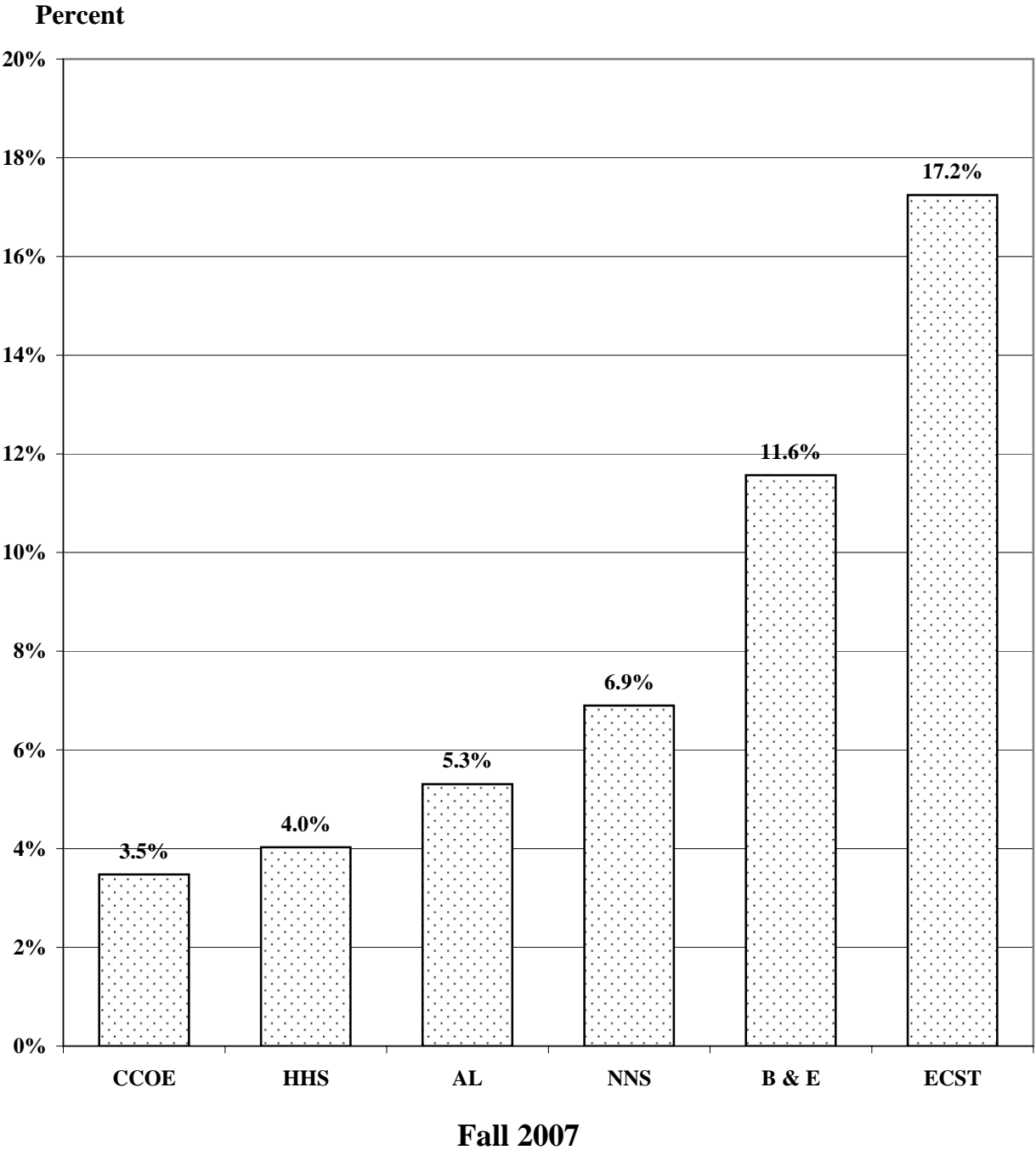

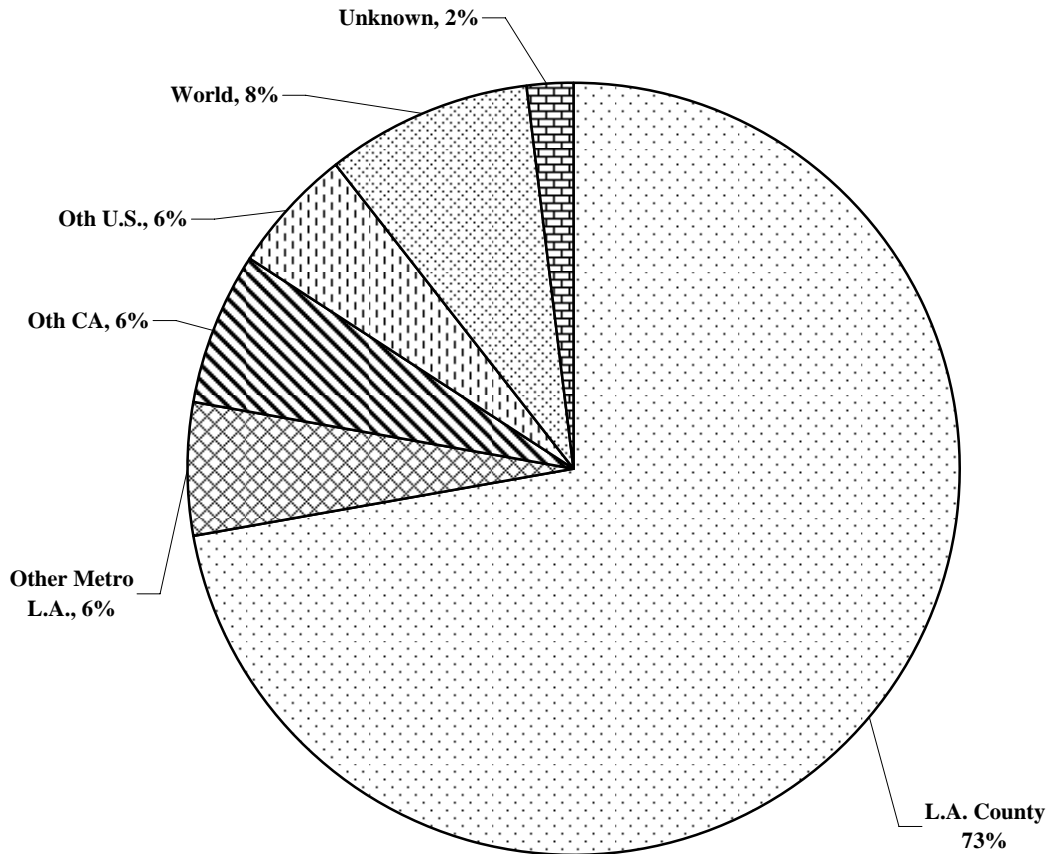
