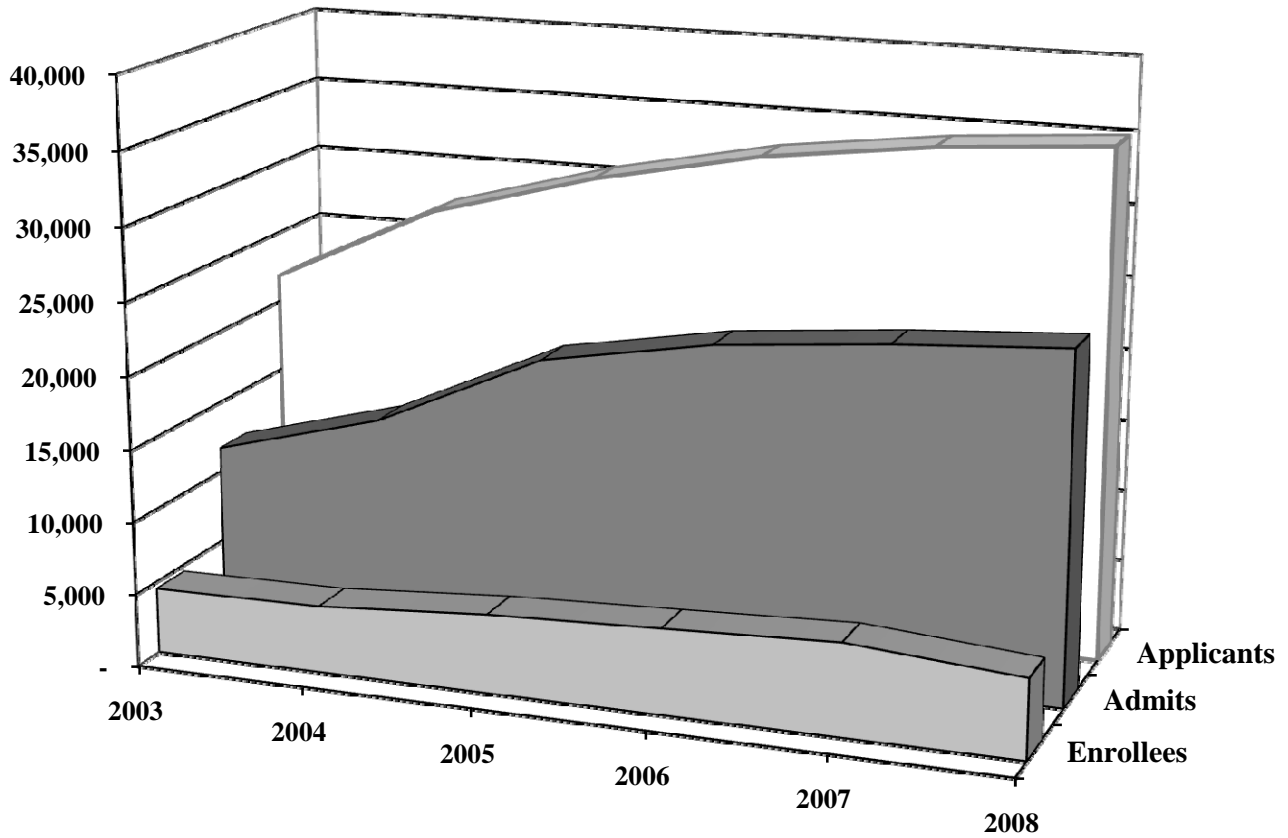

ENROLLMENT vs. COURSE LOAD

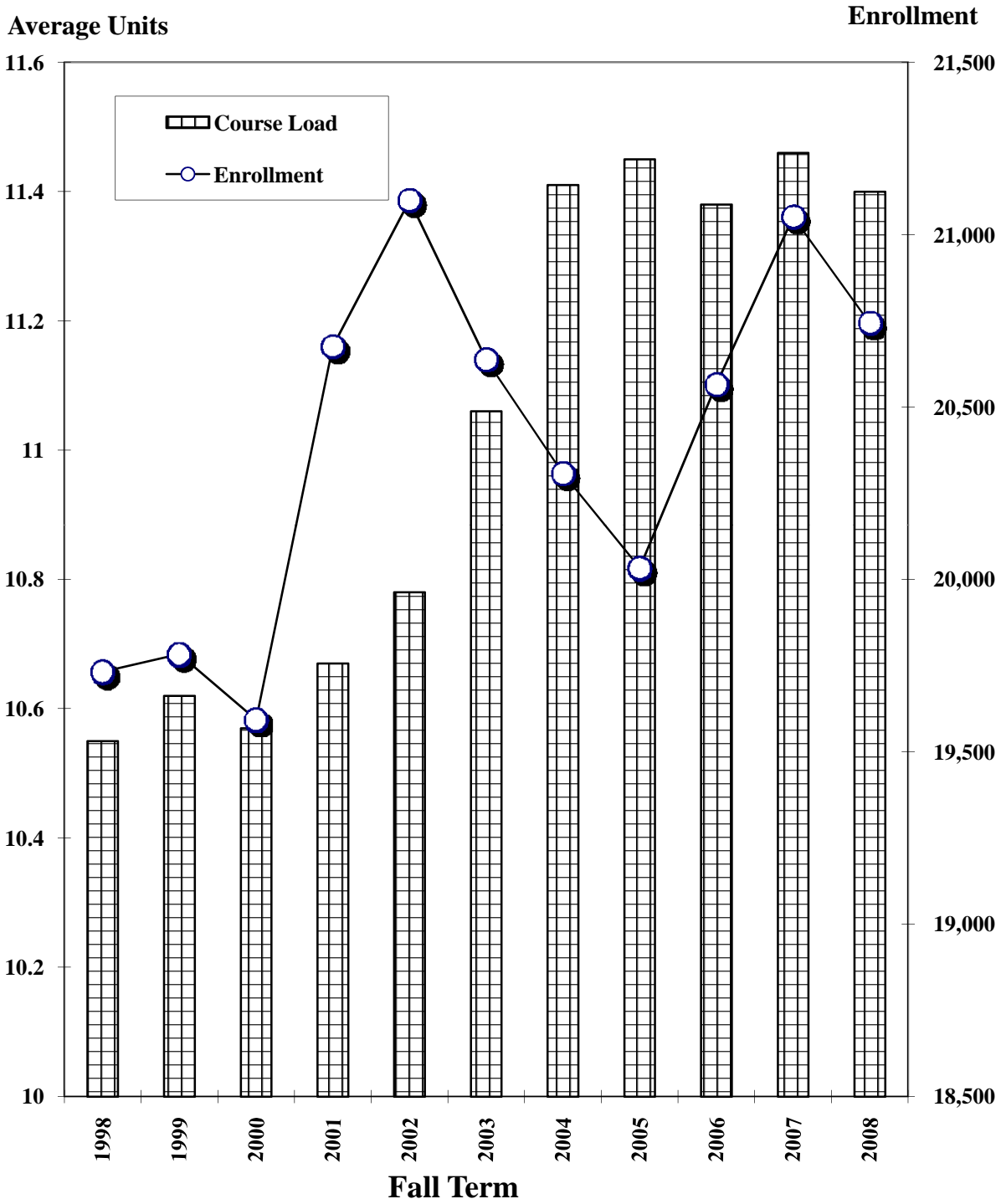

1989-2008

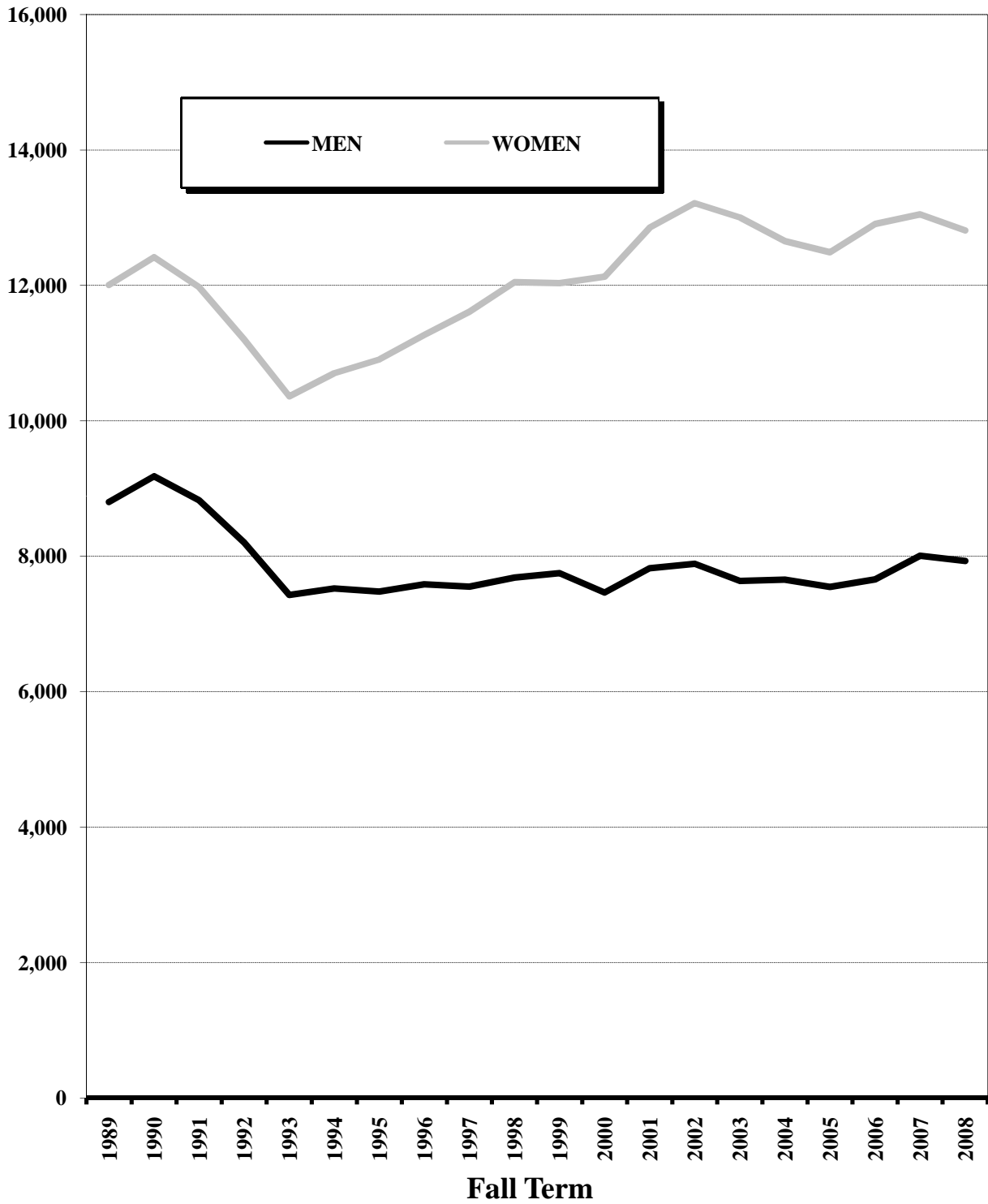

Undergraduate & Graduate Majors By College

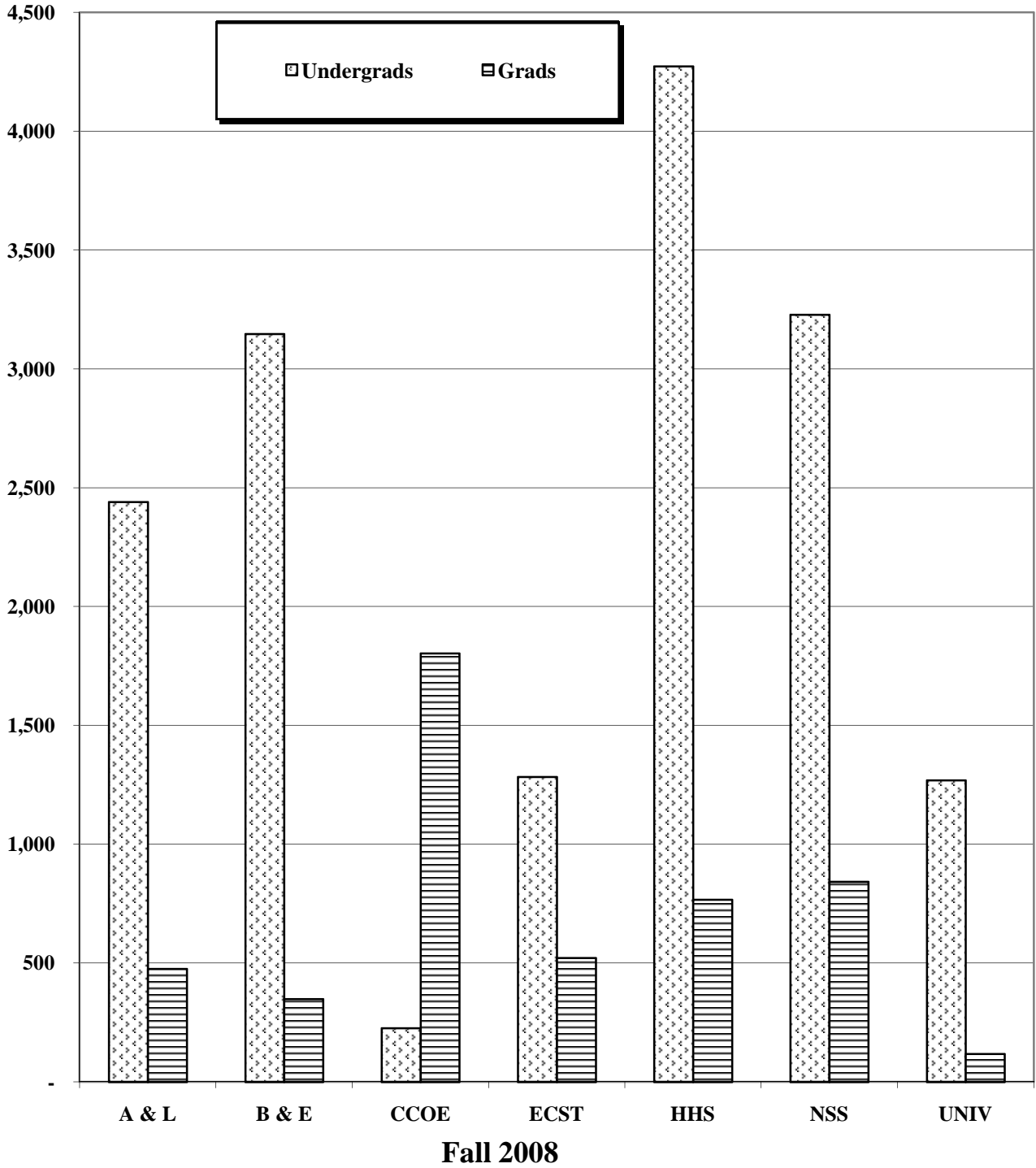

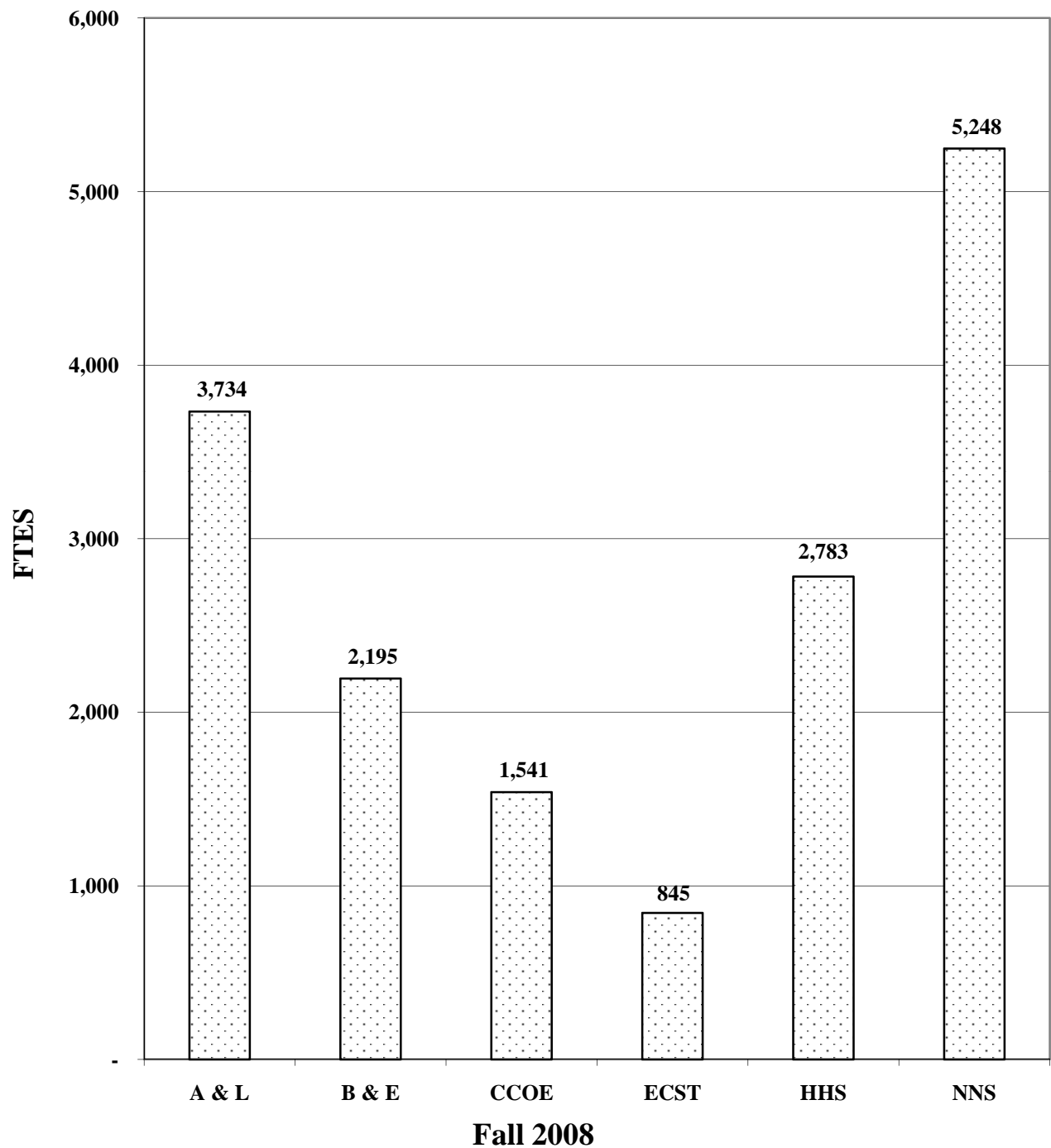

Enrollment

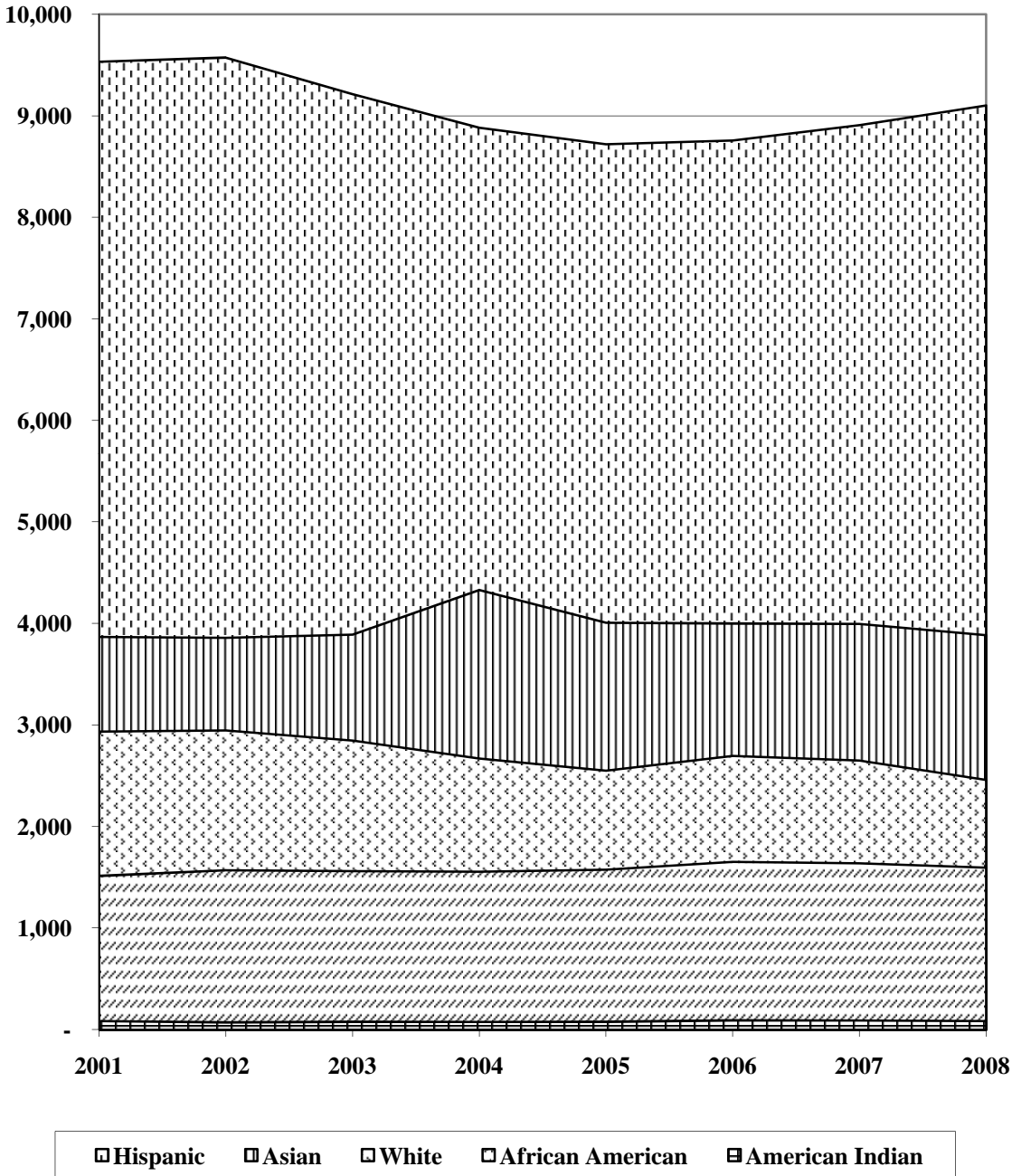

Fall 2001 to Fall 2008

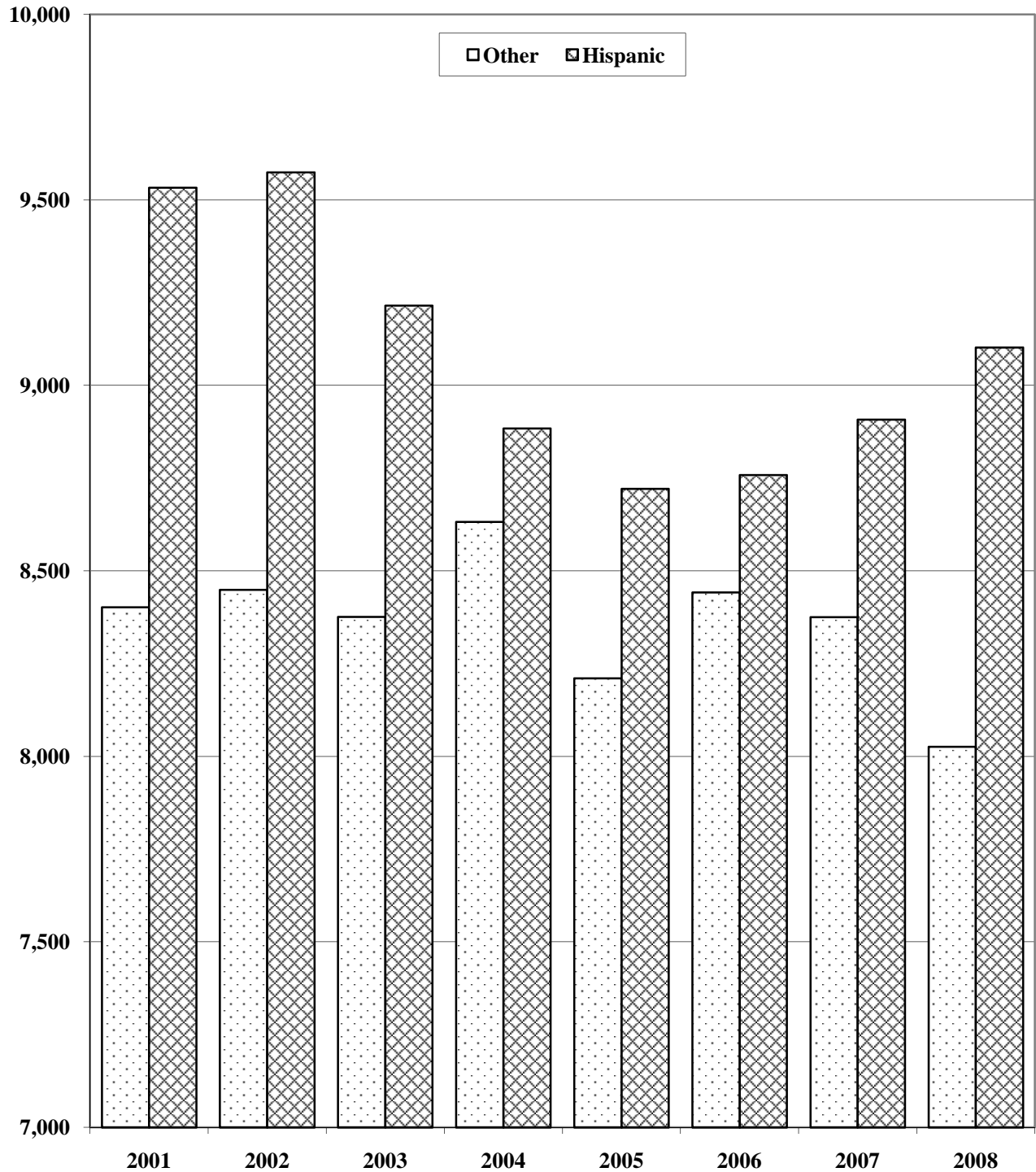

DEGREES GRANTED

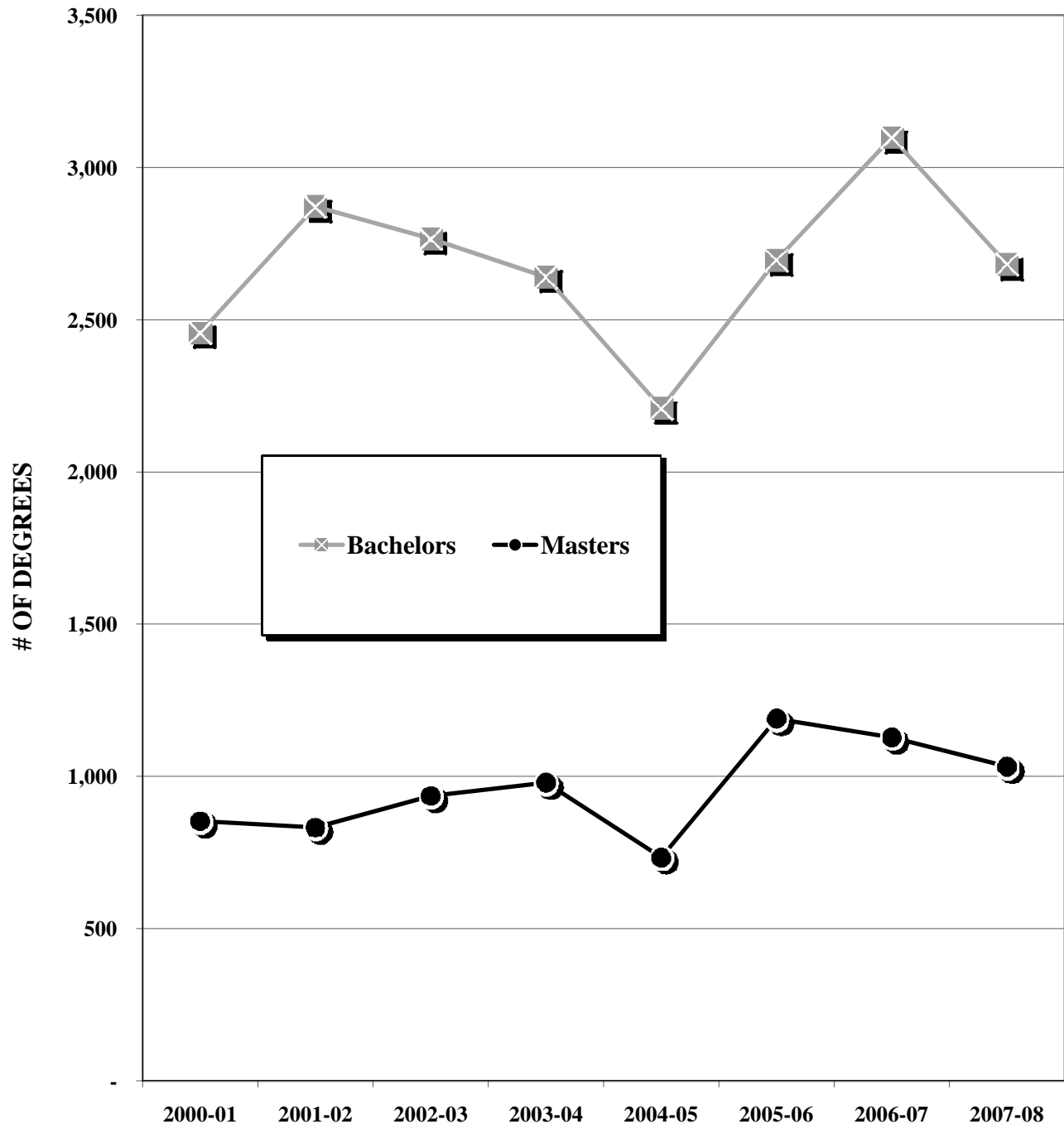

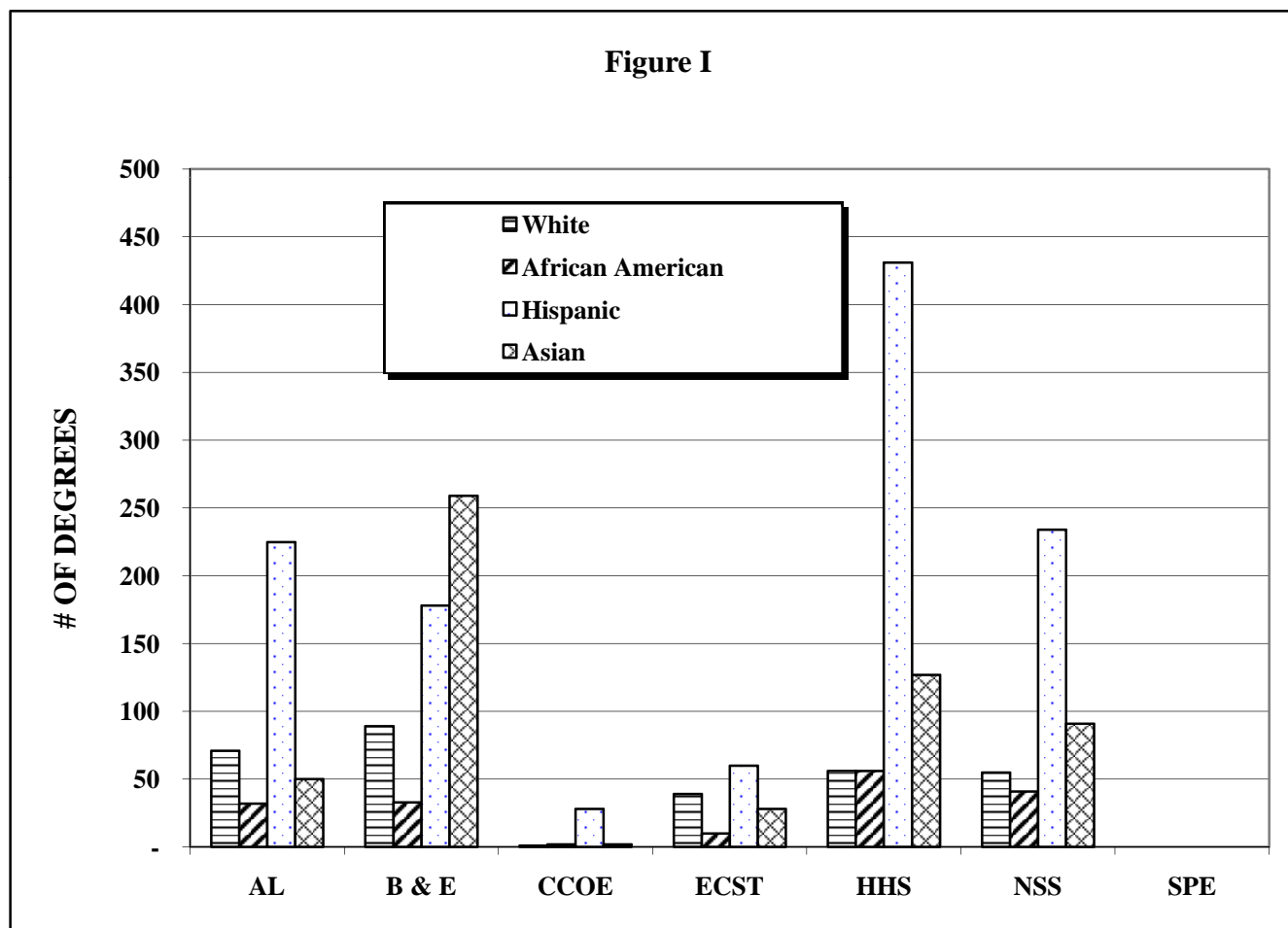

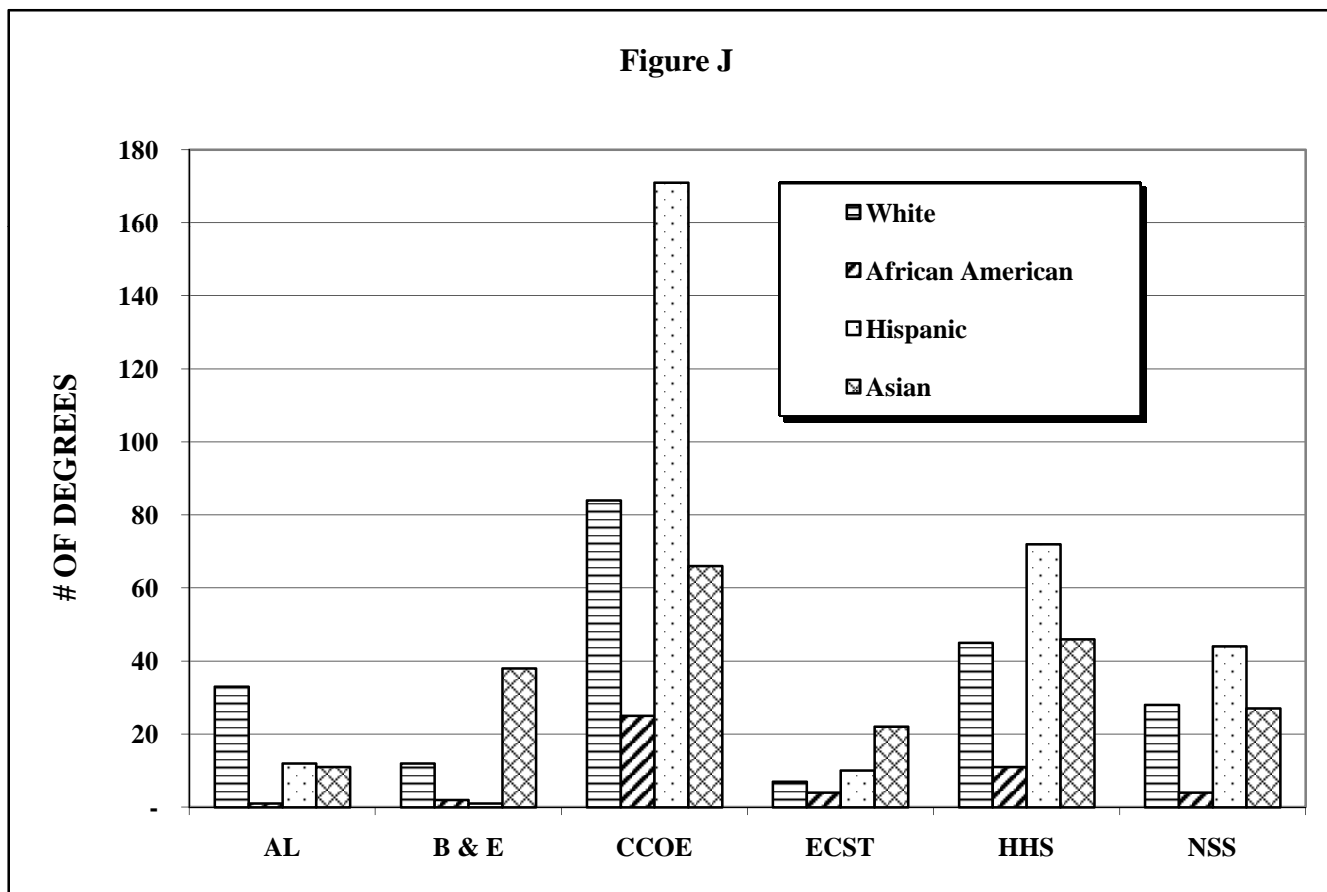

(25 years and older)

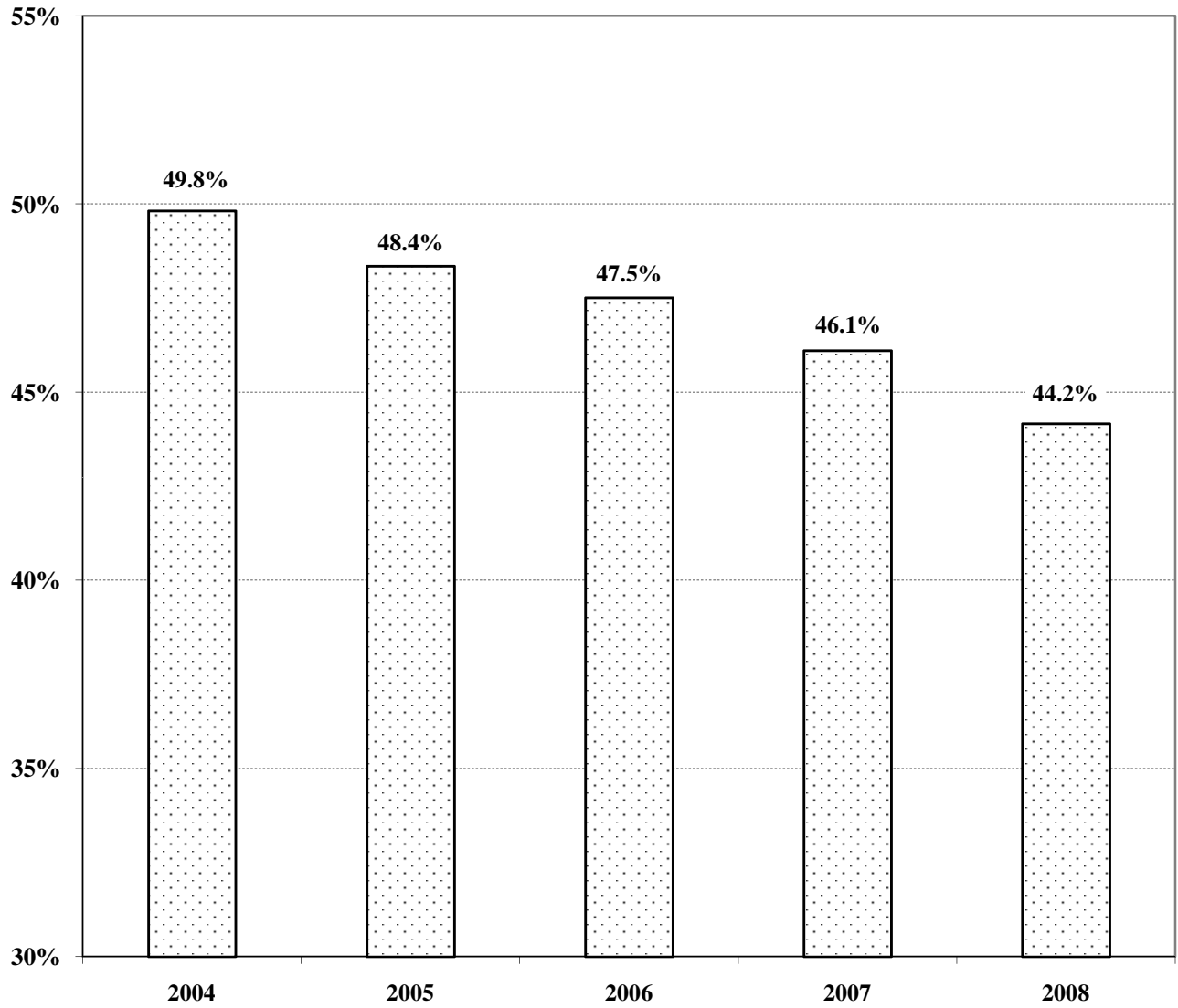

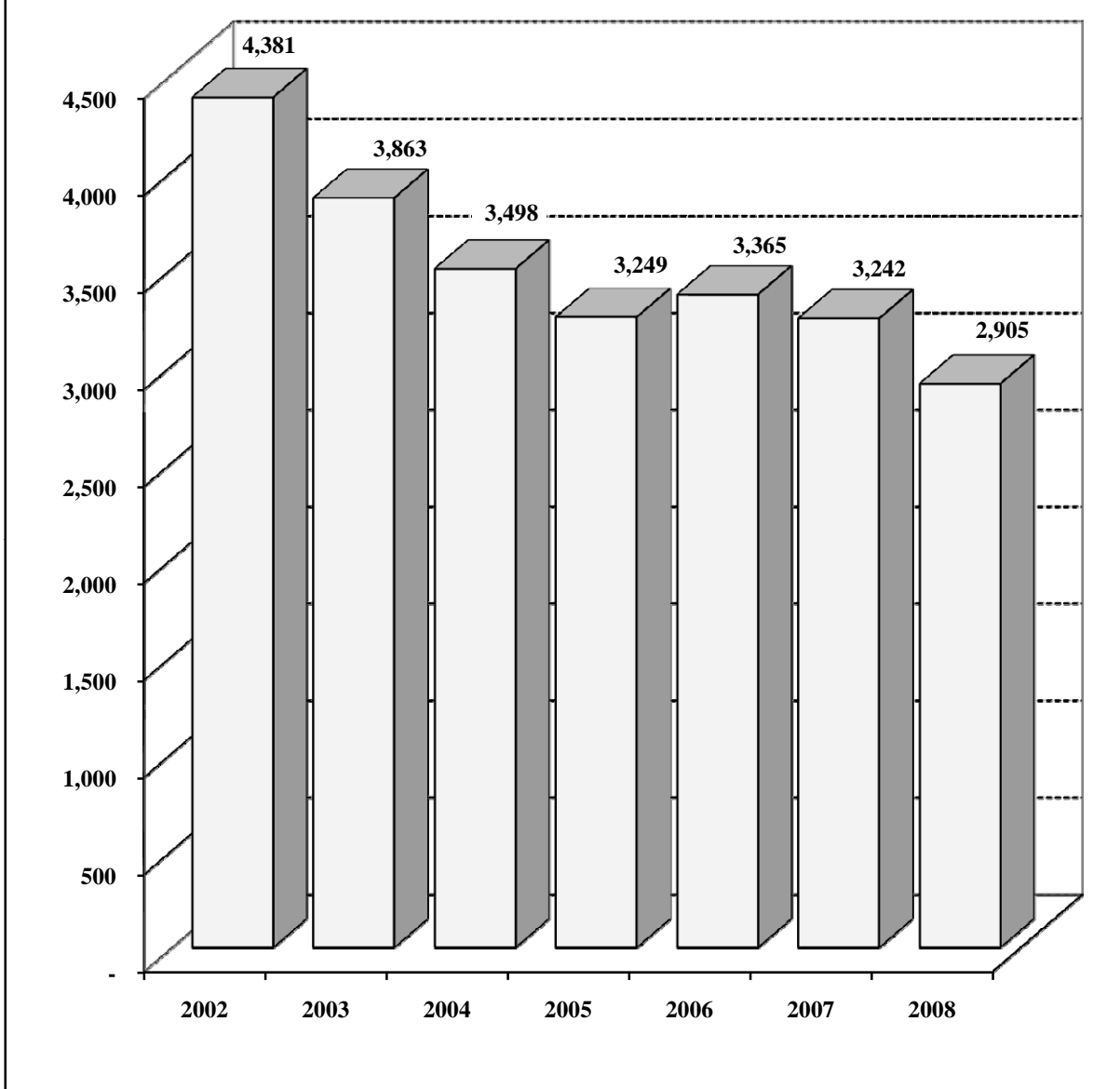

Percent of each college's majors who are international

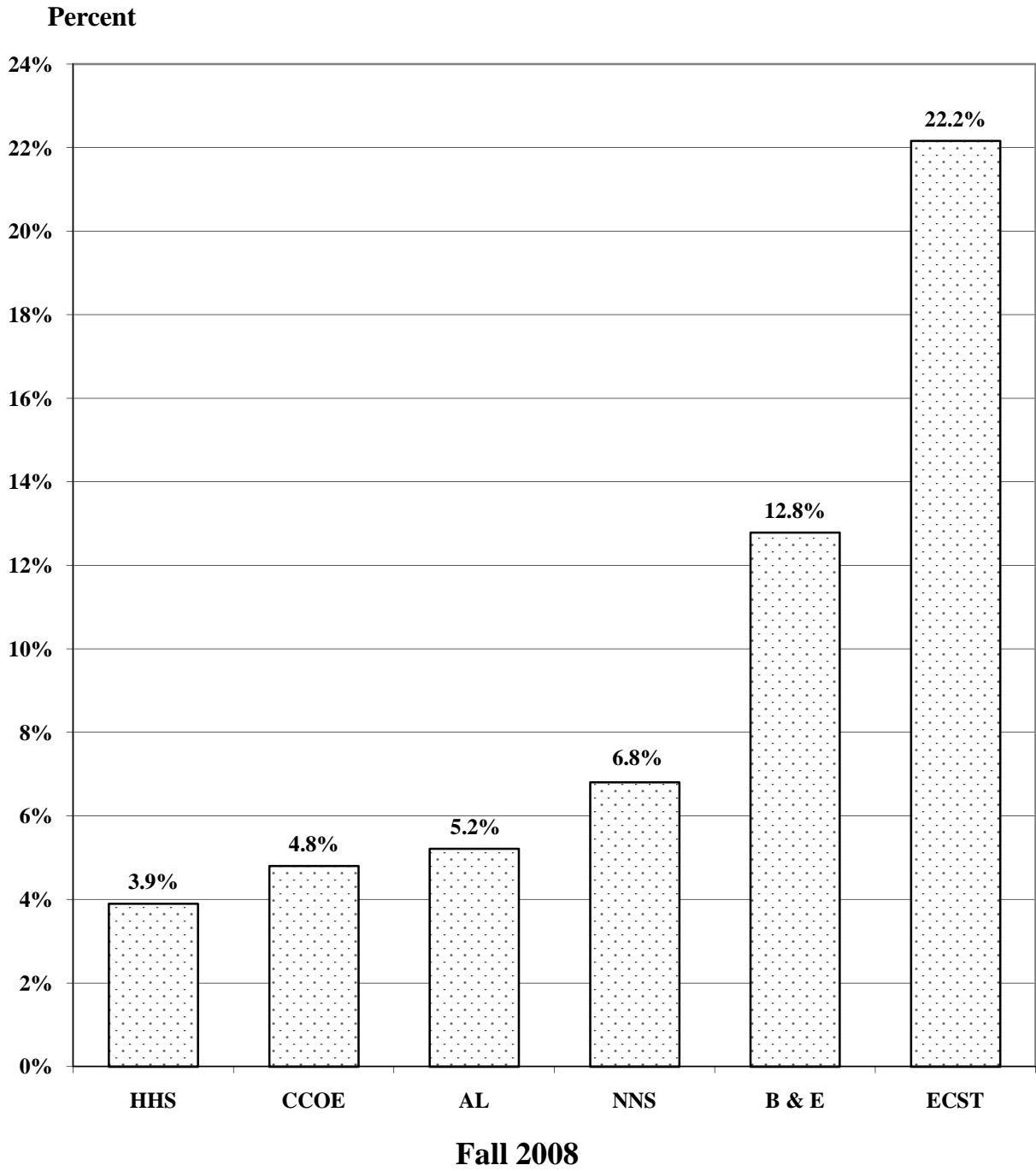

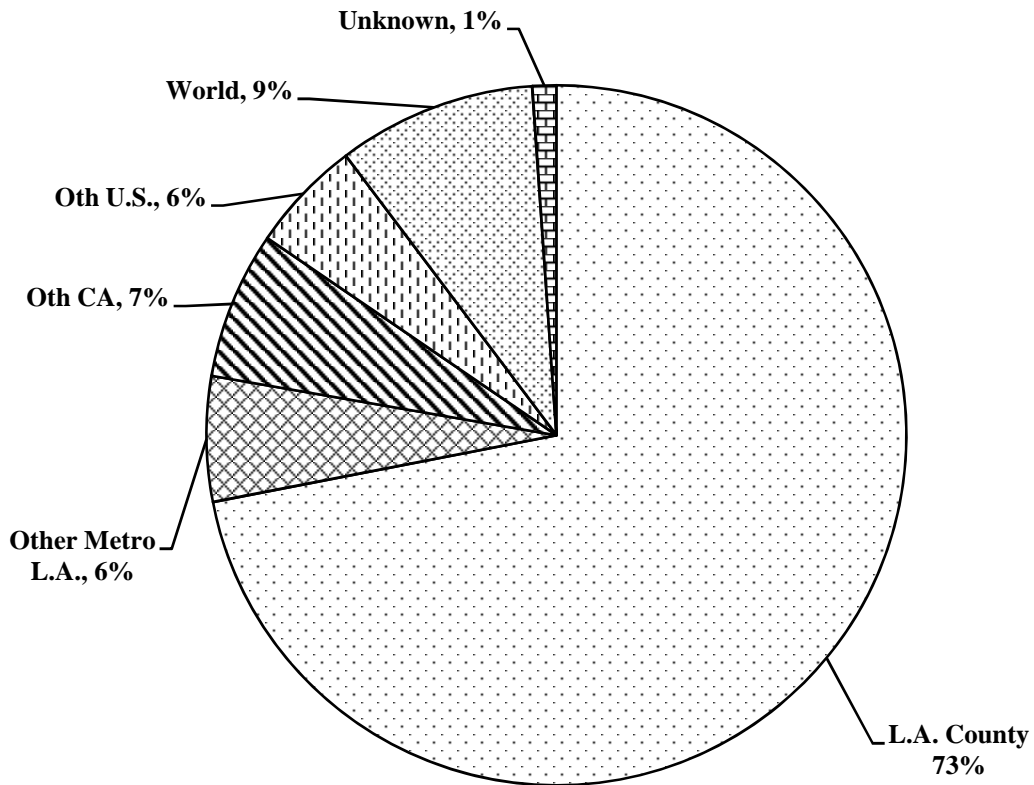
