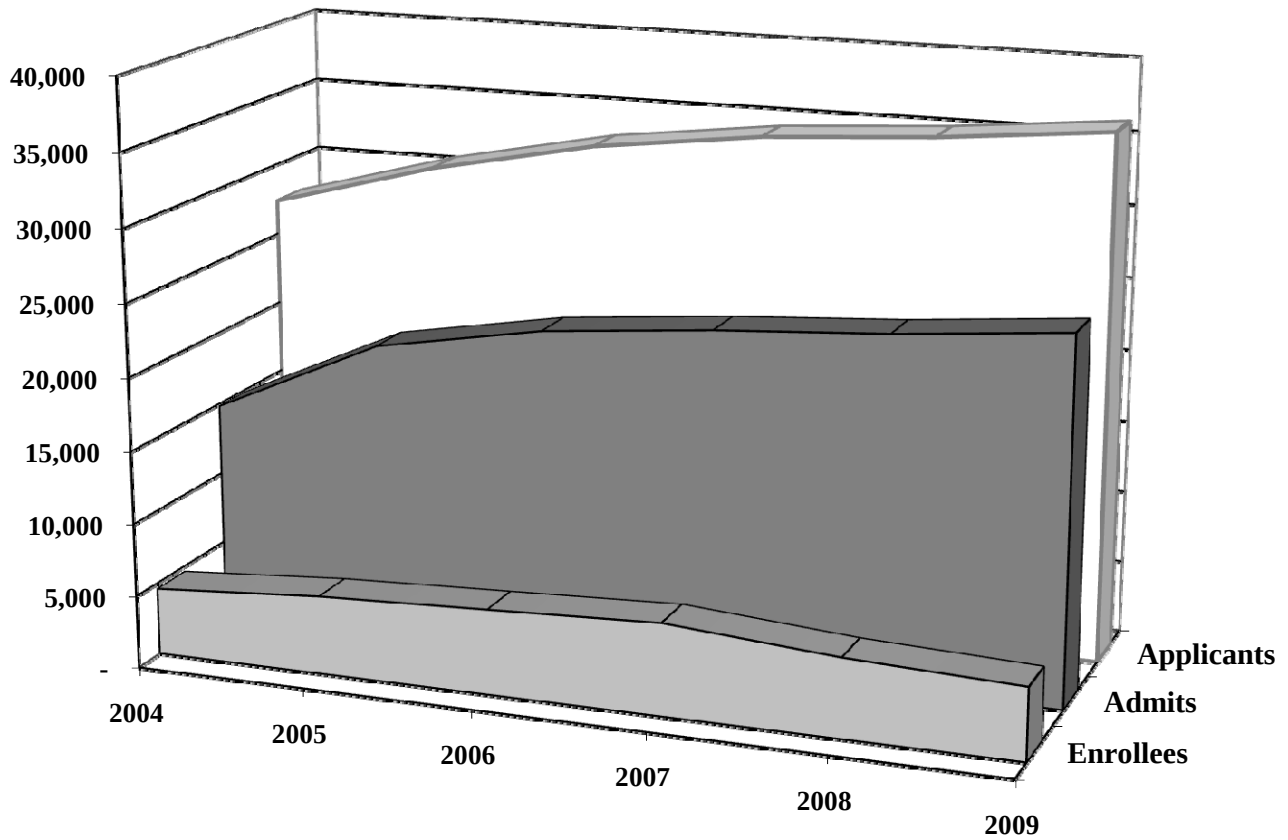

ENROLLMENT vs. COURSE LOAD

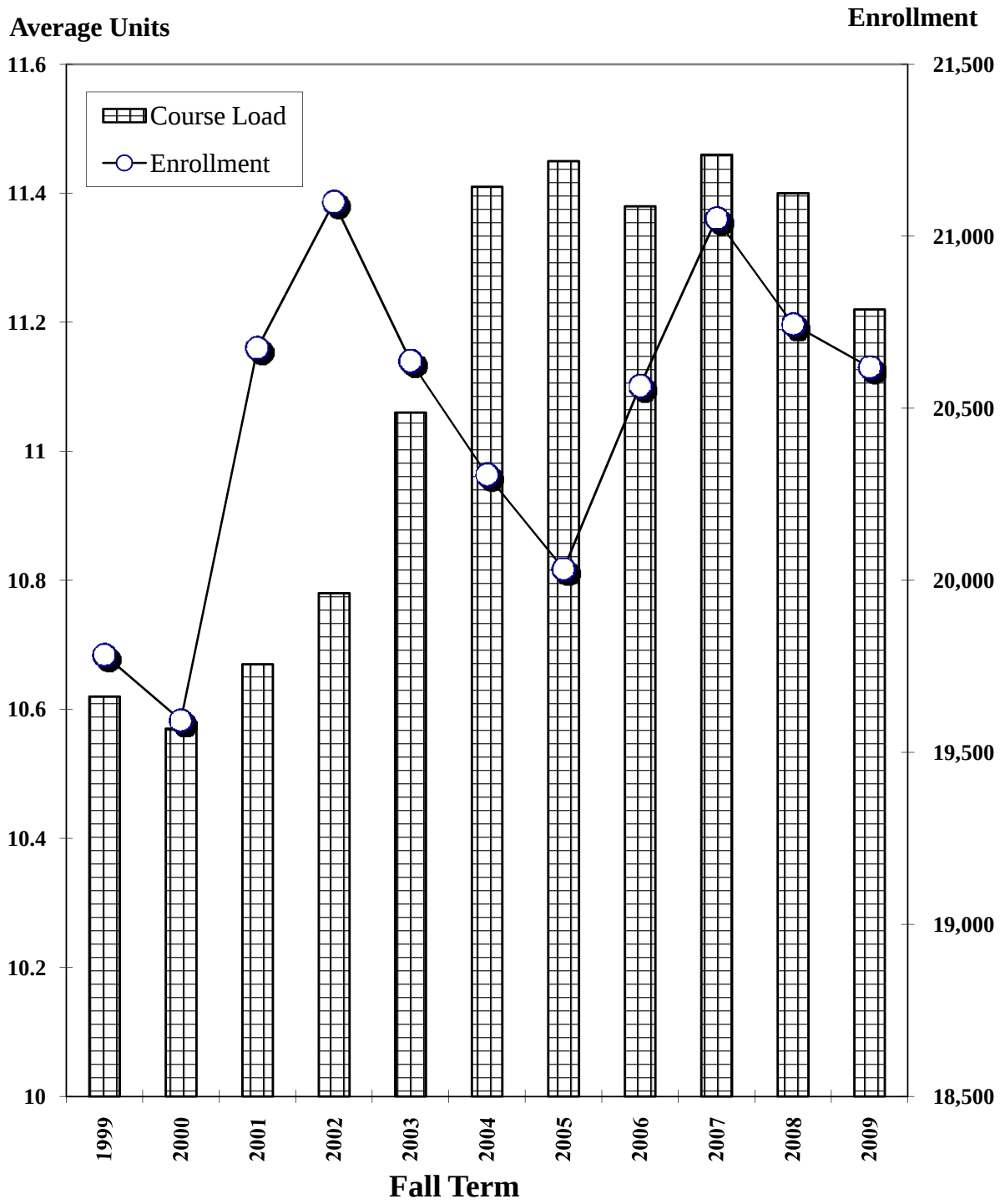

1990-2009

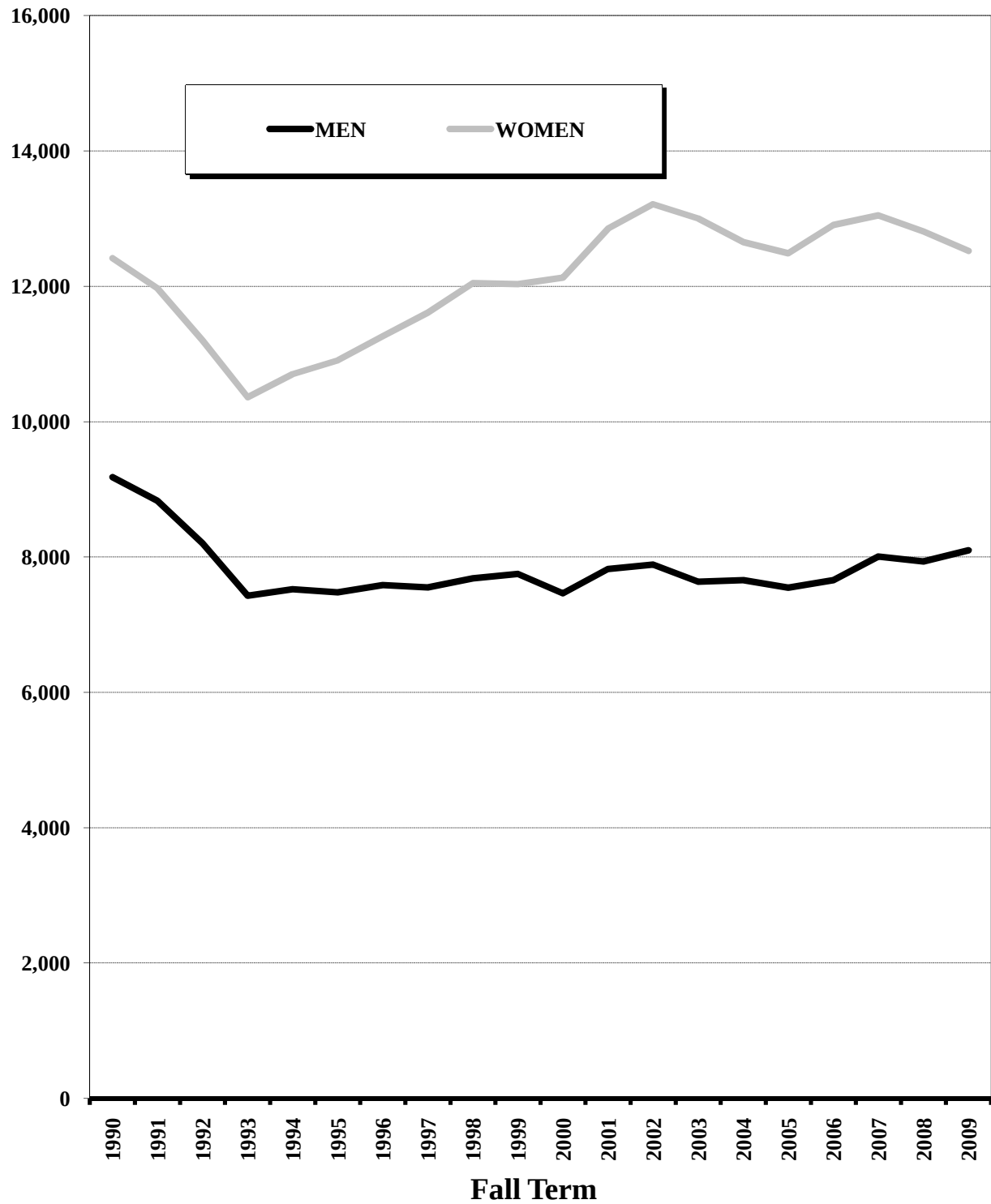

Undergraduate & Graduate Majors By College

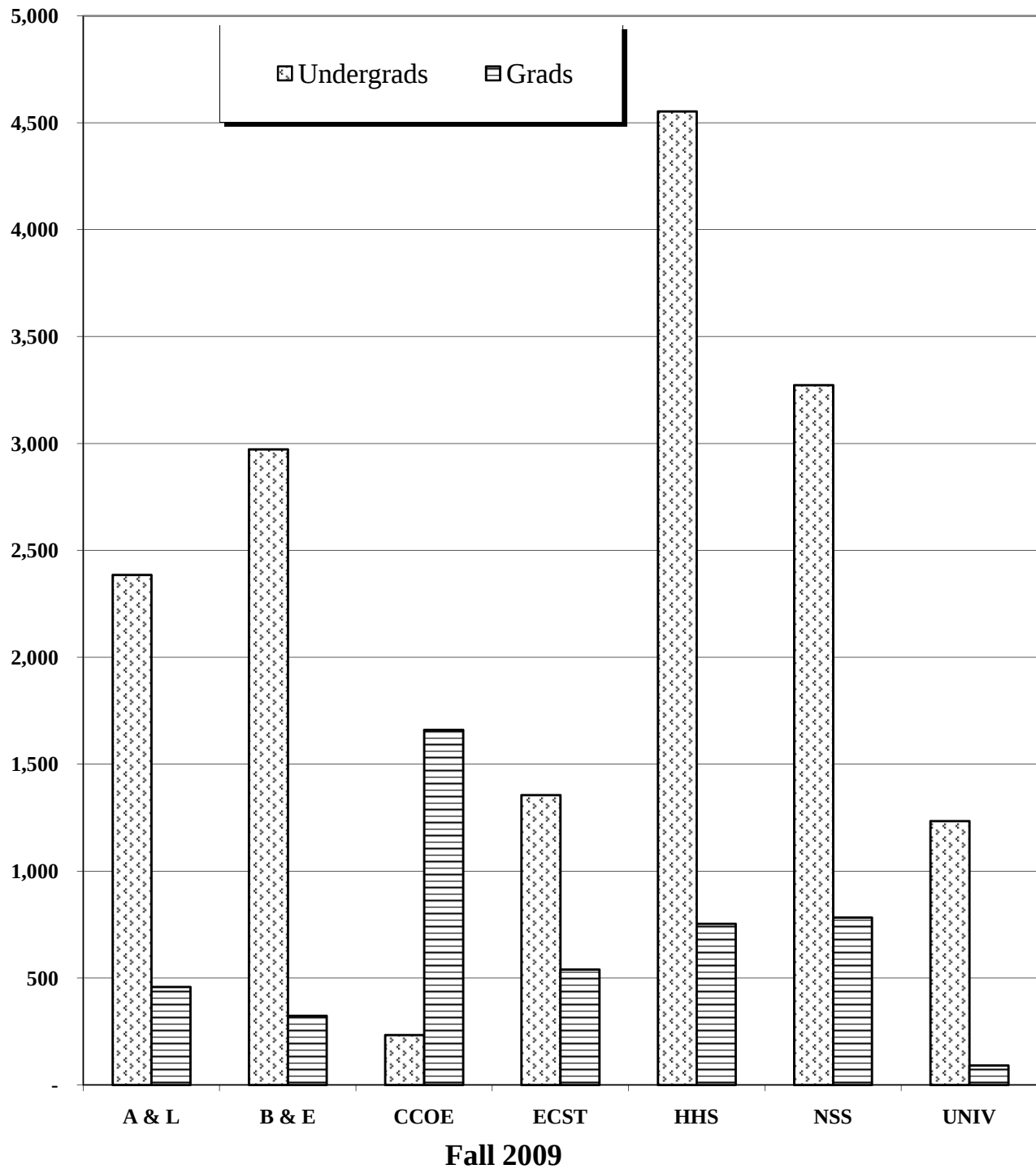

FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT STUDENTS BY COLLEGE

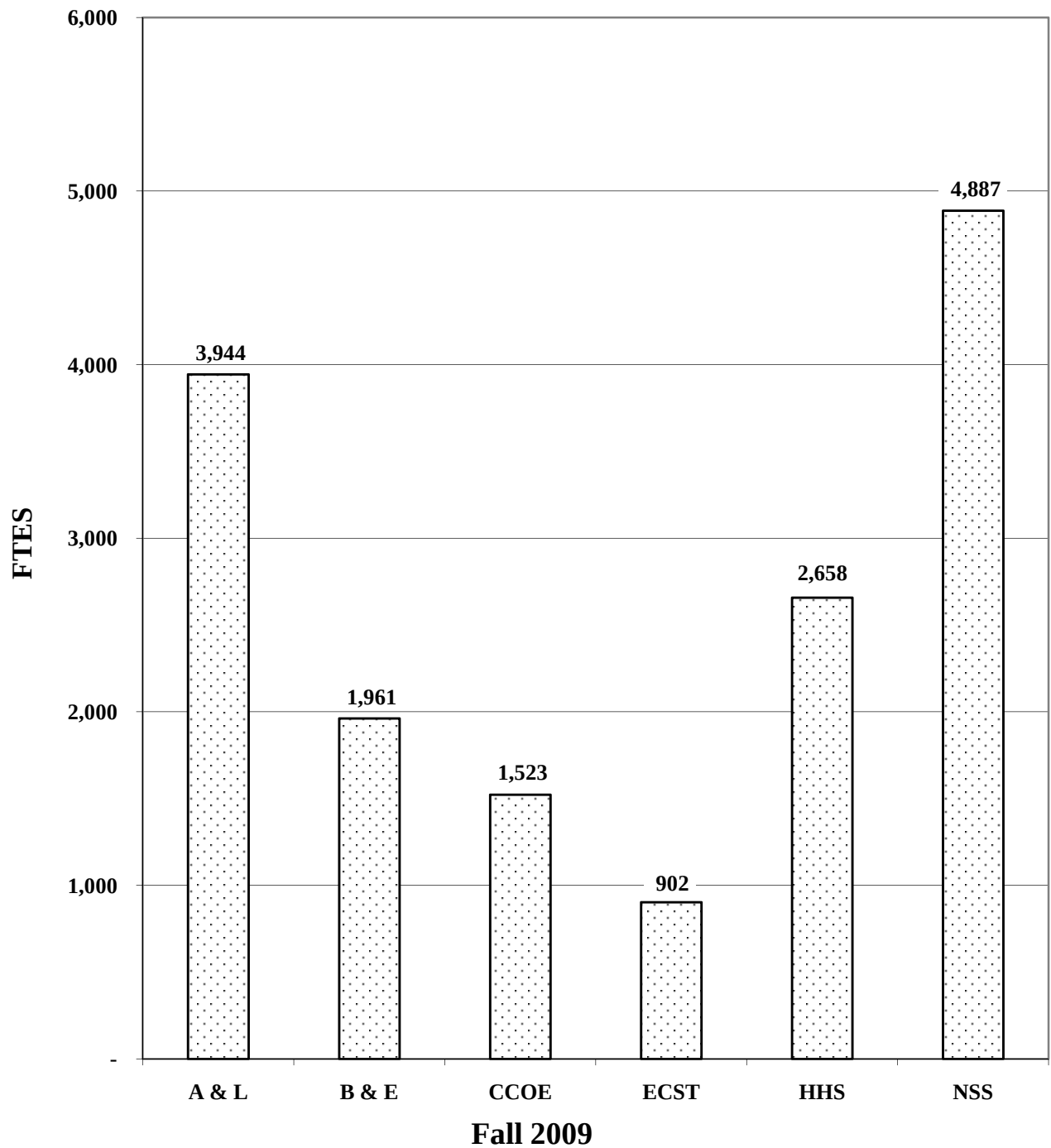

Fall 2002 to Fall 2009

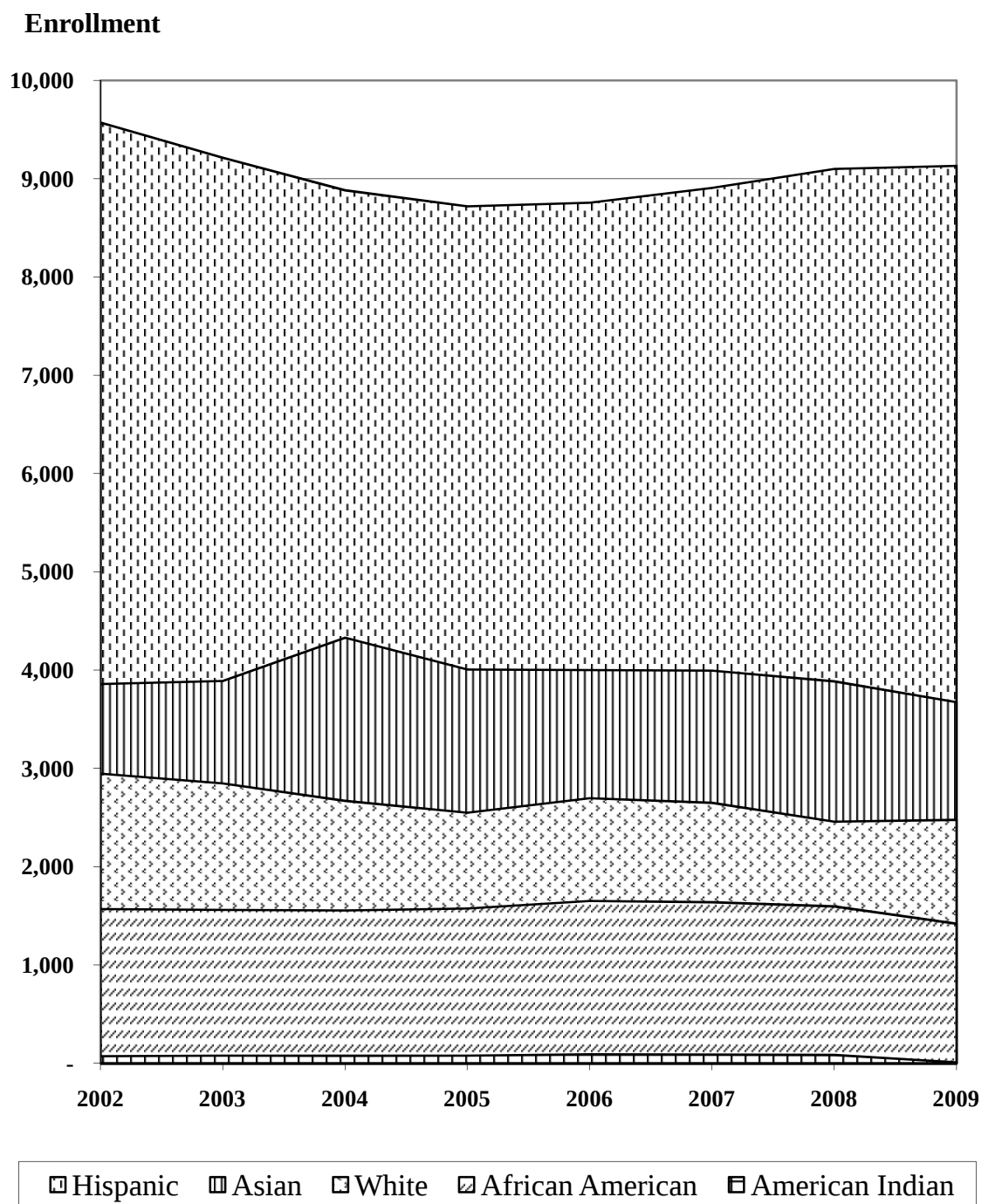

Fall 2002 to Fall 2009

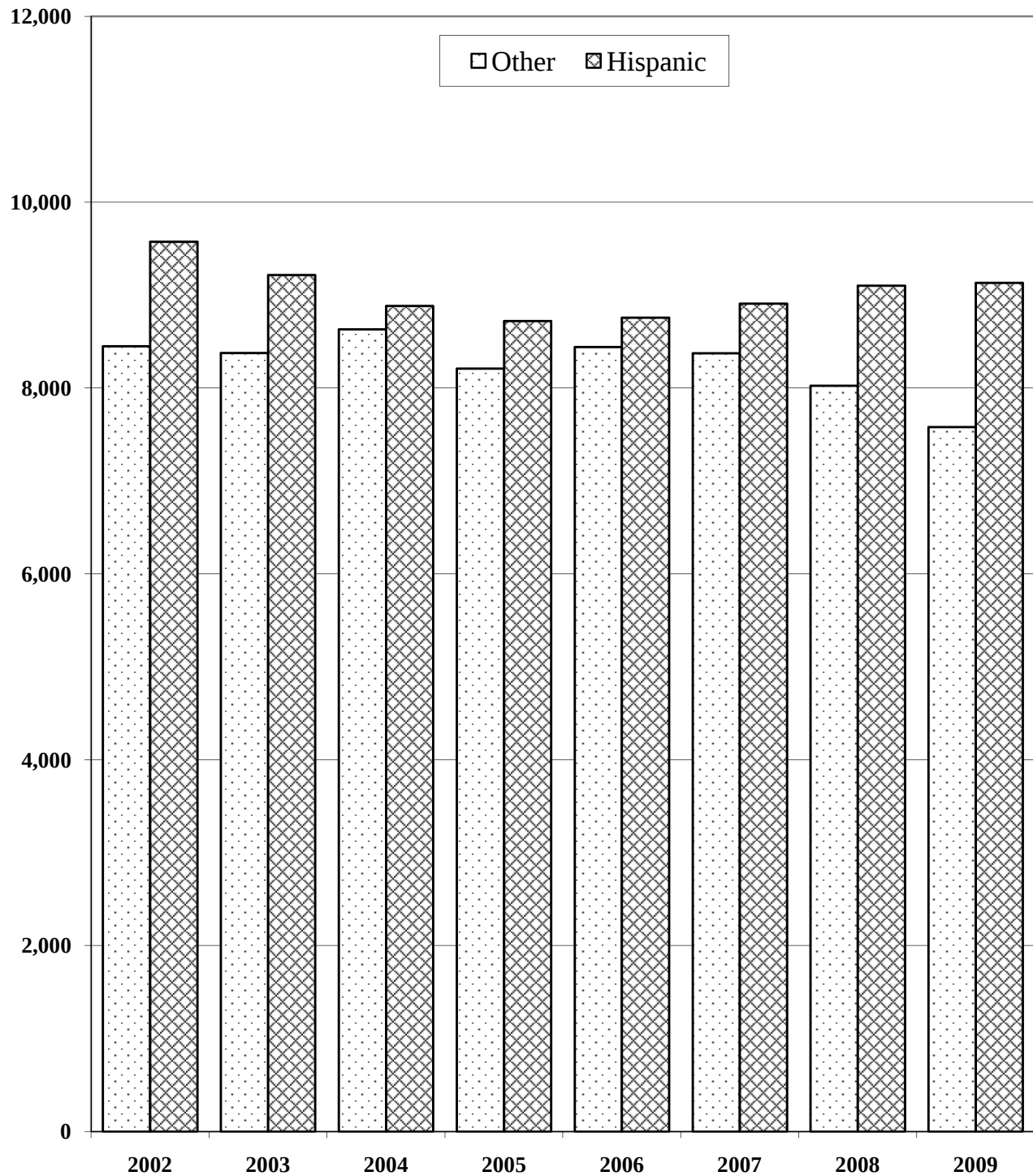

DEGREES GRANTED

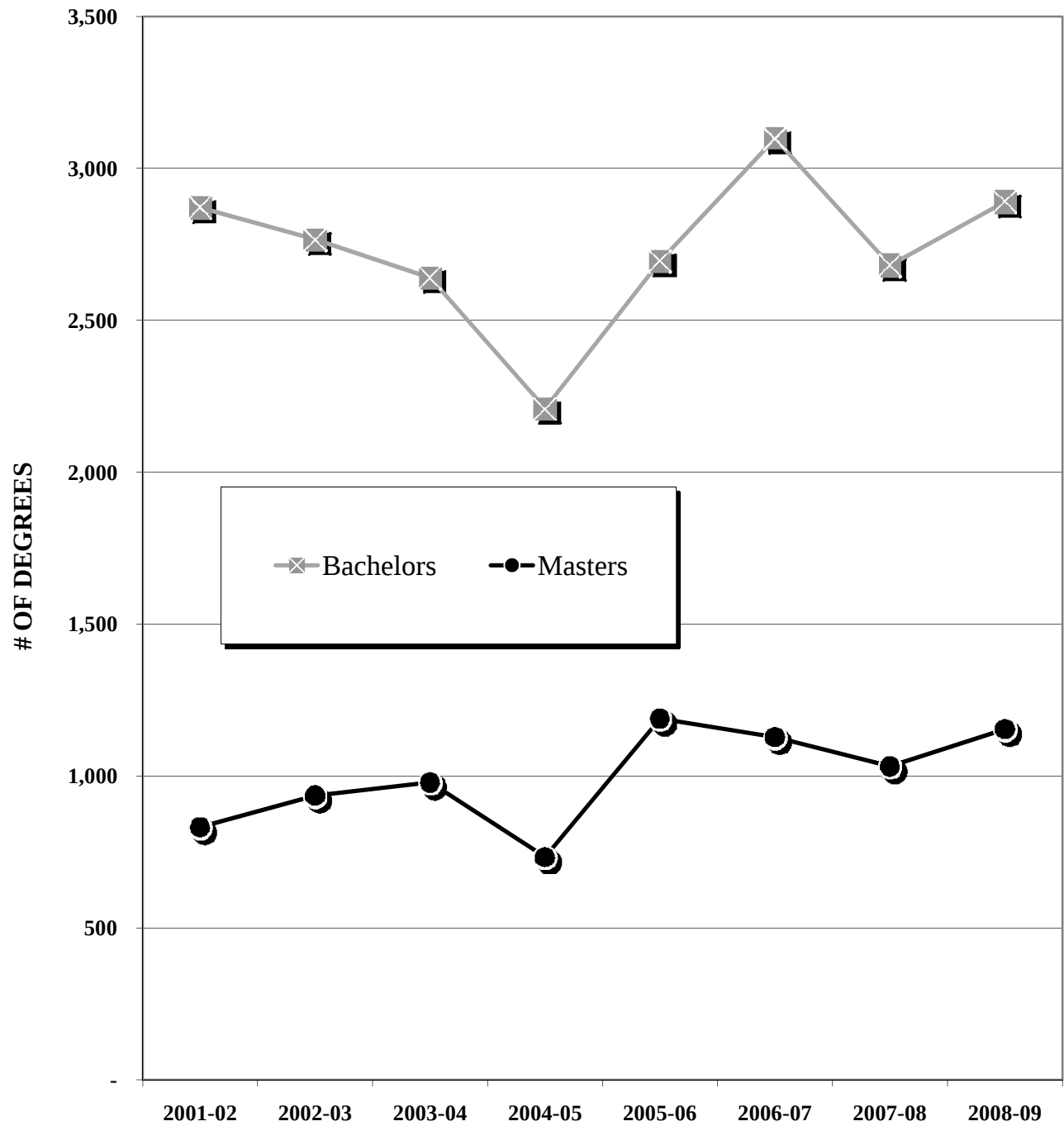

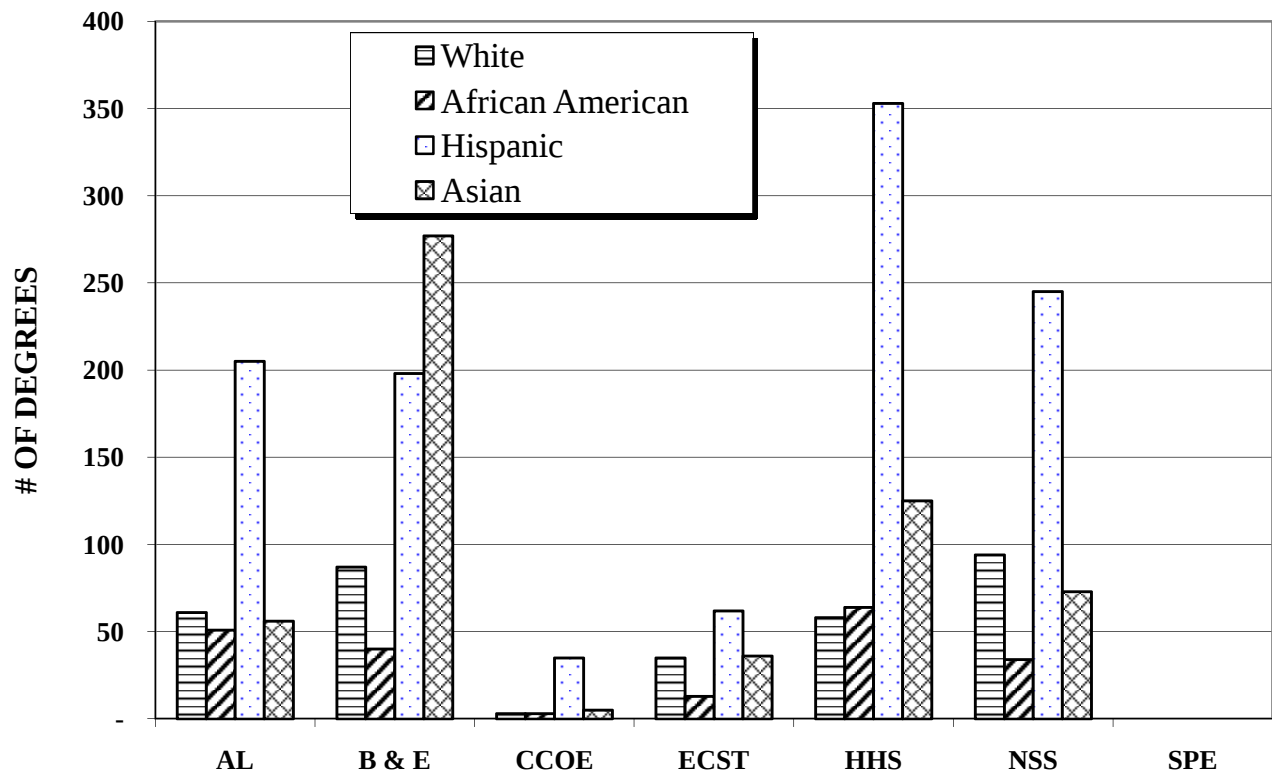

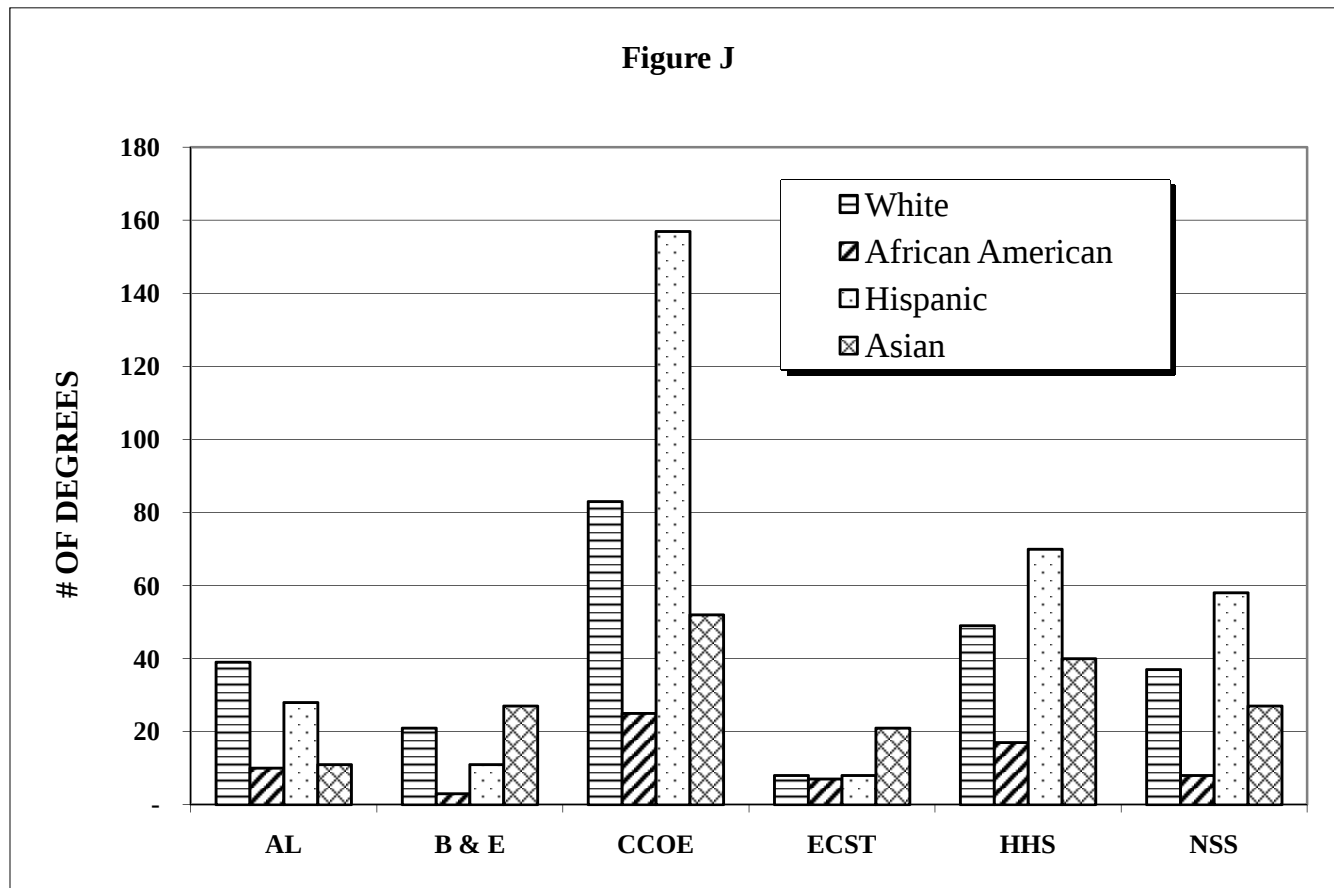

(25 years and older)

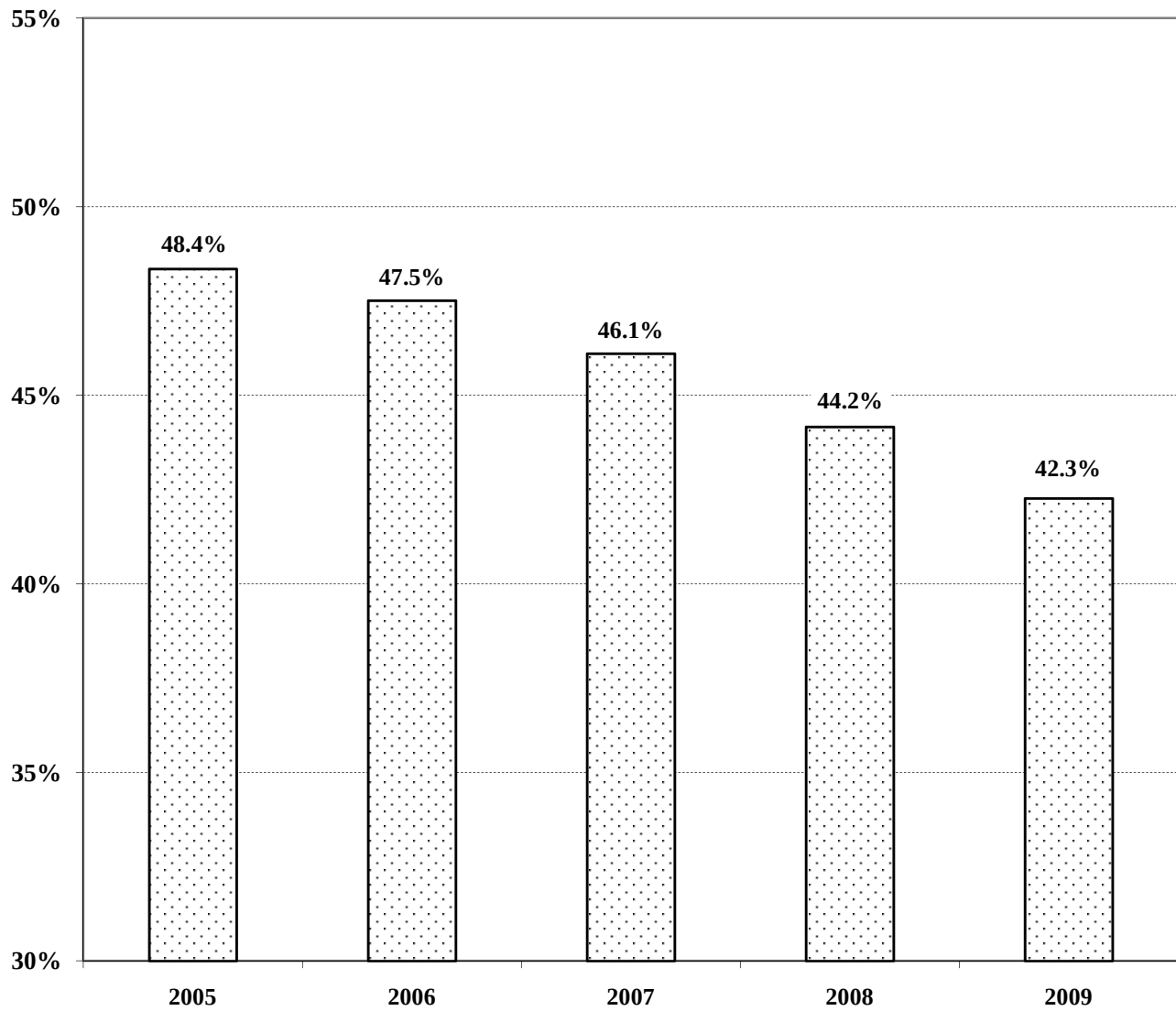

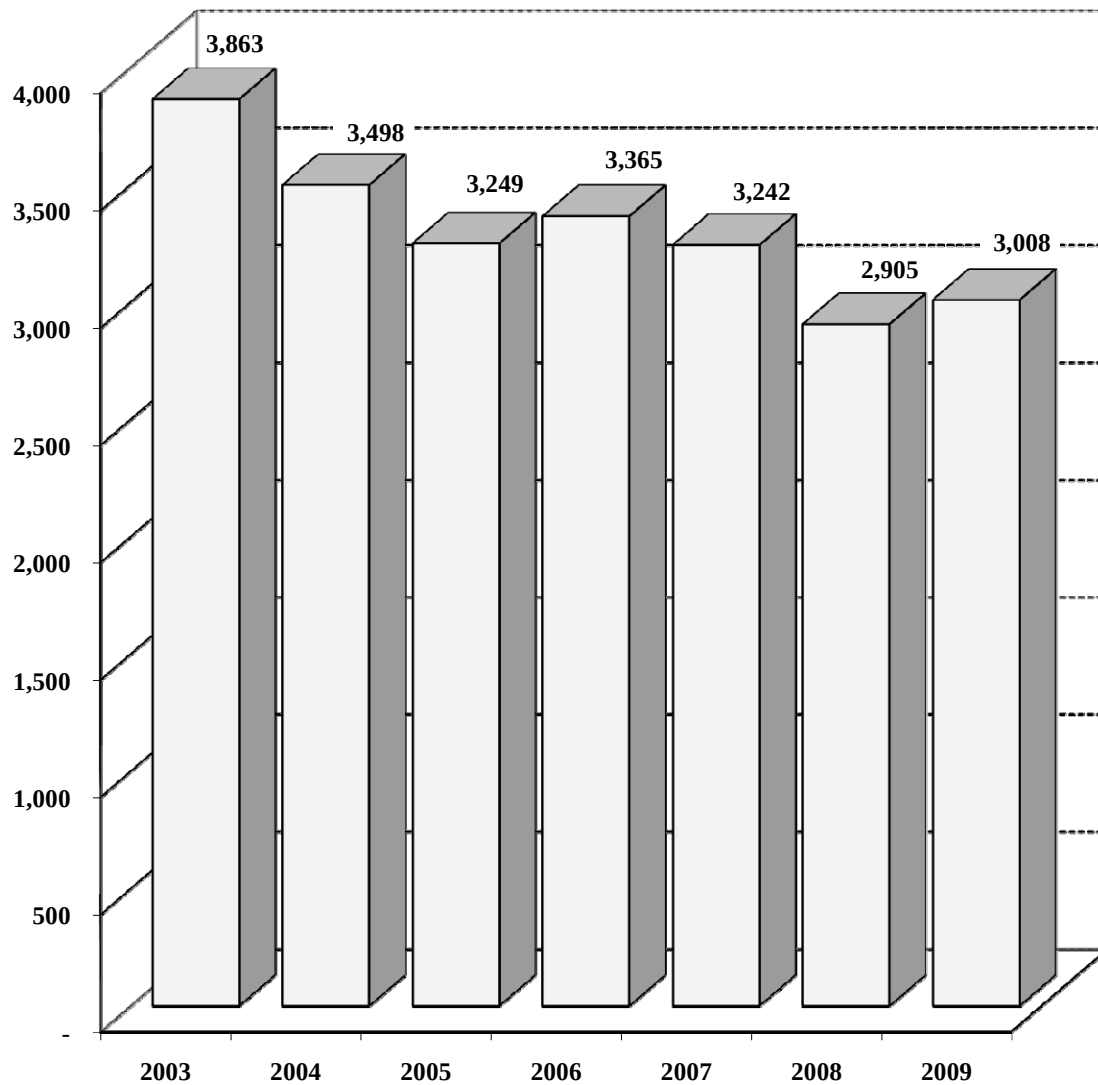

International Student Enrollment

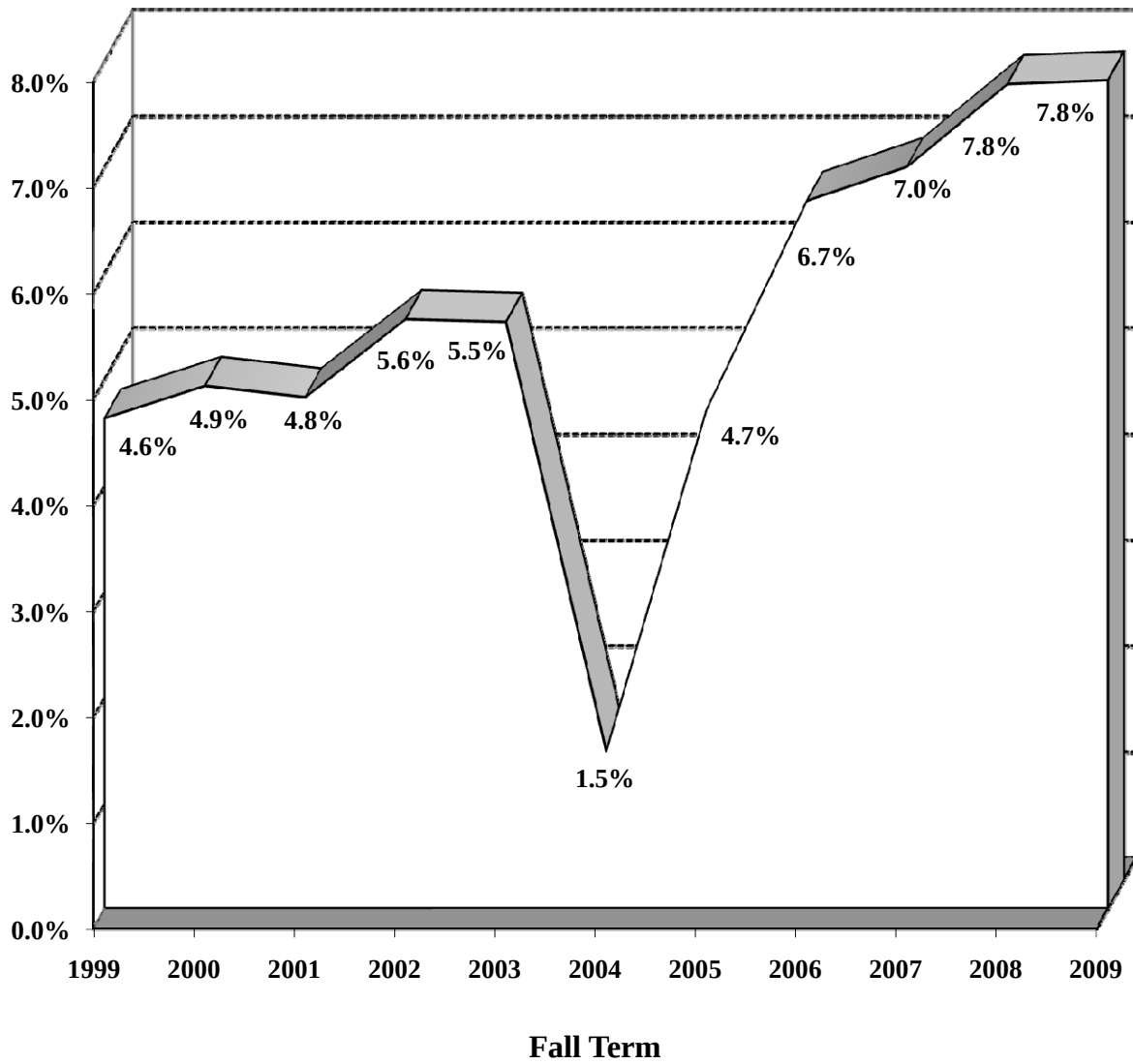

Percent of each college's majors who are international

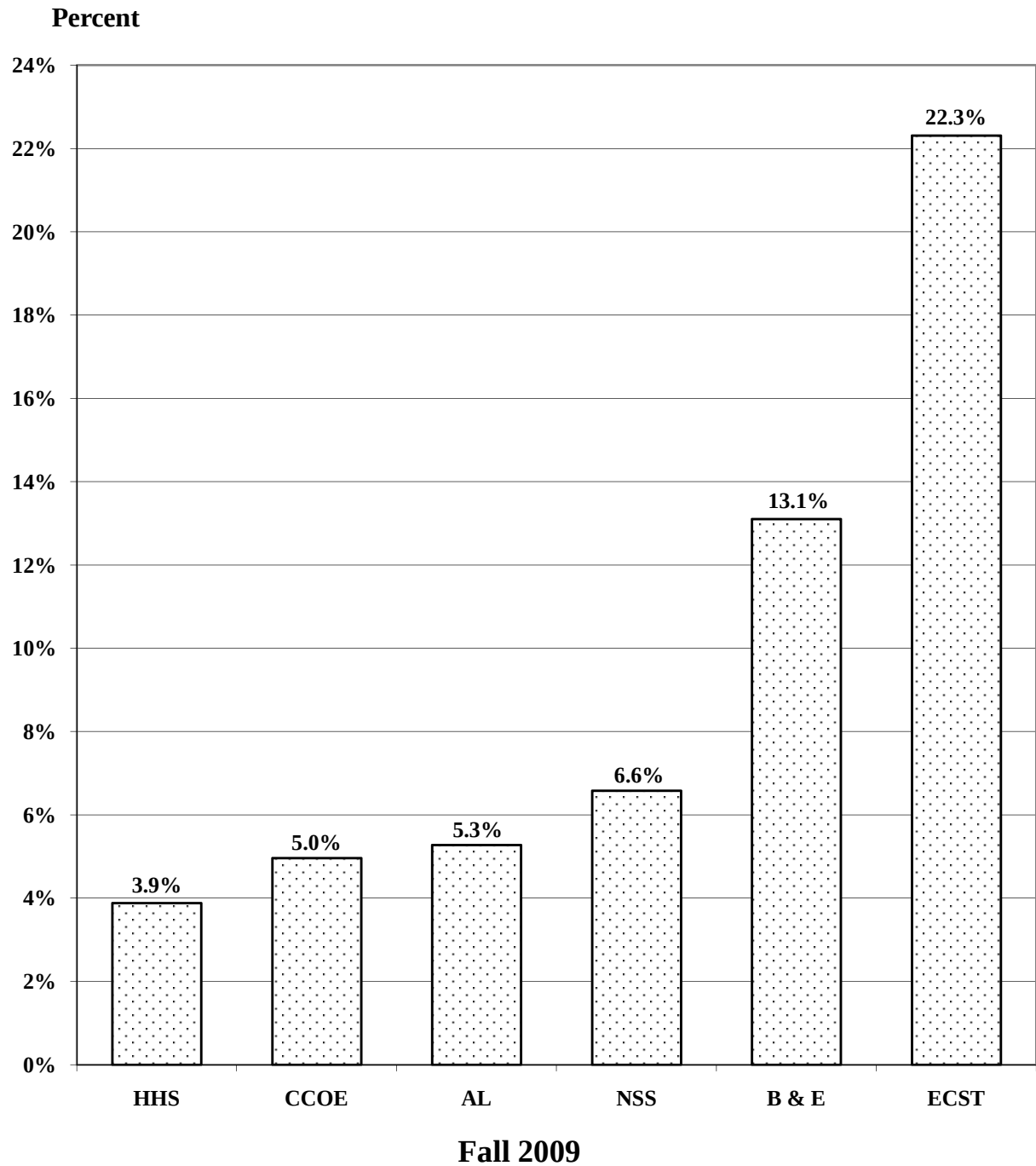

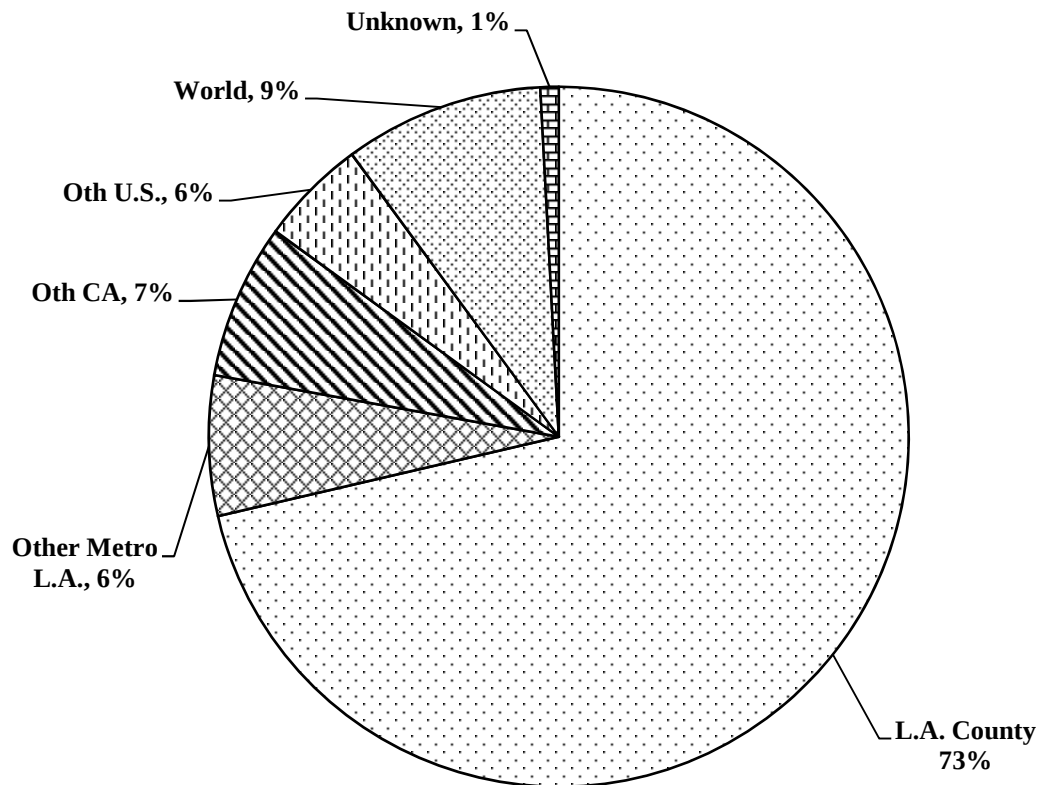
