12. Proposed Policy Modification: The Class Syllabus (FPC 00-11)

Department chairs or higher administrators should address exceptions, 2) Learning outcomes - Learning outcome is incorporated into course objectives, 3) The ADA policy - The ADA policy is addressed in numerous campus publications such as the University Catalog and Schedule of Classes, 4) Inclusion of specific College requirements - The individual college dean or department chair will be responsible for including specific college requirements, 5) Date and time of final examination - This information should be included in the syllabus.
