NOTES: Each required PH course is listed just once on this roadmap. Most PH courses required for the major are given at least twice a year. Check the PH website for class schedules.

1. Roadmap does not include PH prerequisites, including the PH lower division elective, or lower division GE courses.

2. Students who have NOT met the math requirement should replace HHS 400 or PH 472 with Math 100 or 102.

3. Students who have NOT taken PH 150 should take that instead of PH 410. PH 410 may be taken in the winter.

4. Many students may find that they do not need to take 16 units in each quarter to graduate in the two year time frame.

5. Students who did NOT take HHS 400 or PH 472 in the fall should take HHS 400 here and the PH Core Elective in another quarter

6. Internship may be taken 8 units in one quarter, with approval of faculty.

7. Elective: Any course that may be necessary to complete requirements. May not be necessary.
