The Department of Anthropology requires majors to complete 12 units of a language other than English. Students can comply with these requirements by presenting proof of having completed three years of modern language study in high school or receiving a score indicating at least 2nd year proficiency on the college level foreign language placement test as an acceptable equivalent. An additional acceptable equivalent can be the successful completion of three upper division courses in linguistics: ANTH 470/ENGL 403, ANTH 471/ENGL 400, AND ANTH 472. Students who do not complete any units in foreign language at CSULA will need to complete four more units of GE Block C than listed above. Students who complete 8 units of foreign language can do one less class in GE Block C than listed above. Students who complete 12 units of foreign language can use those units to fulfill the GE Block C requirements and do not need to take other Block C classes.
