Notes:

1. The above roadmap is a *SAMPLE* schedule. Please ensure that you meet with the department's undergraduate advisor to plan your actual schedule.
2. English majors must take one lower division Block C course in Arts (C1) and one in Humanities (C2) and are encouraged to consider choosing their C1 course from ENGL 2070, 2260 or 2800, and their C2 course from ENGL 2310, 2600, 2700, 2710, 2730, and 2760, because these can also count as lower-division English electives.
3. All CSULA students must complete two diversity courses (d), of which one must focus on race and ethnicity (re). Consult an adviser for help in selecting these courses.
4. All CSULA students must complete two writing intensive courses (wi). English majors fulfill this requirement by taking ENGL 2900 and a senior seminar (ENGL 4910, 4920, or 4925).
5. All CSULA students must complete two civic learning/community engagement courses (cl). The IHE (Introduction to Higher Education) is one (cl) course and the second one should be taken as one of the upper division general education (UD GE) courses.
6. The introductory sequence of ENGL courses is as follows: ENGL 1010—ENGL 1050—ENGL 2900—ENGL 3xxx (six Core Readings courses).
7. Students must be cleared by the Office of Teacher Preparation and Advisement Center (TPAC) before being permitted to enroll in ENGL 3980 (early field experience), which is taken in conjunction with both ENGL 3050 and ENGL 4910
8. Senior standing (90 or more units completed) is required to enroll in ENGL 4910.
9. The above roadmap only identifies requirements for General Education (48 units) and the English major (51 units). Students will need to enroll in additional free electives to accumulate the 120 units necessary for graduation. The department recommends that students consider using their free electives to pursue an academic minor or to take additional ENGL courses.
