Application for Graduate Assistantship

Graduate assistantships typically involve teaching 1-5 physical activity courses per quarter. Salary is commensurate with experience and number of courses taught. Occasionally, graduate assistants are assigned to teach other courses, manage the Cal State L.A. fitness center, manage the Intramural and Recreational Sports Program, assist faculty with research, or assist faculty with community service projects. To apply for a graduate assistantship: (a) apply to the University for general admission as a graduate student, (b) apply directly to the School of Kinesiology and Nutritional Science for specific admission into the School's Master of Science Degree Program, and/or to the Charter College of Education for admission into a teaching credential program, and (c) complete this form. This form and all items pertaining to your application for admission into the Master of Science Degree Program in Kinesiology should be sent directly to the School of Kinesiology and Nutritional Science (not to the Office of University Admissions).
