



When to use EAB and when to use GET:

EAB and Golden Eagle Territory (GET) are both tools that advisors use to access student information and develop student success plans. EAB is a tool designed to assist advisors during the advising process and draws from data in GET. EAB is also where students set appointments, advisors schedule availability, and campaigns are created for targeted advising for various student groups. Some information exists in both systems, and it is recommended that advisors use EAB where this is the case. Other information resides exclusively in GET. This guide is designed to help advisors determine when to use each system.

<p>Use EAB For:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transcript history • Transfer credit • Term GPA, Cumulative GPA, and academic standing • Major status • Class status • High School data • Student Contact information • Success Markers • Appointment history including notes and advising reports • Current term enrollment including class sections and instructor information • Concern levels • Related career information • Test score data • Searchable fields to identify targeted student populations • Individual and group communication 	<p>Use GET For:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advisor Request System (course subs, changing major/minor, changing catalog dates) • Degree Audit information (CAAR) • Removing or adding advising holds • What-if reports
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There are other uses for each platform but these functions cover the majority of needs when advising students.
