The student shall declare at registration any course(s) to be graded ABC-/NC or CR/NC. Faculty members are not informed of the student's selection of non-standard grading. Grades are reported as A through F and automatically transformed when posted to the student's transcript.

## ABC-/NC GRADING

- 30 units of ABC-/NC graded coursework may be applied to an undergraduate degree program.
- ABC-/NC graded coursework may only be used for the General Education Program and elective credit.
- ABC-/NC graded coursework will not apply to my major(s) and minors(s).
- D+, D, D-, and F instructor assigned grades are converted to NC, which earns no credit.
- Coursework receiving an NC grade is not eligible for Grade Forgiveness.
- 12 or more units of graded coursework are required to be eligible for Dean's List honors.
- Students who receive an NC grade are not eligible for Dean's List honors.
- NC grades received by students using Veterans Affairs (VA) and Department of Defense (DoD) benefits may result in a financial penalty requiring repayment of funds received.

## CR/NC GRADING

- 30 units of CR/NC graded coursework may be applied to an undergraduate degree program.
- 6 units of CR/NC may be attempted per semester.
- CR/NC graded coursework may only be used for elective credit.
- CR/NC graded coursework shall not apply to the General Education program, major(s), and minors(s).
- D+, D, D-, and F instructor assigned grades are converted to NC, which earns no credit.
- Coursework receiving CR/NC grades is not eligible for Grade Forgiveness.
- A grade of CR may not meet minimum grade prerequisites for subsequent required coursework.
- Students on academic or special probation must complete courses for letter grades or they will be advanced to academic disqualification.
- 12 or more units of graded coursework are required to be eligible for Dean's List honors.
- Students who receive an NC grade are not eligible for Dean's List honors.
- Credential students must maintain a credential course GPA of 3.0 or greater in order to enter clinical practice and be recommended for a credential. Receiving an NC grade has potentially negative implications for overall progress.
- Some graduate/professional programs will not accept CR grades for prerequisite courses.
- A student who does not earn letter grades in a particular term may jeopardize their financial aid eligibility for subsequent terms.
- NC grades received by students using Veterans Affairs (VA) and Department of Defense (DoD) benefits may result in a financial penalty requiring repayment of funds received.
- International students must complete a sufficient number of units with a letter grade to maintain immigration status.
