President's Scholars

Annual scholarships of \$2,500 to \$6,800 (potentially renewable for up to three additional years) may be awarded to incoming Honors College freshmen demonstrating high achievement, motivation, and a commitment to education. Minimum criteria for a President's Scholar includes: be a California resident; have a cumulated high school GPA of 3.75 or greater; have been accepted to and enrolled in California State University, Los Angeles and the Honors College.

Honors College Scholars

Multi-year scholarships may be offered to incoming Honors College freshmen who have demonstrated great potential, motivation, and a commitment to education. Award range varies.

The following is a list of scholarships for which Honors College students will be considered, if they submit a Cal State LA General Scholarship application and a FAFSA/California Dream Act application. Not every scholarship has sufficient funds each year to award to students.

Coca-Cola First Generation College Scholarship Program

The Coca-Cola First Generation College Scholarship is available to students in the Honors College; first in their family to attend college; through essay demonstrate a commitment to the university's mission of engagement, service, and the public good, and demonstrate financial need. Award range per student: \$1,000-\$2,000.

Edison Scholars

Scholarships will be provided to qualified Honors College freshmen, continuing, and transfer students who reside within the Southern California Edison service territory area and are majoring in the areas of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM).

Elliott R. Barton Endowment

The Elliott R. Barton Endowment to further the mission of California State University, Los Angeles.

George Bachmann President's Scholarship

The George Bachmann President's Scholarship will be awarded to a full-time undergraduate student with a 3.75 GPA or greater.

Honors Opportunities to Promote Excellence

To support Honors College and Early Entrance Program internships, study abroad, and other educational opportunities that promote academic achievement.

John B. Willis Scholarship Endowment

The John B. Willis Scholarship Endowment annual interest will fund one scholarship to a Cal State L.A. student.

Joseph Drown Scholars

The Joseph Drown Scholarship is available to full-time Honors College students whose adjusted gross family income is between \$81,500-\$169,800.

Joyce Bourke Memorial Scholarship Early Entrance Program

The Joyce Bourke Memorial Scholarship Early Entrance Program will be awarded to a member, in good standing, of the Early Entrance Program at Cal State LA. Outstanding service to the community and/or University/EEP.

Lucy Venzor Memorial Scholarship

The Lucy Venzor Memorial Scholarship is for full-time/part-time students who need financial assistance to attend college.

Merkin Honors College Scholars I

The Merkin Honors scholarship will provide undergraduate financial support for talented students attending Cal State L.A., particularly those in the humanities, focusing on the English Department, with a preference for students who have plans for post baccalaureate professional education.

Osher Scholarship Endowment for California Community College Transfer Students

Osher Scholars are students who are transferring or have transferred from a California Community College with at least 60 semester units and are entering or entered Cal State LA at the junior level or above; demonstrate financial need; show academic promise and a commitment to obtaining a baccalaureate degree.

The Blanca Flanagan Rios Scholarship Fund

Students must have knowledge, understanding, and appreciation of Mexican culture. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher and be enrolled full-time. Students must be in good academic standing and demonstrate financial need.

The CSU Chancellor Emeritus Barry A. Munitz Scholarship

To be awarded at the discretion of the Honors College.

The L.T. & Patricia Button Endowed Scholarship

The L.T. & Patricia Button Endowed Scholarship is to be used for Outreach and Recruitment. First-time freshman with a High School GPA of at least 3.25 and enrolling for at least 8 units. The recipient qualifies to retain the scholarship if they maintain a 3.0 or better while enrolled at the University.

The Prabir K. Pal Endowed Scholarship

To provide scholarship support for an Honors College student at the University who is enrolled in the Early Entrance Program.

William James Dermody Scholarship

Funds to be used to fund student scholarships to be distributed at the discretion and direction of the President of California State University, Los Angeles in honor of William James Dermody.
