How to Apply

To apply, complete the online application available at www.calstatela.edu/SILA

IMPORTANT: Only completed applications will be reviewed.

Applications must include the following:

- ✓ A completed Study in L.A. online application (Available online at www.calstatela.edu/ international/SILA)
- ✓ Bank Document (less than 6 months old) or scholarship verification of support funds (Acceptable documents include: personal or family member's bank statement, scholarship letter, government support letter or government financial guarantee)
- Passport information page (name, date of birth, citizenship)
- ✓ Home university transcript with English translation
- Official proof of English proficiency test results (no more than 2 years old)

Minimum score required: Undergraduate: TOEFL (61 iBT.1), IELTS (5.5), or PTE (44); Graduate:TOEFL (80iBT), IELTS (6), PTE (53)
