7.2 Library budget issues in AY 2016-17

C. Koike reported on the status of the Fiscal Policy Committee's Library Budget Report. She summarized the main points in the report are that the Library needs more money; more resources for databases; needs

Chancellor's Office support. Requested an increase in Lottery Funds from \$400,000 to \$440,000.

85% of budget goes toward electronic resources

Next meeting C. Rodriguez will provide a detailed breakdown of budget. Other campuses have 2-4% of budget is for Library; 1.7% at CSLA for Library.

Want to bring it up to 2%.

7.3 Feedback from faculty

C. Rodriguez explained that the Library would like to have ongoing feedback; it can be informal.

Would like to raise awareness and provide opportunities for interaction among faculty. Some ideas include:

- Online newsletter
- Lecture series, co-sponsored by each college, monthly, starting in 2017
- Create spaces for faculty in Library

Orientation of new faculty could be where new faculty get introduced to Library; used to be more comprehensive with all Library liaisons. Need to strengthen relationship with CETL.

Develop learning communities

S. Stretch-Stephenson pointed out that B&E is planning a lecture series soon. Suggested C. Rodriguez talk to the deans about collaborating on this series with B&E and possibly other colleges.
