A maximum of 5 units of ENGL 598 can be applied to the degree. No more than 8 units at the 400-level can be applied to the degree. Students are strongly encouraged, with advisor approval, to use their electives to formulate a concentration in an area such as literary analysis; composition, rhetoric, and language, or creative writing.</p>
