Fellowship Award Competition

Each year the Cal State L.A. Chapter of the Honor Society Phi Kappa Phi holds a competition for the \$1,000 **James M. Rosser Gamma Epsilon Chapter Fellowship**. This award is given based on undergraduate academics, leadership and service, and prospects for post-baccalaureate study.

To be eligible, students must be active Phi Kappa Phi members as of April 15, 2015, or have accepted membership by June 30, 2015. Students must have applied to enroll as a full-time student in a post-baccalaureate program of study during the 2015-16 academic year. Applicants who have successfully completed 10 or more graduate credits on or before April 15 2015 are not eligible.

The recipient of this campus award will then represent Cal State L.A. in the national Phi Kappa Phi Fellowship competition. Every year, Phi Kappa Phi awards fifty-one Fellowships of \$5,000 each and six at \$15,000 each to members entering the first year of graduate or professional study.
