### Student Enrollment and FTES

Definition of FTES: Class-Based vs. Student-Based

FTES: Full-time Equivalent Student

1 FTES = 15 units for UG/PB students = 12 units for MS/Doctoral students.

#### Class-Based FTES:

FTES generated in classes offered by College/Department of the Class Section

#### Student-Based:

FTES generated by students who declared major in the Department/College

# Class-Based FTES Example


- Example #1: BIOL1010-2 (3 units course) − 20 UG students
- Example #2: ENGL2070-5 (3 units course) 19 UG students, 1 Post-Bac Cred
- Example #3: MATH2120-1 (4 units course) 15 UG students, 3 master's student


